THE TWINS: Completed their season-long nine-game roadtrip with a record of 5-4, going 1-2 in St. Louis, 1-1 in Cincinnati and 3-1 in Houston...tonight the Twins will begin their season-long nine-game homestand with three against the White Sox from tonight-Wednesday, an off-day on Thursday, three against the Rays from Friday-Sunday and three against the Indians (August 16-18)...the Twins have gone 24-30 at home this season and 24-34 on the road.

TWINS FINISH TRIP STRONG IN HOUSTON: The Twins beat the Astros yesterday afternoon at Minute Maid Park by a score of 7-5, winning their ninth series (9-22-6) of the season and fifth on the road (5-10-5)...Kenta Maeda (5-4) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the Twins used five relievers as Danny Coulombe earned his first hold, Jorge Alcalá recorded his fifth hold and Alex Colomé saved his fifth game...the offense recorded 12 hits...Max Kepler went 3-for-6 and Jorge Polanco went 2-for-4 with two home runs and four RBI - his third career multi-homer game.

INSIDE THE TRIP: The Twins completed the trip with a 5-4 record, marking their fourth winning trip of the season; the previous three were April 1-7 (2-1 at Milwaukee & 2-1 at Detroit), May 20-23 (1-1 at Los Angeles-AL & 2-1 at Cleveland) and June 14-20 (1-2 at Seattle & 3-0 at Texas).

- ☞ The Twins completed the trip by winning three of four over the Astros, their first winning series in Houston since August 11-13, 2014.
- ☞ Individuals on the trip: Jorge Polanco hit .325 (13-for-40) with two doubles, five home runs and 10 RBI...Luis Arraez hit .458 (11-for-24) with three doubles, three RBI and four walks.
- ☞ The Twins collectively hit .291 (23-for-79) with runners in scoring position and hit nine home runs.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have placed right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcalá on the 10-day Injured List with triceps tendinitis...Alcalá has appeared in 45 games for the Twins this season, going 3-5, 5.11 ERA (44.0 IP, 25 ER), 11 walks and 43 strikeouts...this marks the right-hander's first career trip to the Injured List at the major league level...to replace Alcalá on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Edgar García from Triple-A St. Paul...García, who was claimed off waivers from Cincinnati on July 30, has appeared in four games for the Saints, going 2-0, 0.00 ERA (5.0 IP), two hits allowed, one walk and six strikeouts...the right-hander made his major league debut in 2019 for Philadelphia and has appeared in 46 career games across three MLB seasons with Philadelphia, Tampa Bay and Cincinnati, going 2-1 with a 7.14 ERA (46.2 IP, 37 ER), one save, 31 walks and 50 strikeouts.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the 17th of 19 meetings this season...Twins are 4-12 against the Sox in 2021, going 2-4 at Target Field and 2-8 at Guaranteed Rate Field...this series, Twins are looking to avoid their most losses against the Sox since going 4-14 in 2012.

- ☞ Max Kepler (15), former Twin Nelson Cruz (15) and Miguel Sanó (13) hold the top three spots in home runs against the White Sox since the start of 2019.
- ☞ The Twins have hit 80 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019, ahead of second place Cleveland's 53.
- ☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .293 (66-for-225) with 10 doubles, 20 home runs, 51 RBI, 43 walks and a 1.006 OPS in 65 career games vs. the White Sox.

ARRAEZ AND SHINE: Luis Arraez has hit safely in 19 of his last 21 games, hitting .437 (31-for-71) in that span, the best in baseball since July 4 (minimum 70 plate-appearances)...he is 11-for-24 (.458) with three doubles and four walks in eight games since being reinstated from the 10-day Injured List on July 31.

MIGGY BOMBAS: Miguel Sanó hit his 18th home run of the season yesterday afternoon and the 149th of his career, 14 short of Tom Brunansky's 163...Bruno ranks 10th on the club's all-time list (since 1961).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1997, Brad Radke's 12-decision win streak ended in a 4-1 loss to New York-AL at the Metrodome; Radke's streak is tied with Scott Erickson (April 21-June 24, 1991) for the second-longest winning decision streak by a starter in Twins history (since 1961)...also Happy Birthday to former Twins pitcher Pat Mahomes, father of current Royals part-owner and Kansas City Chiefs quarterback Patrick Mahomes.
