THE TWINS: Have gone 4-4 through eight games on their season-long nine-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in St. Louis, 1-1 in Cincinnati and 2-1 in Houston...today the Twins will complete the trip with the four-game series finale in Houston...after the game, the Twins will travel home to play a season-long nine-game homestand with three against the White Sox (Monday-Wednesday), three against the Rays (Friday-Sunday) and three against the Indians (August 16-18)...the Twins have gone 24-30 at home this season and 23-34 on the road.

TWINS SHUT OUT IN HOUSTON: The Twins lost to the Astros last night at Minute Maid Park by a score of 4-0, suffering their sixth shutout of the season...Michael Pineda (4-7) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched with no walks and three strikeouts...the offense collected just four hits, two going for extra-bases as Brent Rooker and Ryan Jeffers each hit their sixth doubles of the season.

TWINS-ASTROS: The Twins and Astros are playing each other today for the seventh and final time in 2021...the Twins have gone 3-3 against Houston this season, 1-2 at Target Field and 2-1 at Minute Maid Park...the Twins are 34-36 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 23-27 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .320 (71-for-222) with 16 doubles, two triples, 13 home runs, 43 RBI, 41 walks and a 1.029 OPS in 63 career games against the Astros...he has reached safely in 17 of his last 18 games vs. Houston.

☞ Andrelton Simmons has 83 career hits in 85 games against the Astros, his most against any opponent.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .319 (30-for-94) with four doubles, two triples, four home runs, 13 RBI and an .895 OPS in 24 career regular season games vs. Houston.

ADDITIONALLY: Polanco has nine home runs since July 4, tied with Cleveland's Franmil Reyes and Seattle's Kyle Seager for most in the American League since that date.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Twins are looking to win their ninth series of the season...they have gone 8-22-6 in series play this season, 4-12-1 at home and 4-10-5 on the road...their last series win was a four-game sweep of the Tigers at Target Field from July 8-11 and their last series win on the road was a three-game sweep of the Rangers in Arlington from June 18-20...their last series win over the Astros was April 29-May 2, 2019, taking three of four at Target Field...their last series win at Houston was August 11-13, 2014, taking two of three.

MAX POWER: Max Kepler has eight home runs in his last 30 games, tied for fourth most in the AL during that span (since July 4)...he is four away from tying Eddie Rosario for 15th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Double-A Wichita infielder Jermaine Palacios and Triple-A St. Paul left-handed pitcher Jovani Moran as the club's minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Palacios appeared in seven games for the Wind Surge, hitting .259 (7-for-27) with two doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, four walks and a 1.122 OPS...the 25-year-old was originally with the Twins organization from 2014-2017 and was traded to Tampa Bay in exchange for right-handed pitcher Jake Odorizzi in February of 2018...he re-signed with the Twins just prior to this season.

☞ Moran appeared in two games for the Saints this week, pitching 4.0 shutout innings with no hits allowed, no walks and seven strikeouts...the 24-year-old was originally selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft from the Carlos Beltrán Baseball Academy in Puerto Rico.

RORTVEDT CALLED GAME: Ben Rortvedt hit a pinch-hit, two-run walk-off homer in the 10th inning last night, leading Triple-A St. Paul to a 4-2 win over Louisville...the Saints were no-hit through the first six innings of the game and tied the score 2-2 in the bottom of the ninth before Rortvedt's walk-off blast in the following frame...Rortvedt is batting .295 (18-for-61) with five doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and 12 runs scored in 16 games for the Saints this season.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1974, the Twins game at Royals Stadium in Kansas City was briefly delayed in the middle of the game so fans and players could hear President Nixon's resignation speech; Twins won the game 3-2 in 14 innings on a Tony Oliva sacrifice fly scoring Rod Carew...in 1987, Hall of Famer Steve Carlton earned his 329th and final career win while wearing a Twins uniform, beating Oakland 9-2 with an 8.2-inning performance...in 1998, Paul Molitor stole his 500th career base in Minnesota's 6-3 loss to the Orioles, joining Ty Cobb, Honus Wagner, Eddie Collins and Lou Brock as the only players with 3,000+ hits and 500+ stolen bases (since joined by Rickey Henderson and Ichiro Suzuki).

LAST START: Maeda took a no-decision last Tuesday, August 3 in the series opener at Cincinnati, an eventual 7-5 Twins victory...allowed five runs on seven hits (3 HR), with one walk and nine strikeouts...pitched scoreless first and second innings before running into trouble in the third; allowed back-to-back home runs to Eugenio Suárez and Tucker Barnhart leading off the frame, before yielding consecutive doubles to Jonathan India and Jesse Winker later in the inning that pushed across a third Cincinnati run...began the fifth inning with a 4-3 lead but allowed a go-ahead, two-run homer to India and departed with a 4-5 deficit after 5.0 innings...the Twins scored thrice in the top of the ninth to win, 7-5...Maeda tied his season high of three home runs allowed for the third time and first since also yielding three longballs in consecutive starts April 21 at Oakland and April 27 at Cleveland...five runs allowed marked his most since giving up seven in his start on June 29 at Chicago-AL.

☞ Maeda went 1-for-2 with a run scored at the plate in the start...he joined Bailey Ober (1-for-2 on August 3) as the second Twins pitcher to record a hit this season, marking the first time the Twins had multiple pitchers with a hit in the same season since 2017 (Jose Berrios, Dietrich Enns, Ervin Santana)...Maeda also scored his second run this season; the last Twins pitcher to score multiple runs in a season was Kyle Gibson in 2018 (2 runs scored).

START PRIOR: Maeda did not factor into the decision on July 27 vs. Detroit, an eventual 6-5 Twins loss in 11 innings...he allowed one run on four hits (1 HR) over 6.1 innings, with two walks and five strikeouts in his fourth quality start of the season...the lone run he permitted came on an Akiel Baddoo two-out solo homer in the third inning...departed with a 5-1 lead; the Tigers tied the game with a four-run ninth and scratched another run across in the top of the 10th to win.

☞ Maeda finished July with a 2.15 ERA (29.1 IP, 7 ER) in five starts, his third-lowest ERA in any month in his career (min. 3 starts), trailing only his 1.41 ERA in April 2016 and his 1.71 ERA in June 2017...he allowed three-or-fewer runs in all five starts and recorded three of his four quality starts on the season during the month...his 2.15 ERA in his five July starts was nearly one-third of the 6.26 ERA (23.0 IP, 16 ER) that he posted in his previous five from May 16-June 29.

ASTRONOMICAL PERFORMANCES: Maeda is facing the Astros for the seventh time in his career this afternoon, but only the second time in the regular season...owns a combined 0-1, 3.38 ERA (16.0 IP, 6 ER) with one hold, seven walks and 12 strikeouts over six games (two starts) against Houston in the regular season and Postseason.

☞ Last pitched vs. the Astros when started in Game 1 of the 2020 American League Wild Card Series at Target Field in an eventual 4-1 Twins defeat...took a no-decision despite turning in 5.0 innings of two-hit, shutout ball, with three walks and five strikeouts.

☞ His lone regular season start vs. Houston came on August 4, 2018 at Dodger Stadium while pitching for Los Angeles-NL...shouldered the loss in a 14-0 Dodgers defeat, allowing five runs on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts over 5.1 innings of work...today marks his first regular season appearance at Minute Maid Park.

☞ Earned a hold in Game 6 of the 2017 World Series vs. the Astros after pitching a scoreless seventh inning, allowing one hit but nothing more...Los Angeles-NL won the game, 3-1, but lost the series (4-3) the following night.

ON THE ROAD (AGAIN): Maeda is making his 13th road start of the season, going 3-2, 5.80 ERA (59.0 IP, 38 ER) with 18 walks and 66 strikeouts in his 12 prior starts...this compares to the 1-2, 2.53 ERA (32.0 IP, 9 ER) with nine walks and 33 strikeouts he has in his six home starts this season...14 of the 16 home runs and 26 of the 36 extra-base hits he's allowed this season have come on the road.

MILESTONE MAN: Maeda surpassed two career milestones in his start against the Mariners in Seattle on June 14...at the end of his second inning of work he reached 700 career MLB innings, becoming the 10th Japanese-born pitcher to hit that plateau in the majors...the others are: Hideo Nomo (1,976.1 IP), Hiroki Kuroda (1,319.0 IP), Yu Darvish (1,255.2 IP), Tomo Ohka (1,070.0 IP), Masahiro Tanaka (1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma (883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka (790.1 IP), Masato Yoshii (757.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa (720.1 IP)...additionally, Maeda's strikeout of Shad Long Jr. in the fourth inning on June 14 was the 2,000th of his career...he now has 2,053 strikeouts combined between Nippon Professional Baseball (1,233) and Major League Baseball (820).

☞ Maeda's final strikeout on July 17 was the 800th of his major league career...he became just the fifth Japanese-born pitcher in major league history to reach 800 career strikeouts, joining Nomo (1,918), Darvish (1,546), Tanaka (991) and Kuroda (986).

☞ Maeda's seven career games with 10-plus strikeouts are fourth most among Japanese-born pitchers in major league history, behind Darvish (47), Nomo (31) and Tanaka (14).

2021 ARSENAL: Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last two seasons...he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his most frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020, followed by his split finger...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

☞ Ranks in the 92nd percentile with a 33.4 chase rate this season.

OPPOSING COUNTS: Opponents are hitting .415 (17-for-41) off Maeda's first offering of an at-bat...by contrast, opponents are batting .183 (35-for-191) off Maeda with two strikes, above the .087 (13-for-150) mark he held them to in 2020 and his career mark of .147 (238-for-1618)...the league average mark this season with two strikes is .164.

☞ When the count goes full, Maeda is holding opposing hitters to just 4-for-37 (.108), tied for the seventh-lowest mark among all major league pitchers (min. 35 opponent at-bats) and tied for third lowest among American League pitchers...since 2017, he's held hitters to a .133 (28-for-211) batting average on full counts, the second-lowest mark in the majors in that span (min. 200 opp. at-bats), behind only Jhoulys Chacin (.127).
