LAST START: Maeda did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 27 vs. Detroit, an eventual 6-5 Twins loss in 11 innings...he allowed one run on four hits (1 HR) over 6.1 innings, with two walks and five strikeouts in his fourth quality start of the season...the lone run he permitted came on an Akil Baddoo two-out solo homer in the third inning...departed with a 5-1 lead; the Tigers tied the game with a four-run ninth and scratched another run across in the top of the 10th to win.

 Φ Maeda finished July with a 2.15 ERA (29.1 IP, 7 ER) in five starts, his third-lowest ERA in any month in his career (min. 3 starts), trailing only his 1.41 ERA in April 2016 and his 1.71 ERA in June 2017...he allowed three-or-fewer runs in all five starts and recorded three of his four quality starts on the season during the month...his 2.15 ERA in his last five starts is nearly one-third of the 6.26 ERA (23.0 IP, 16 ER) that he posted in his previous five from May 16-June 29.

**START PRIOR**: Maeda started the Twins' homestand opener on July 22 vs. Los Angeles-AL, as he shouldered the loss in a 3-2 Twins defeat...worked a season-high 7.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits, with no walks and six strikeouts, good for his third quality start of the season...marked his first start of at least 7.0 innings since September 11, 2020 vs. Cleveland (also 7.0 IP)...did not walk a batter for the first time since April 27 at Cleveland (5.2 IP)...also marked his seventh career start in which he worked at least 7.0 innings and threw 95-or-fewer pitches...all three Angels runs came on a Jack Mayfield three-run homer in the top of the fifth inning – the second-consecutive start in which all the runs he allowed came via one two-out, three-run swing of the bat.

SEEING RED: Maeda last faced the Reds on April 16, 2019 at Dodger Stadium, earning the 6-1 win in a quality start as he held Cincinnati to one run on four hits with three walks and five strikeouts in 6.2 innings of work...he's 2-1-1, 3.54 ERA (20.1 IP, 8 ER), six walks, 21 strikeouts and a .238 opponent batting average (19-for-80) in four career games (3 starts) against the Reds, all as a Dodger.
 Ø Owns one career start at Great American Ball Park, on June 18, 2017...yielded just one run on three hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings as Los Angeles-NL won, 8-7.

**INTERLEAGUE REDUX.** Tonight marks Maeda's second Interleague start of the season, after he took a no-decision against the Brewers on Opening Day, April 1...allowed two runs (1 ER) on six hits, with two walks and five strikeouts in 4.1 innings in an eventual 6-5 Twins loss in 10 innings...he's 1-0, 2.52 ERA (25.0 IP, 7 ER), six walks, 26 strikeouts and a .165 opponent batting average (15-for-91) in four career Interleague starts as a member of the Twins (since 2020)...Maeda spent the first four seasons of his career in the National League with Los Angeles-NL and is 7-7-1, 4.13 ERA (106.2 IP, 49 ER), 37 walks, 112 strikeouts and a .213 opponent batting average (85-for-400) in 23 career Interleague games (19 starts).

KENTA MAEDA, ALL-AROUND PLAYER: Maeda is 0-for-1 with a run scored at the plate this season... the lone run scored came as a pinch runner (see bullet below)...he's a career.153 (27-for-177) hit-ter, with four doubles, one home run, 14 RBI, 11 runs scored, one walk and 35 sacrifice bunts...his last hit came on August 28, 2019 at San Diego with Los Angeles-NL, a second-inning single off Luis Perdomo...Maeda's lone home run came in his second career MLB at-bat on April 6, 2016 at San Diego, when he took Andrew Cashner deep.
 Maeda also pinch ran for fellow hurler Caleb Thielbar in the bottom of the 10th inning of the Twins' 6-5, extra-inning victory over the Detroit Tigers on July 26, the night before his last start...he scored the winning run on Max Kepler's walk-off single...marked his fourth career appearance as a pinch runner and first since June 2, 2019 vs. Philadelphia for Los Angeles-NL...Maeda became the first Twins pitcher to pinch run since Liam Hendriks on June 22, 2012 at Cincinnati, as well as the first to pinch run and score since Pat Mahomes pinch ran and scored the winning run in the bottom of the 12th inning on August 9, 1994 vs. Boston.

**ON THE ROAD:** Maeda is making his 12th road start of the season, going 3-2, 5.50 ERA (54.0 IP, 33 ER) with 17 walks and 57 strikeouts in his 11 prior starts...this compares to the 1-2, 2.53 ERA (32.0 IP, 9 ER) with nine walks and 33 strikeouts he has in his six home starts this season...he's 1-0, 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP, 3 ER) in his last two road outings, dating back to July 4 at Kansas City...11 of the 13 home runs and 21 of the 31 extra-base hits he's allowed this season have come on the road.

MILESTONE MAN: Maeda surpassed two career milestones in his start against the Mariners in Seattle on June 14...at the end of his second inning of work he reached 700 career MLB innings, becoming the 10th Japanese-born pitcher to hit that plateau in the majors...the others are: Hideo Nomo (1,976.1 IP), Hiroki Kuroda (1,319.0 IP), Yu Darvish (1,248.2 IP), Tomo Ohka (1,070.0 IP), Masahiro Tanaka (1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma (883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka (790.1 IP), Masato Yoshii (757.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa (720.1 IP)...additionally, Maeda's strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth inning on June 14 was the 2,000th of his career...he now has 2,044 strikeouts combined between Nippon Professional Baseball (1,233) and Major League Baseball (811).
 Maeda's final strikeout on July 17 was the 800th of his major league career...he became just the fifth Japanese-born pitcher in major league history to reach 800 career strikeouts, joining Nomo (1,918), Darvish (1,534), Tanaka (991) and Kuroda (986).
 Maeda's seven career games with 10-plus strikeouts are fourth most among Japanese-born pitchers in major league history (46), Nomo (31) and Tanaka (14).

2021 ARSENAL: Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last two seasons...he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his most frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020, followed by his split finger...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP CHARLIE BARNES [2021 SEASON: 0-1, 1.93 ERA // CAREER: 0-1, 1.93 ERA]

Rookie southpaw Barnes is due to start tomorrow's series finale in Cincinnati...will be making his second career start and appearance, after being recalled on July 31 to fill the roster spot of Hansel Robles, who was traded to Boston...made his major league debut in the first game of the doubleheader on July 17 at Detroit, taking the loss despite allowing just one run on four hits, with one walk and one strikeout in 4.2 innings...became just the second pitcher in Twins history to allow one-or-fewer runs in his debut and take the loss, alongside Brad Havens on June 5, 1981 at Detroit

- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
  Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
  Owns the fifth-most strikeeuts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), oppo-nents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.
