THE TWINS: Began their eight-day roadtrip with three-consecutive losses to the Yankees from Thursday-Saturday...the fourth game that was to be played on Sunday afternoon in New York was postponed late Saturday afternoon due to Tropical Sform Henri...tonight they will continue the trip with the first of three against the Red Sox at Fenway Park, staying through Thursday night...the Twins have gone 30-33 at home this season and 24-37 on the road.

**Eunday's postponed game has been scheduled for Monday, September 13 at 1:05 pm (CT)... the game will be in the middle of an already scheduled six-game homestand...the Twins will play three against the Royals over that weekend (September 10-12), travel to New York for the one game, then travel back to Minneapolis for three against Cleveland (September 14-15), a series which includes a doubleheader with the Tribe on Tuesday, September 14.

ANOTHER BUMMER IN THE BRONX The Twins lost to the Yankees and Gerrit Cole on Saturday afternoon by a score of 7-1 at Yankee Stadium...Kenta Maeda (6-5) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched with one walk and five strikeouts...Maeda left the game in the fifth inning with right forearm tightness...the offense recorded six hits, went 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position and left six men on base...Jorge Polanco provided the Twins' only run with a solo home run off Lucas Luetge in the eighth inning.

ROSTER MOVE: Yesterday, the Twins reinstated infielder Miguel Sanó from the Paternity List... Sanó had returned to Minneapolis to be with his family after the birth of his daughter, Danea. last Thursday morning...Sanó has played in 98 games for the Twins this season, hitting. 217 (73-for-337) with 18 doubles. 21 home runs, 53 RBI, 51 runs scored, 44 walks, a .308 on-base percentage and a .765 DPS...to make room for Sanó on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Kenta Maeda on the 10-day Injured list with right forearm tightness (retroactive to August 22)...Maeda, who departed Saturday's game against the Yankees in the fifth inning with the injury, has gone 6-5, 4.66 ERA (106.1 JP, 55 ER) with 32 walks, 113 strikeouts and a .258 (106-for-411) opponent batting average in 21 starts for the Twins this season...this marks his second trip to the Injured List this year, after missing 20 games with a right adductor strain prior to the All-Star Break.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fifth of seven meetings in 2021...they last played a four-game series at Target Field from April 13-15, as the Twins won the finale and lost the first three...the Twins' last visit to Fenway Park came September 3-5, 2019, as the Twins won the three-game series 2-1.

♣ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .333 (38-for-114) with six doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, 10 walks and a .386 on-base percentage in 31 career games vs. the Red Sox.

♣ Luis Arraez is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with one double, four RBI, six walks and a .469 on-base percentage in nine career games vs. Boston.

♣ Josh Donaldson is hitting .395 (17-for-43) with three doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, five walks, a .458 on-base percentage and a 1.203 OPS in his last 11 games vs. Boston.

POLO POP: Jorge Polanco hit his 22nd home run of the season on Saturday afternoon, tying his single-season career-high, done in 2019...he enters today 10-for-28 (.357) with two doubles, one home run and eight RBI in his last six games...since July 1, he is hitting .306 (55-for-180) with eight doubles, one triple .13 home runs, 40 RBI, a .352 on-base percentage, a .578 slugging percentage and a .930 OPS...in that span, he leads the club in RBI, ahead of Miguel Sano, who has 19...Polanco has accounted for 21% of the club's RBI during that time (40 of 193)...below are his AL ranks since July 1 (among qualifiers):

LUEY - CERTIFIED HITTER: Luis Arraez has hit safely in 15 of his last 17 games and in 29 of his last 32...overall on the season, he is hitting 312 (96-for-308) while posting a 378 on-base percentage in 87 games...among all American League players with at least 300 at-bats, he ranks third in on-base percentage, trailing Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.406) and Houston's Yuli Gurriel (.383)...he also ranks third in batting average, trailing Houston's Gurriel (.317) and Michael Brantley (.315).

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Double-A Wichita outfielder B.J. Boyd and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Joe Ryan were named the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week on Sunday morning.

◆ Boyd played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .355 (11-for-31) with five home runs, 12 RBI, nine runs scored, an .839 slugging percentage and a 1.194 OPS.. Boyd, who was named Double-A Central Player of the Week one week ago, was originally selected by Oakland in the fourth round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft out of Palo Alto High School (CA)...he declared free agency in the offseason and signed with the Twins to a minor league contract in late May.

◆ Ryan, 25, made one start for the Saints on Friday night vs. lowa, allowing one run on one hit in 4.0 innings pitched with one walk and nine strikeouts...fresh off the Tokyo Olympics, where he helped Team USA win a silver medal in baseball, Ryan has combined to go 4-3, 3.54 ERA (61.0 IP, 24 ER), 11 walks, 84 strikeouts and a .168 opponent batting average in 13 games (12 starts) between St. Paul and Triple-A Durham...he was one of two pitchers (also Drew Strotman) acquired by the Twins via trade with Tampa Bay, in exchange for Nelson Cruz on July 22.

REHAB UPDATES: Outfielder Byron Buxton has appeared in two games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 1-for-5 with a home run, two RBI and two strikeouts...Buck has missed the Twins' last 52 games with a left hand fracture...right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak made the start for Single-A Fort Myers Saturday night in Dunedin, pitching 3.0 perfect innings with five strikeouts...Dobnak has missed the Twins' last 54 games with a right middle finger strain.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1981, in his first major league game, Kent Hrbek hit a 12th-inning home run, giving the Twins a 3-2 victory over the Yankees...he became the fifth player in club history to homer in his first major league game (12 now)...Hrbek finished his career with 293 home runs, second most in Twins history, trailing only Harmon Killebrew (475).

DOWN ON THE FARM UPDATE: Twins 2020 first round (27th overall) selection Aaron Sabato was recently promoted from Low-A Fort Myers to High-A Cedar Rapids...the 22-year-old first baseman was 54-for-286 (.189) with 15 doubles, 11 home runs, 42 RBI and a .357 slugging percentage in 85 games for the Mighty Mussels.

TARGET FIELD ROCKED: Last night, Target Field hosted the Hella Mega Tour, featuring Green Day, Fall Out Boy and Weezer, with the opener The Interrupters...it marked each band's first show at Target Field and mark the first concert at the Twins' ballpark since Down the Rabbit Hole Live: Zac Brown Band 2018 North American Tour with OneRepublic and Caroline Jones...Green Day joins Paul McCartney (2014), Billy Joel (2017), Journey (2018), Def Leppard (2018), Cheap Trick (2018) and The Eagles (2018) as members of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame to perform at Target Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Jax did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 16 vs. Cleveland, as the Twins defeated the Indians, 5-4, in 10 innings on Jorge Polanco's walk-off double...Jax recorded his second career quality start (and second consecutive), after allowing four runs (2 ER) on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts over a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of work...yielded a leadoff walk followed by a two-run homer to Bradley Zimmer in the second inning, the first extrabase hit he's allowed in the first or second inning in his career...plunked Owen Miller in the second inning, his first career hit batter...allowed unearned single tallies in the fifth and sixth innings, and departed with the score tied 4-4; the Twins later walked off in the 10th.

The following night, August 17, fellow rookie starting pitcher Bailey Ober also recorded a quality start, marking the first time the Twins had quality starts by rookies in back-to-back games since August 18-19, 2012 vs. Seattle, when Scott Diamond (August 18; 6.2 IP, 2 ER) and Samuel Deduno (August 19; 6.0 IP, 2 ER) each did so.

START PRIOR: Jax started on August 10 vs. Chicago-AL; earned his third win as the Twins topped the White Sox, 4-3...set single-game career highs in innings pitched (6.0) and strikeouts (10), allowing three runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk in his outing...also marked his first career quality start... became the first Twins rookie hurler with double-digit strikeouts in an outing since Trevor May on September 14, 2014 at Chicago-AL (also 10 K)...threw 83 pitches in the start, becoming the second Twins pitcher since 1988 to record at least 10 strikeouts and 83-or-fewer pitches in an outing, joining losé Barrios (11 K 81 nitches) on July 31, 2019 at Miami José Berríos (11 K, 81 pitches) on July 31, 2019 at Miami.

STRONG STRETCH: lax is 2-0, 2,73 FRA (26.1 IP, 8 FR), seven walks, 21 strikeouts and a, 188 (18-for-96) opponent batting average in his last five starts, since July 19 at the White Sox...this run has come in the wake of allowing six earned runs in his first career start on July 3 at Kansas City...his opponent batting average in that span is third in the American League (min. 95 AB), behind Shohei Ohtani (.179) and Cal Quantrill (.187); also ranks fifth in the majors in that category in that span...his .248 opponent on-base percentage in that span (min. 95 AB) is also third in the AL and sixth in the majors.

EASTERN VIEWS: Jax is making his first career start and appearance vs. Boston, as the Twins last faced the Red Sox in April prior to his debut...owns two career relief appearances vs. the American League East division, both occurring against New York-AL on June 8-9 of this season (June 8 was his major league debut)...is 0-0, 8.31 ERA (4.1 IP, 4 ER), no walks and three strikeouts in those two outings.

EARLY DOMINANCE: Jax is holding opposing hitters to a .182 (14-for-77) batting average the first time through the lineup so far in his major league career...this increases to .273 (18-for-66) the second time around and jumps further to .333 (8-for-24) the third time he sees opposing hitters...these numbers correspond to his numbers in each respective inning, as he is holding opposing hitters to .132 (0 for C6) betting average in the first three pinning combined. a .132 (9-for-68) batting average in the first three innings combined

LOTS OF LOVE FOR THE LEFTIES: Jax has held left-handed batters to a .180 (11-for-61) batting average, with two doubles, three homers, seven walks and 11 strikeouts so far in his major league career...this compares to the .274 (29-for-106) batting average that right-handed batters have posted against Jax.

BIG LEAGUE BREAKDOWN: Jax is in his fourth stint with the Twins this season, after being with BIG LEAGUE BREAKDUWN: Jax is in his fourth stint with the liwns this season, after being with the club from June 5-15, June 24-July 7 and on July 19 as the 27th man for the doubleheader...the 26-year-old has appeared four times out of the bullpen, including his June 8 major league debut, and made four starts, on July 3 at Kansas City, July 19 at Chicago-AL, July 30 at St. Louis and August 5 at Houston...he's gone 3-1, 5.11 ERA (44.0 IP, 25 ER), 15 walks and 35 strikeouts across those outings.

4 Had his contract selected June 5, while his big league debut came at Target Field on June 8 vs. the New York Yankees...pitched the ninth inning, fanning Tyler Wade for his first career strikeout.

5 Also pitched June 9 vs. the Yankees and June 15 at Seattle...was optioned following his 4.0-inning, six-strikeout, 93-pitch effort vs. the Mariners...was recalled just nine days later and earned his first career win in relief on June 25 vs. Cleveland (4.1 IP, 3 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 2 K).

ACROSS THE RIVER: Jax did not play an official professional game in 2020 and was not part of the Twins' 60-man player pool...participated in the Twins Fall Instructional League in Fort Myers in October 2020...opened 2021 in the rotation for Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-1, 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER) in five starts during May...did not pitch upon being optioned to the Saints on June 16 and returned to the Twins on June 24...made one start for the Saints during his most recent Triple-A stint, on July 25 at Omaha (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/ER, 1 BB, 5 K).

❖ Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in all seven of his Triple-A starts, while cresting the 90-pitch plateau in four of his seven efforts...is 4-1, 3.32 ERA (38.0 IP, 14 ER) overall with the Saints.

❖ Has held opponents to one-or-zero runs in five of his seven Saints starts...in fact, taking away his lone poor outing in a May 18 loss to Indianapolis (5.0 IP, 7 ER), he has posted a 4-0 mark with a 1.91 ERA (33.0 IP, 7 ER) in his other six outings...bounced back from his lone loss five days later to hold that same Indians club to one run on seven hits, with a walk and eight strikeouts, in 6.0 innings.

❖ In his final Triple-A start before his first major league stint on May 28 at lowa, established a career high across any level with 10 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-hit, shutout ball (2 walks).

❖ Did not factor into the decision in his lone outing during his most recent Triple-A stint, pitching

- Enters his sixth year as a member of the Twins organization in 2021; did not play in 2020 when the minor league season was cancelled due to COVID-19.
