TAMING THE TIGER：Today marks Ober＇s second career start against Detroit．．．．his lone start came on July 10 at Target Field．．．．he did not factor into the decision of the Twins＇9－4 victory after allowing four runs on four hits，with two walks and four strikeouts．

MONTHLY BREAKDOWN：Ober is about to complete his third full month in the majors．．．．below is a breakdown of his numbers in each month．．．the Twins have won four of his last five starts，in that span he posted a 2.13 ERA（ 25.1 IP， 6 ER）with four walks and 27 strikeouts．

LOW RISP，HIGH REWARD：Through his first 15 career major league starts，Ober is holding opponents to a 182 batting average（4－for－22）with runners in scoring position and two outs，as well as a just once in his career，on July 20 at Chicago－AL（2－for－5）．．．in his four starts for Triple－A St．Paul， Ober held opposing hitters to just a ． 182 （4－for－22）batting average with runners in scoring position．

SAINTLY SUMMARY：Ober made four starts for Triple－A St．Paul this season，going 1－0，2．81 ERA（16．0 IP， 5 ER），five walks， 21 strikeouts and a 217 opponent batting average（ 13 －for－60）．．．two of the starts occurred prior to his call－up on May 18 and two after．

LOW TRAFFIC：Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019，good for an MiLB－best 11.11 strikeout－to－walk ratio（min．75．0（P）．．．that season，he also tanked second in the minors in WHIP（0．81）and base runners－per－9．0 IP（7．55），and was fifth in walks－per－9．0 IP（1．03）．
－In 14 MLB starts this season，Ober has allowed 81 total base runners in 63.2 innings，good for an 11.45 base－runners－per－ 9.0 IP ratio．．．he＇s also averaging 2.26 walks－per－ 9.0 IP while averaging 9.19 strikeouts－per－ 9.01 P．．．he has walked just 16 batters compared to 62 strikeouts， recording a 4.06 strikeout－to－walk ratio．．．his 16 walks are tied for sixth fewest among all

244 strikeouts and a 222 opponent batting average（163－for－734）over 38 career minor league appearances（ 35 starts）from 2017－21．．．was added to the Twins＇ 40 －man roster on November 20， 2020．．．spent part of the offseason working out in Colorado with fellow Twins staffmate Taylor Rogers and last night＇s pitcher Griffin Jax．

क Among all minor leaguers between 2017－21（min．180．0 IP），Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout－to－walk ratio，second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber（who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017－18 seasons）．

NO RUNS：Ober posted a miniscule 0.69 ERA（78．2 IP， 6 ER）in 2019，his most recent full profes－ sional season．．．his mark led all minor league pitchers（min． 75.0 IP）and he also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six－or－fewer earned runs in 78．2－or－more innings pitched since at least 1961 ．．．also marked the second－lowest single－season ERA by any minor
league pitcher since 1992 （min． 75.0 IP），trailing only Erasmo Ramírez＇s 0.51 ERA（88．0 IP， 5 ER） eague pitcher since 1992 （min
in 2009 for the VSL Mariners．
\＃82 IN YOUR PROGRAMS，\＃1 IN YOUR HEART：Ober is the first player in Twins history to wear uniform number 82．．．former hitting coach James Rowson is the only other uniformed personnel to wear \＃82， doing so while presiding over 2019＇s＂Bomba Squad．＂

SKOL TWINS：Ober attended Charlotte Christian School in Charlotte，North Carolina，where he was batterymates on the baseball team and friends with Vikings center Garrett Bradbury．．．Bradbury had just arrived in the Twin Cities for OTAs at the time of Ober＇s debut on May 18，and attended the game with his wife，Carson．．．Carson is also the older sister of Kansas City Royals №． 6 prospect Jackson Kowar．
