THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their season-long nine-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in St. Louis, followed by a win in Cincinnati last night...today the Twins will continue the trip with the two-game series finale in Cincinnati...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Houston for four games from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 24-30 at home this season and 21-32 on the road...they are seeking their fourth sweep (note below) and ninth series victory of the season.

JUST INSIDE THE FOUL POLO, TWINS WIN: The Twins beat the Reds last night by a score of 7-5 at Great American Ball Park, scoring three runs in the top of the ninth...Kenta Maeda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded nine hits, two from both Mitch Garver and Luis Arraez...Garver nit his 12th home run and Jorge Polanco hit his 17th, a game-winning three-run shot in the top of the ninth inning...it was the fifth go-ahead homer for Polo this season.

© Last night marked the second time this season that the Twins have won when trailing after eight innings...the other time was June 10 vs. New York-AL when Minnesota scored four runs in the ninth inning (off Aroldis Chapman) to win by 7-5, highlighted by a game tying two-run homer from Josh Donaldson and a walk-off two-run homer from Nelson Cruz.

SWEEPS WEEK: The Twins are looking for their fourth sweep of the season this afternoon...their previous three sweeps of 2021 came against Baltimore in three games from May 24-26 at Target Field, three games in Texas from June 18-20 and four games against Detroit at Target Field from July 8-11...their only sweep of the Reds came in three games from July 6-8, 2001 at the Dome.

TWINS AND REDLEGS: Minnesota and Cincinnati are facing off this week for the third and fourth time this season...the Twins hosted the Reds for two games from June 21-22, splitting the series with scores of 7-5 (12 innings) and 7-10...the Twins are 15-15 all-time against the Reds, going 4-3 at Great American Ball Park, 3-5 at Target Field, 7-2 at the Metrodome and 1-5 at Cinergy Field.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The Twins have gone 6-6 in Interleague Play this season, going 2-1 at Milwaukee from April 1-4, 1-2 vs. Pittsburgh from April 23-25, 1-1 vs. Cincinnati from June 21-22, 1-2 at St. Louis last weekend and 1-0 at Cincinnati...after this series, their IL schedule is as follows: three vs. Milwaukee August 27-29, two vs. Chicago-NL August 31-September 1 and two at Chicago-NL September 21-22.

▼ Twins are 238-216 all-time in IL Play, the fifth-most wins in baseball, trailing Boston (274-184), New York-AL (268-189), Los Angeles-AL (251-206) and Oakland (247-213).

▼ Josh Donaldson is hitting .310 (153-for-494) with 27 doubles, 31 home runs, 98 RBI, 98 runs scored and a .957 OPS in 136 career IL games..his IL average ranks seventh among actives (minimum 300 plate appearances)...in his last 21 IL games, he is hitting .344 (21-for-61) with a 1.097 OPS, six doubles, five home runs and 17 RBI.

▼ Jorge Polanco is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with one double, two home runs, four RBI, two walks and an .884 OPS in his last seven games against the National League.

▼ Miguel Sanó has reached safely in 46 of his last 50 Interleague games, posting a .379 on-base percentage in those games (50 hits, 28 walks).

POLO'S A PRO: Jorge Polanco is hitting .364 (28-for-77) with four doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI, 15 runs scored, four walks, a .402 on-base percentage and a 1.091 OPS in his last 19 games...he enters today with a season-long seven-game hitting streak, going 12-for-33 (.364) with two doubles, three home runs and two walks during the streak.

CATCHING ON: After Mitch Garver's 12th home run last night, Twins catchers have now combined for 24 homers in 2021 (Ryan Jeffers - 9, Ben Rortvedt - 2, Williams Astudillo - 1), trailing only Tampa Bay's 25 for most in baseball...additionally, the 24 homers are the third-highest single-season total in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901), trailing the 44 in 2019 and 27 in 1963...Garver's homer passed the 23 that Twins catchers hit in 2009, which was highlighted by Joe Mauer's MVP season where he finished with 28 (4 as a DH and 1 as a PH).

SANÓ STORM: Miguel Sanó has reached base multiple times in six of his last seven games, posting a .515 on-base percentage in those seven...he's also batting .282 (11-for-39) with five doubles, two home runs, six RBI, nine runs scored, 10 walks, a .429 on-base percentage and a .993 OPS in his last 11 games.

AUSTIN MARTIN DEBUTS: Twins prospect Austin Martin made his Twins minor league debut with Double-A Wichita last night, leading off and playing shortstop for the Wind Surge...he went 1-for-3 with a run scored in Wichita's 6-5 victory over Midland...Martin was acquired on Friday from the Toronto Blue Jays along with right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson in exchange for right-handed pitcher José Berrios...in 56 games between Wichita and New Hampshire (Toronto) this season, he is hitting .281 (56-for-199) with 10 doubles, two triples, two home runs, 16 RBI, 37 walks, 44 runs scored, a .425 on-base percentage and an .807 OPS.

CONGRATS, M-RAD!: Twins Vice President of Player Personnel Mike Radcliff will be honored today at the East Coast Pro Showcase that he helped start roughly 20 years ago...nearly all the good prep players from the eastern half of the country attend each year...it's an opportunity for the players to be around scouts in the dugout, as each major league team sends 5-10 scouts to cover the event, giving high school players more visibility as they head into their senior season...he will be honored with a video tribute featuring several current and former players and from office personnel. and former players and front office personnel.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2019, Jerry Bell was inducted into the Twins Hall of Fame, becoming the 33rd member (Justin Morneau is set to become the 34th member on Saturday, September 25)...Bell was named the third president in Twins history in January 1987.

HBD, UNCLE MILTY: Former Twins left-handed pitcher Eric Milton is celebrating his 46th birthday today...Milton pitched six seasons for the Twins from 1998-2003, going 57-51, 4.76 ERA (987.1 IP, 522 ER) with 10 complete games, four shutouts, 269 walks, 715 strikeouts and earning an AL Ali-Star berth in 2001...he still ranks 15th on the club's all-time strikeout list (since 1961) and fifth among lefties, trailing Jim Kaat (1,824), Johan Santana (1,381), Frank Viola (1,214) and Francisco Liriano (788)...he pitched for the Reds from 2005-07, going 16-27, 5.83 ERA (370.1 IP, 240 ER) with 103 walks and 231 strikeouts...he was acquired by the Twins in February of 1998 along with SS Cristian Guzmán, P Danny Mota and OF Brian Buchanan from the Yankees, in exchange for 2B Chuck Knoblauch...Milton was eventually traded in December of 2003 to Philadelphia, in exchange for P Carlos Silva, IF Nick Punto and P Bobby Korecky.

LAST TIME OUT, DEBUT-STYLE: Today marks Barnes' second career start and appearance, after he made his major league debut for the Twins in the first game of the July 17 doubleheader in Detroit; took the 1-0 loss as the Twins were shut out in seven innings...allowed a leadoff homer to Robbie Grossman before settling in to toss 4.2 shutout innings, with Just four total hits allowed, one walk and one strikeout...marked the first Twins starting pitcher to allow a homer to the first batter he faced in his career since Hall-of-Famer Bert Blyleven did so against the Senators' Lee Maye on June 5, 1970.

Barnes became just the second pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) to make his major league debut as the starting pitcher in the first game of a doubleheader, joining Bert Cueto, who did so on June 18, 1961 at Chicago-AL (ND, 8.1 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB, 3 K).

Also became the second pitcher in Twins history to allow one-or-fewer runs in his debut and take the loss, joining Brad Havens on June 5, 1981 at Detroit (L, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 K).

LAST TIME OUT, SAINTS-STYLE: Barnes last pitched overall on July 28, starting for Triple-A St. Paul against Indianapolis at home...worked just 1.0 inning, allowing two runs on two hits, with a leadoff walk and one strikeout...was the second of two starts he made for the Saints during his recent stint down, alongside his outing on July 23 at Omaha (L, 4.2 IP, 7 H, 3 R/ER, HR, 3 BB, 3 K).

THE ARSENAL: As a pitcher who relies primarily on finesse and pinpoint location rather than overpowering speed, Barnes' fastball averages between 88-90 MPH...as a result, MLB's Statcast registered and labelled most of his fastballs as changeups or sinkers in his debut...with that caveat, here's a picture of the rookie's arsenal, per Baseball Savant.

SAINT PAUL SEASON SUMMARY: Barnes has gone 5-3, 4.24 ERA (63.2 IP, 33 ER) with 23 walks, 54 strikeouts, a 1.35 WHIP and a .257 (63-for-245) opponent batting average in 13 starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season.

 Made his season debut on May 5 at Omaha, earning his second career Triple-A victory while holding the Storm Chasers to three runs on seven hits, with no walks and two strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work; the Saints won 10-4.
 Four of his 13 starts have been quality, including a stretch of three-straight quality starts from May 26-June 8...posted a 0.95 ERA (19.0 IP, 2 ER) in that stretch.
 Tossed a season-high 7.0 innings on two occasions, May 26 at lowa (W, 7.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 7 K) and July 3 vs. Omaha (W, 7.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 3 K).
 Did not allow a home run until his seventh start of the season on June 13 vs. Omaha; permitted four longballs for the first time in his career and took the loss as the Saints fell 15-4... however, Barnes has allowed just six home runs in 63.2 innings of work this season, good for a 0.85 homers-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also yielded just 25 home runs in 361.1 career minor league innings; his 0.62 career homers-per-9.0 IP ratio is 18th best among all minor leaguers since 2017 (min. 360.0 IP).
 Threw at least 90 pitches in six of his 13 starts and struck out at least six batters in four starts.
 The Saints have gone 8-5 as a team in Barnes' 13 starts...since his professional debut on June 27, 2017 for the Rookie-Elizabethton Twins, Barnes' teams have gone 42-32 in games in which he pitches, including 42-30 in his starts.

CAREER RECAP: A fourth-round selection by the Twins in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Clemson University, Barnes has made a swift ascent through the Minnesota minor league system... here's a more in-depth look at his success at each level.

♣ In 2020, was an invite to Twins spring training, the first of career...was added to the Twins' 60-man Player Pool September 5 and spent the final month of season at the alternate training site in St. Paul, MN...also participated in Twins Fall Instructional League during October in Fort Myers, Fl.

♣ In 2019, posted a 7-8 record, 4.88 ERA (131.0 IP, 71 ER) in 26 appearances (25 starts), with 55 walks and 124 strikeouts across three levels of the Twins' system — Single-A Fort Myers (8 games/starts), Double-A Pensacola (14 games, 13 starts) and Triple-A Rochester (4 games/starts)...led all Twins minor league pitchers with 25 games started...his 124 strikeouts tied for fourth most in the organization and his 131.0 innings pitched were second...began the season at Single-A Fort Myers, where he went 3-2 with a 6.51 ERA (37.1 IP, 27 ER) before being promoted to Double-A Pensacola on May 27...transferred to Triple-A Rochester on August 9 and innished the season with the Red Wings...made four starts, posting a 6.75 ERA (18.2 IP, 14 ER).

♣ In 2018, spent the entire year with Single-A Fort Myers, going 6-6 with a 2.81 ERA (118.1 IP, 37 ER) in 23 starts...led all qualified Twins minor league pitchers in ERA; tied for third in starts and winning percentage, while ranking fifth in opponent batting average (260)...set a new career best with eight strikeouts in 4.2 innings on April 7, but took the loss after allowing five runs...posted a 1.50 ERA (30.0 IP, 5 ER) in June, followed by a 1.98 ERA (27.1 IP, 6 ER) in July.

♣ In 2017, made his professional debut for Rookie-Elizabethton...made six appearances for the E-Twins, allowing three runs in his first two starts (5.2 IP)...did not allow an earned run in his next four appearances (3 starts) over 17.0 IP (2 uncarned runs)...owne

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT: When he debuted, Barnes became the seventh player to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of three pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), RHP Bailey Ober (May 18), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2) and RHP Griffin Jax (June 8).
