<b>THE TWINS:</b> Have gone 0-4 on their current roadtrip, losing three games in New York, followed
by a loss in the series opener last night in Bostontonight they will play the second of three
at Fenway Parktomorrow evening they will complete the roadfrip then travel to Minneapolis
to begin a three-game weekend series with the Brewerson Monday they will play a makeup
game in Detroit, then return to Target Field for a two-game series with the Cubs on Tuesday and
Wednesdaythe Twins have gone 30-33 at home this season and 24-38 on the road.

**TWINS CHASE RED SOX BUT FALL SHORT:** The Twins lost to the Red Sox last night at Fenway Park by a score of 11-9, despite scoring six runs in the final four innings...it marked the Twins' third loss this season when scoring nine-or-more runs (12-13 defeat on April 21 at Oakland and a 14-17 defeat on July 28 vs. DET)...Griffin Jax (3-2) was the starter and loser, allowing nine runs on seven hits (3 home runs) in 4.2 innings pitched, with four walks and four strikeouts... the offense recorded 14 hits with six different Twins recording multiple hits...Jorge Polanco highlighted the night by hitting his single-season career-high 23rd home run while driving in three...the Twins went 3-for-14 with runners in scoring position and left nine men on base.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the sixth of seven meetings in 2021... the Twins need to win each of these next two games to win their second-consecutive series at Fenway Park (2-1 in 2019).

♣ 13 of the last 15 games between these two at Fenway have been decided by three runs-or-less.
♣ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .333 (38-for-114) with six doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, 10 walks and a .386 on-base percentage in 31 career games vs. the Red Sox.
♣ Luis Arraez is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with one double, four RBI, seven walks and a .486 on-base percentage in 10 career games vs. Boston...he has reached base safely seven times (6 hits, 1 walk) in his last 10 plate appearances over his last two games vs. the Sox.
♣ Josh Donaldson is hitting .404 (19-for-47) with three doubles, five home runs, nine RBI, six walks, a .472 on-base percentage and a 1.259 OPS in his last 12 games vs. Boston... in 35 career games at Fenway Park, he is hitting .308 (41-for-133) with seven doubles, two triples, six home runs, 17 RBI, 26 walks, a .423 on-base percentage and a .950 OPS... additionally, he has reached safely in 12 straight at Fenway Park.

POLO POP: Jorge Polanco hit his 23rd home run of the season last night, setting a single-season career-high, passing his 22 in 2019...he enters tonight 12-for-33 (.364) with two doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI in his last seven games...since July 1, he is hitting .308 (57-for-185) with eight doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 43 RBI, a .353 on-base percentage, a .589 slugging percentage and a .942 OPS...below are his AL ranks since July 1 (among qualifiers): HITS RBI AVG OBP SLG OPS XBH TB 4th (57) 1st (43) 6th (.308) 15th (.353) 3rd (.589) 3rd (.942) T-5th (23) 1st (109)

**BATTING ON BOTH SIDES:** Polanco's 23rd home run last night moved him into sole possession of third place on the Twins all-time single-season home run list for switch hitters...lower left is the Twins list (since 1961) and lower right is where he ranks among all switch hitters in baseball this season.

ALL HE DOES IS HIT: With two more hits last night, Luis Arraez is now hitting .314 (98-for-312) on the season, third in the AL (min. 300 PA's), trailing Houston's Yuli Gurriel (.317) and Michael Brantley (.314)...he is short of qualifying for the batting title by 36 plate appearances... additionally, he is in the 99th percentile in baseball in strikeout percentage, having struck out just 34 times in 352 plate appearances, the second-fewest in baseball among hitters with at least 350 plate appearances, trailing only Pittsburgh's Kevin Newman (32 K's in 431 PA's).

The Arraez is hitting .396 on four-seam fastballs, .294 on curveballs and .288 on sliders this season.

**BUCK UPDATE:** Byron Buxton (left hand fracture) played in his third game on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul last night at Toledo, going 1-for-4 and playing the entire game in centerfield...in three rehab games for the Saints, he has gone 2-for-9 with a double and a home run.

LAST START: Ober was dealt his second career loss on August 17, as the Twins fell to Cleveland 3-1... allowed three runs (2 ER) on five hits (1 HR) over a career-high 6.0 innings of work, with no walks and three strikeouts...tossed 4.0 scoreless innings to start the game before allowing a two-run homer to Daniel Johnson in the fifth; another unearned run scored on a sacrifice fly by Wilson Ramos in the sixth...marked Ober's first career quality start and his third outing in which he did not allow a walk.

allowing seven earned runs in 8.1 innings pitched (7.56 ERA) in the prior two.

**START PRIOR**: Ober did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 1-0 victory on August 11 against the White Sox...tossed a then-career-high-tying 5.1 innings, with six hits, one walk and six strikeouts, good for the longest scoreless start of his career...marked his third career scoreless start as well as his fifth career outing with at least six strikeouts.

**A NEW OPPONENT BRINGS A NEW OPPORTUNITY:** Tonight marks Ober's first time facing Boston and the American League East...is 1-2, 4.23 ERA (55.1 IP, 26 ER) with 13 walks and 57 strikeouts against the American League in his career.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** Ober is one of seven players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of three pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2), RHP Griffin Jax (June 8) and LHP Charlie

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first 14 career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .150 hatting average (3-for-20) with runners in scoring position and two outs, as well as a .231 (9-for-39) overall mark with RISP...has allowed multiple hits with runners in scoring position just once in his career, on July 20 at Chicago-AL (2-for-5)...in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, Ober held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position.

This 6.0 walk percentage ranks in the 81st percentile of all pitchers and his 30.9% chase rate ranks in the 80th percentile.

LOW TRAFFIC: Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019, good for an MiLB-best 11.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 75.0 IP)...that season, he also ranked second in the minors in WHIP (0.81) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.55), and was fifth in walks-per-9.0 IP (1.03).

© In 14 MILB starts this season, Ober has allowed 81 total base runners in 63.2 innings, good for an 11.45 base-runners-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also averaging 2.26 walks-per-9.0 IP while averaging 9.19 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP...he has walked just 16 batters compared to 62 strikeouts, recording a 4.06 strikeout-to-walk ratio...his 16 walks are tied for sixth fewest among all rookie pitchers this season (min. 48.0 IP).

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work... took the ball again on May 13 vs. lowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at lowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-5 rout of the I-Cubs...his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.

CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts) from 2017-21...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020...spent part of the offseason working out in Colorado with fellow Twins staffmate Taylor Rogers and last night's pitcher Griffin Jax.

 ♠ Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).
 ♠ Over that same time span, Ober ranks fifth by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per-9.0 innings, fourth by walking just 1.18 batters-per-9.0-innings and seventh in WHIP (0.96).

**SKOL TWINS:** Ober attended Charlotte Christian School in Charlotte, North Carolina, where he was batterymates on the baseball team and friends with Vikings center Garrett Bradbury...Bradbury had just arrived in the Twin Cities for OTAs at the time of Ober's debut on May 18, and attended the game with his wife, Carson...Carson is also the older sister of Kansas City Royals No. 6 prospect Jackson Kowar.

NO RUNS: Ober posted a miniscule 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) in 2019, his most recent full professional season...his mark led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) and he also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961...also marked the second-lowest single-season ERA by any minor league pitcher since 1992 (min. 75.0 IP), trailing only Erasmo Ramírez's 0.51 ERA (88.0 IP, 5 ER) in 2009 for the VSL Mariners.
