LAST START: Ober did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 9-6, 10-inning victory August 25 in Boston after tossing 5.0 shutout innings, yielding four hits and just one walk with a career-high-tying seven strikeouts...marked the second time in his career he struck out seven batters without giving up a run...also marked his third start with at least 5.0 shutout innings, joining his outings on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 shutout IP) and August 11 vs. Chicago-AL (5.1 shutout IP)...did not subtract her batters with a batter to the total seven batters... allow any extra-base hits in the outing...departed with a 4-0 lead, but Red Sox rallied off the Twins bullpen to force extras

START PRIOR: Ober was dealt his second career loss on August 17, as the Twins fell to Cleveland 3-1... allowed three runs (2 ER) on five hits (1 HR) over a career-high 6.0 innings of work, with no walks and three strikeouts...tossed 4.0 scoreless innings to start the game before allowing a two-run homer to Daniel Johnson in the fifth; another unearned run scored on a sacrifice fly by Wilson Ramos in the sixth...marked Ober's first career quality start and his third outing in which he did not allow a walk.

TAMING THE TIGER: Today marks Ober's second career start against Detroit...his lone start came on July 10 at Target Field...he did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 9-4 victory after allowing four runs on four hits, with two walks and four strikeouts.

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first 15 career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .182 batting average (4-for-22) with runners in scoring position and two outs, as well as a .244 (10-for-41) overall mark with RISP...has allowed multiple hits with runners in scoring position just once in his career, on July 20 at Chicago-AL (2-for-5)...in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, Ober held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position.

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after.

LOW TRAFFIC: Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019, good for an MiLB-best 11.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 75.0 IP)...that season, he also ranked second in the minors in WHIP (0.81) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.55), and was fifth in walks-per-9.0 IP (1.03).
 In 14 MLB starts this season, Ober has allowed 81 total base runners in 63.2 innings, good for an 11.45 base-runners-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also averaging 2.26 walks-per-9.0 IP while averaging 9.19 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP...he has walked just 16 batters compared to 62 strikeouts, recording a 4.06 strikeout-to-walk ratio...his 16 walks are tied for sixth fewest among all rookie pitchers this season (min. 48.0 IP).

CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts) from 2017-21...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020...spent part of the offseason working out in Colorado with fellow Twins staffmate Taylor Rogers and last night's pitcher Griffin Jax.

Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons). æ

NO RUNS: Ober posted a miniscule 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) in 2019, his most recent full profes-sional season...his mark led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) and he also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961...also marked the second-lowest single-season ERA by any minor league pitcher since 1992 (min. 75.0 IP), trailing only Erasmo Ramírez's 0.51 ERA (88.0 IP, 5 ER) in 2009 for the VSL Mariners.

#82 IN YOUR PROGRAMS, #1 IN YOUR HEART: Ober is the first player in Twins history to wear uniform number 82...former hitting coach James Rowson is the only other uniformed personnel to wear #82, doing so while presiding over 2019's "Bomba Squad."

SKOL TWINS: Ober attended Charlotte Christian School in Charlotte, North Carolina, where he was batterymates on the baseball team and friends with Vikings center Garrett Bradbury. Bradbury had just arrived in the Twin Cities for OTAs at the time of Ober's debut on May 18, and attended the game with his wife, Carson...Carson is also the older sister of Kansas City Royals No. 6 prospect Jackson Kowar.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOHN GANT (2021 SEASON: 4-8, 4.00 ERA // CAREER: 23-23, 3.85 ERA)

The Twins return to Target Field tomorrow as right-hander Gant is set to take the mound for game one of a two-game series against Chicago-NL., was dealt the loss from the Twins' 12-2 defeat on August 26 at Boston after allowing four runs on three hits over 4.0 innings, with three walks and three strikeouts...will make his fifth appearance and second start this season against the Cubs...is 1-0, 10.13 ERA (10.13 IP, 6 ER), with six walks and two strikeouts against Chicago-NL this year.
