THE TWINS: Have gone 4 -3 through seven games on their season-Iong nine-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in St. Louis, $1-1$ in Cincinnati and 2-0 in Houston...tonight the Twins will continue the trip with the third of four in Houston before concluding the series tomorrow...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel home to play a season-long nine-game homestand with three against the White Sox (August 9-11), three against the Rays (August 13-15) and three against the Indians (August 16-18)...th Twins have gone $24-30$ at home this season and $23-33$ on the road.
TWINS TAKE ASTROS IN EXTRAS: The Twins beat the Astros last night in Houston by a score of 5-4 in 11 innings... Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined to allow one unearned run over 6.0 innings sitched with three hits allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts..the oftense recorded eight hiits, highlighted by Mitch Garver's 13 tht home run and Jorge Polanco's 23 2rd
double Josh Donaldson went 1 -for-5 and drove in the winning run in the too of the 11 th inning. $\Phi$ After dropping their first eight extra-inning contests this season, the Twins have won eight of their last 10 games that have gone to extra frames...with the 11 -inning victory last night, they also improved to $2-1$ in games that went past the 10th inning.
TWINS-ASTROS: The Twins and Astros are playing each other tonight for the sixth of seven scheduled meetings in 2021...the Twins went 1-2 against Houston over a three-game series at Target Field from June 11-13...the Twins are 34-35 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 23-26 since Houston joined the American League in 20

43 RBI, 41 walks and a 1.029 OPS in 63 career games against the Astros... he has reached safely in 17 of his last 18 games vs. Houston.
玉 Andrelton Simmons has 83 career hits in 84 games against the Astros, his most against any opponent. 13 RBI and a . 933 OPS in 23 career regular season games vs. Houston.
$\Phi$ Twins are now 5-0 in the state of Texas this season (3-game sweep of the Rangers in Arlington from June 18-20, and wins in the first two games of this series in Houston).

SEEKING THE SERIES: The Twins are looking to win their ninth series of the season...they have gone 8-22-6 in series play this season, 4-12-1 at home and 4-10-5 on the road...their last series win was a four-game sweep of the Tigers at Target Field from July 8-11 and their last series win on the road was a three-game sweep of the Rangers in Arlington from June 18-20...their last series win over the Astros was April 29-May 2, 2019, taking three of four at Target Field...their last series win at Houston was August 11-13, 2014, taking two of three.
ARRAEZ AND SHINE: Luis Arraez has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games, hitting . 438 (14-for32) in that span...he is 8 -for-19 (.421) with three doubles and three walks in six games since being reinstated from the 10 -day injured List on July 31...beginning July 4, he has hit safely in 17 of 19 games, batting . 424 (28-for-66) with 12 runs scored, six doubles, five RBI, six walks, a . 466 on-base percentage and a . 981 OPS in that span.
USA WINS OLYMPIC BASEBALL SILVER: Team USA was shut out, 2-0, by host nation Japan earlier this morning in the gold medal game of the Tokyo Olympics, earning the silver...Twins top prospects Simeon Woods Richardson (No. 3) and Joe Ryan (No. 8) were on the USA roster; Woods Richardson did not appear in a game and Ryan went 1-0 with a 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts...former Twin Tyler Austin also played for
Team USA and batted . 417 (10-for-24) with five runs scored, three doubles, two homers and

 seven RBI in six games, winning All-Olympic Baseball Team honors at designated hitter for his performance.
REMEMBERING DON BAYLOR: Former Twin Don Baylor passed away on this day in 2017 at age 68 after his battle with cancer...the Twins acquired Baylor on August 31, 1987 in exchange for pitcher Enrique Rios...Baylor played 20 games for the Twins during the " 87 regular season, hitting. 286 (14-for-49) with six RBI.... he hit

## MICHAEL PINEDA

## Heght 6-7 Weight 280 <br> B/: R/R Age: 32 (1/18/1989 in Yaguate, DR)

2021: 4-6, 3.89 ERA CAREER: 57-52, 4.01 ERA
$\Phi$ Will make his 16th start and appearance of the season, the 164th of his career.
$\Phi$ Is making his second start of the season against Houston ( $0-1,6.75$ ERA), fourth as a Twin (0-2, 7.53 ERA) and 11th of his career (3-5, 5.18 ERA).
$\Phi$ Is 1-1, 3.00 ERA ( 15.0 IP, 5 ER ) with two walks and 12 strikeouts in three second half starts...
went 0-3, 8.10 ERA (16.2 IP, 15 ER) in his last four starts prior to the All-Star Break.


SECOND HALF TURNAROUND: Pineda is 1-1, 3.00 ERA (15.0 IP, 5 ER), two walks ( 1 intentional), 12 strikeouts and a $.241 / .267 / .397$ opponent slash line (14-for-58 with 6 doubles and 1 home run) in three starts since the All-Star Break...marks a return to form for "Big Mike," after he stumbled to an 0-3 mark with an 8.10 ERA (16.2 IP, 15 ER), three walks, eight strikeouts and a .387/.405/.627 opponent slash line (29-for-75 with 8 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs) in four starts from June 1-July 7.

LAST TIME OUT: Pineda was saddled with the 7-3 loss to Adam Wainwright and St. Louis last Sunday (August 1) at Busch Stadium....allowed three runs (2 earned) on five hits, with one walk (intentional) and three strikeouts over 4.0 innings...was lifted for a pinch-hitter in the top of the fifth with the Twins trailing 3-2 and the tying run at second base...go-ahead run scored off Pineda in the bottom of the fifth on a two-out throwing error by third baseman Luis Arraez, the culmination of a 10-pitch at-bat by Wainwright.
क Threw 52 strikes among his 68 pitches...strike percentage of $76.5 \%$ was second-best of the season, behind his $77.3 \%$ mark on April 10 vs. Seattle ( 75 pitches, 58 strikes).

START PRIOR: "Big Mike" took the mound July 26 vs. Detroit at Target Field and turned in his first quality start in exactly two months, limiting the Tigers to two runs (both on a Miguel Cabrera two-run homer in the sixth) on five hits over 6.0 innings in a game the Twins eventually won, 6-5 in 10 innings...did not walk a batter, while striking out six (his most since fanning 8 on May 26 vs. Baltimore).
$\Phi$ Blanked Detroit on three hits over the first 5.0 frames and retired 11 in a row before Jonathan Schoop singled with two outs in the sixth, immediately preceding Cabrera's homer.
$\Phi$ Departed with a 5-2 lead, but the Tigers rallied with a pair of homers off Minnesota's bullpen to force extra innings...Max Kepler delivered the walk-off winner for the Twins in the 10th.

MINNESOTA MIKE: Pineda has made 46 starts in a Twins uniform, going 17-11, 3.90 ERA (249.0 IP, 108 ER ) with a 4.46 strikeout-to-walk ratio ( $232 \mathrm{~K}, 52 \mathrm{BB}$ ) and a 1.18 WHIP ( 241 hits)...Minnesota is $27-19(.587)$ when he toes the rubber
$\Phi$ Big Mike's personal winning percentage (.607), team winning percentage, ERA, strikeout-to-walk ratio and WHIP with the Twins are all better than his overall career numbers: A personal .523 winning percentage (57-52) and a .521 team ledger (85-78) in 163 starts, with a 4.01 ERA (929.0 IP, 414 ER ), 4.40 strikeout-to-walk ratio ( $919 \mathrm{~K}, 209 \mathrm{BB}$ ) and a 1.19 WHIP ( 893 hits)

玉 His 4.7 WAR (per Fangraphs) since 2019 is 15 th among AL starters (min 240.0 IP).
HOUSTON PROBLEMS: Big Mike has struggled in three starts against the Astros since joining the Twins in 2019, going 0-2,7.53 ERA (14.1 IP, 12 ER), four walks, seven strikeouts and a $.371 / .406 / .629$ opponent slash line ( 23 -for- 62 with 7 2B and 3 HR)....Minnesota lost all three of those games.
\$ Pineda faced Houston on June 13 at Target Field in his final start prior to landing on the Injured List with right elbow inflammation....worked just 4.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits (including a 2-out, 2-run homer by Kyle Tucker in the fourth inning) with one walk and one strikeout, and was saddled with the 14-3 loss (the Astros scored 11 runs off Minnesota's bullpen).
क He is $3-5,5.18$ ERA (57.1 IP, 33 ER) in 10 career starts against the Astros, but has not earned a victory since June 30, 2017 at Minute Maid Park (while with the Yankees).
\$ Big Mike is 2-1, 3.08 ERA (26.1 IP, 9 ER) in four career starts here at Minute Maid Park. his Ione Twins start in this ballpark came April 23, 2019, a no-decision in a game Minnesota eventually lost, 10-4 (5.1 IP, 8 H, 4 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K).
$\Phi$ Pineda was on the Twins' roster for the 2020 American League Wild Card Series, but did not pitch.
ROCKY ROAD: Pineda will pitch on the road this evening for just the sixth time in 2021...has gone 2-3, 4.43 ERA (22.1 IP, 11 ER ) in his first five road starts this season, as compared to 2-3,3.67 (54.0 IP, 22 ER) in 10 starts at Target Field.

START 'EM WITH STRIKE ONE, THEN GET 'EM TO CHASE: Pineda ranks ninth in the American League (min. 75.0 IP) by pouring in strike one at a 66.9 percent clip...he has also induced opposing batters to chase, in any count, 34.0 percent of the time to rank in the 94th percentile among all big league hurlers...for his career, Big Mike owns a 65.4 percent first-strike rate and a 33.5 percent chase rate.

2021 ARSENAL: Below is a breakdown of Pineda's 2021 three-pitch repertoire, according to Baseball Savant, which follows a similar pattern to what he featured in 2020.
$\Phi$ Since his first start of the 2020 season, opponents are hitting .168 (23-for-137) with 56 strikeouts against Pineda's slider.
ד In two-and-a-half seasons with the Twins, he has used his four-seam fastball more than half the time $(53.5 \%$ in $2021,50.1 \%$ in $2020,54.1 \%$ in 2019)...after a career-high $59.5 \%$ use rate as a Mariners rookie, he never topped $47.7 \%$ as a Yankee.

## CAREER NOTES

- Missed last 21 games of 2019, the entire ALDS and the first 36 contests of 2020 due to a 60game suspension for violating MLB's Joint Drug and Prevention Treatment Program. - Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...also missed the entire 2012 campaign with New York-AL recovering from right shoulder surgery, and was out of the majors in 2013 while rehabbing
- Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200+ strikeouts in American League history.
- Was an AL All-Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners, posting a 3.03 ERA (113.0 IP, 38 ER ) with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of 198 in the first half, and finished the year fifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting.
- In 2011, he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters, and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka (Boston, 2007).
- Was signed by Seattle as a 16 -year-old undrafted free agent December 12, 2005...signed by Patrick Guerrero, brother of Fred Guerrero, Twins' Director of Latin American Scouting \& U.S. Integration.
- He owns a farm in his native Dominican Republic, where he raises chickens in addition to growing a number of crops.
