THE TWINS: Have gone 0-4 on their current roadtrip, losing three games in New York, followed by a loss in the series opener last night in Boston...tonight they will play the second of three at Fenway Park...tomorrow evening they will complete the roadtrip then travel to Minneapolis to begin a three-game weekend series with the Brewers...on Monday they will play a makeup game in Detroit, then return to Target Field for a two-game series with the Cubs on Tuesday and Wednesday...the Twins have gone 30-33 at home this season and 24-38 on the road.

TWINS CHASE RED SOX BUT FALL SHORT: The Twins lost to the Red Sox last night at Fenway Park by a score of 11-9, despite scoring six runs in the final four innings...it marked the Twins' third loss this season when scoring nine-or-more runs (12-13 defeat on April 21 at Oakland and a 14-17 defeat on July 28 vs. DET)...Griffin Jax (3-2) was the starter and loser, allowing nine runs on seven hits (3 home runs) in 4.2 innings pitched, with four walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded 14 hits with six different Twins recording multiple hits...Jorge Polanco highlighted the night by hitting his single-season career-high 23rd home run while driving in three...the Twins went 3-for-14 with runners in scoring position and left nine men on base.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the sixth of seven meetings in 2021...the Twins need to win each of these next two games to win their second-consecutive series at Fenway Park (2-1 in 2019).

13 of the last 15 games between these two at Fenway have been decided by three runs-or-less.
 Andrelton Simmons is hitting .333 (38-for-114) with six doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, 10 walks and a .386 on-base percentage in 31 career games vs. the Red Sox.
 Luis Arraez is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with one double, four RBI, seven walks and a .486 on-base percentage in 10 career games vs. Boston...he has reached base safely seven times (6 hits, 1 walk) in his last 10 plate appearances over his last two games vs. the Sox.
 Josh Donaldson is hitting .404 (19-for-47) with three doubles, five home runs, nine RBI, six walks, a .472 on-base percentage and a 1.259 OPS in his last 12 games vs. Boston...in 35 career games at Fenway Park, he is hitting .308 (41-for-133) with seven doubles, two triples, six home runs, 17 RBI, 26 walks, a .423 on-base percentage and a .950 OPS...additionally, he has reached safely in 12 straight at Fenway Park.

POLO POP: Jorge Polanco hit his 23rd home run of the season last night, setting a single-season career-high, passing his 22 in 2019...he enters tonight 12-for-33 (.364) with two doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI in his last seven games...since July 1, he is hitting .308 (57-for-185) with eight doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 43 RBI, a .353 on-base percentage, a .589 slugging percentage and a .942 OPS...below are his AL ranks since July 1 (among qualifiers):

ALL HE DOES IS HIT: With two more hits last night, Luis Arraez is now hitting .314 (98-for-312) on the season, third in the AL (min. 300 PA's), trailing Houston's Yuli Gurriel (.317) and Michael Brantley (.314)...he is short of qualifying for the batting title by 36 plate appearances...additionally, he is in the 99th percentile in baseball in strikeout percentage, having struck out just 34 times in 352 plate appearances, the second-fewest in baseball among hitters with at least 350 plate appearances, trailing only Pittsburgh's Kevin Newman (32 K's in 431 PA's).
 Arraez is hitting .396 on four-seam fastballs, .294 on curveballs and .288 on sliders this season.

BUCK UPDATE: Byron Buxton (left hand fracture) played in his third game on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul last night at Toledo, going 1-for-4 and playing the entire game in centerfield...in three rehab games for the Saints, he has gone 2-for-9 with a double and a home run.
