TWINS CAN'T COMPLETE FOUR-GAME SWEEP: The Twins lost to the Indians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 4-1, snapping their four-game winning streak...Andrew Albers (1-2) returned to the club, making the start while allowing three runs on six hits in 4.0 innings and was dealt the loss...the offense recorded just four hits, as Miguel Sanó homered for the second-straight night and third time in his last five games...the homer was his 26th of the season while the 42 degree launch angle was the highest of his career.

Bill Evers, who was the acting manager for the club, went 3-1 in Baldelli's absence...Rocco returns tonight after attending the birth of his baby girl, Louisa Sunny, late Monday night.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 14th of 19 meetings in 2021...
Twins are 6-7 against the Royals this season, going 3-3 at Target Field and 3-4 at Kauffman Stadium...their last series was at Kauffman Stadium from July 2-4, as the Twins lost the first two and avoided the three-game sweep with a win in game three...their last series at Target Field was from May 28-30, as the Twins won just the second game of the three-game series.

★ The Twins have homered 22 times against KC this season, the most against the Royals in 2021.

★ Miguel Sanó has 19 career home runs against the Royals, including two this season, both at Kansas City...he has 64 career RBI against KC, his most vs. any opponent.

★ Luis Arraez is hitting .351 (27-for-77) with four doubles, one triple, five RBI, 11 walks and a .444 OBP in 21 career games vs. KC this season, one on May 2 and one on July 4.

★ Josh Donaldson is hitting .324 (24-for-74) with 12 doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, eight walks, a .398 on-base percentage and a 1.006 OPS in his last 19 games against KC.

★ Jorge Polanco is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with five doubles in 12 games against KC this season...he has multiple hits in seven of those 12.

FIREMEN ON FIRE: In its last 13 games, since August 27, the Twins bullpen has posted a 0.92 ERA (49.0 IP, 5 ER) with 33 hits allowed, 14 walks, 51 strikeouts, a .191 opponent batting average and a .570 opponent OPS...below are the bullpen's rankings in baseball since that date:

▼ Tyler Duffey has posted a 1.08 ERA (8.1 IP, 1 ER) with an 11.88 K/9.0 IP in his last 10 games.

▼ 13 of Juan Minaya's last 14 appearances have been scoreless, posting a 0.98 ERA (18.1 IP, 2 ER) with 23 strikeouts and a .156 opponent batting average in that span.

▼ Eight of Jorge Alcala's last nine appearances have been scoreless, posting a 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER) with 14 strikeouts and a .179 opponent batting average in that span.

▼ Alexander Colomé has gone 2-0, 2.08 ERA (17.1 IP, 4 ER) with a .203 opponent batting average in his last 18 games...he leads baseball in saves with 11 since August 1 (13 opportunities).

▼ 12 of Luke Farrell's 14 appearances on the season have been scoreless...on the season, he has gone 1-0, 1.56 ERA (17.1 IP, 3 ER) with one home run allowed and a .203 opponent BA.

▼ Ralph Garza Jr. has posted a 1.80 ERA (15.0 IP, 3 ER) with seven walks, 14 strikeouts and a .140 opponent batting average in his last 12 games.

REMEMBERING 9/11: Tomorrow on the 20th anniversary of September 11, 2001, the Twins and Royals will join Major League Baseball and all 30 Clubs to remember and honor those we lost on that tragic day, the heroism of all who sacrificed their own lives to save others, those who died from illnesses obtained at Ground Zero, and those who continue to bravely serve our communities and country...starting at approximately 5:50 p.m., special pre- and in-game elements are scheduled to include:

The placing of six wreaths placed behind the pitcher's mound, commemorating lives lost and each representing a different group (Law Enforcement, Firefighters, Emergency Medical Services, United States Armed Forces, American Citizens and International Citizens).

A special in-ballpark element will be in place throughout the game in remembrance of the 13 U.S. service members killed on August 27 in an attack near the Kabul airport in Afghanistan.

Other elements include video excerpts, ceremonial first pitches, Twins Territory and American flag raising, the National Anthem, a flyover and more.

LAST TIME OUT: Jax did not factor into the decision in his last start on September 5 at Tampa Bay; the Twins won, 6-5, thanks to Nick Gordon's RBI knock in the top of the ninth that drove in the go-ahead run...Jax yielded four runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts in the outing...pitched Scoreless first and second innings before running into trouble in the third, allowing a two-run homer to Brandon Lowe...worked around a pair of one-out singles in the fourth to complete a scoreless frame... yielded a two-out RBI single to Nelson Cruz in the fifth and departed in favor of Caleb Thielbar with the Twins still ahead, 4-3; Thielbar allowed a go-ahead homer to Austin Meadows, with one of the runs being charged to Jax.

START PRIOR: Jax took the loss on August 29 vs. Milwaukee, as the Twins fell 6-2...yielded six runs on six hits (2 HR), with three walks and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...tossed a career-high 100 pitches, doing so for the first time in his professional career — majors or minors...worked a one-two-three first inning before permitting a one-out solo shot to Luis Urías in the second...ran into two-out trouble in the third, as he allowed a double to Christian Yelich, walked Omar Narváez and permitted a three-run homer to Rowdy Tellez...yielded two more tallies in the fourth and worked a scoreless fifth before departing.

4 Jax has tossed at least 5.0 innings in six of his nine career starts to date, including a pair of quality starts (August 10 and August 16).

CENTRAL COMMAND: Jax is due to face the Royals for the second time in his career tonight, after starting in Kansas City on July 3, his first career start (fifth appearance)...took the loss after allowing six runs on eight hits (1 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...tonight marks his sixth career appearance and fifth start against the American League Central division, and he's 2-1, 5.33 ERA (25.1 IP, 15 ER) with nine walks and 24 strikeouts in his prior outings...six of the earned runs he's yielded to the division came in his start on July 3 at Kansas City, and he's permitted just three runs (June 25 vs. CLE, relief and August 10 vs. CWS, start), two earned runs (August 16 vs. CLE, start) and one run (July 19 at CWS, start) in his other four outings...additionally, both of Jax's quality starts have come against the division, on August 10 vs. Chicago-AL and August 16 vs. Cleveland.

STRONG STRETCH: In five starts between July 19-August 16, Jax went 2-0, 2.73 ERA (26.1 IP, 8 ER), seven walks, 21 strikeouts and a .188 (18-for-96) opponent batting average...that run came in the wake of allowing six earned runs in his first career start on July 3 at Kansas City...his opponent batting average in that span ranked third in the majors (min. 95 AB), behind Los Angeles-NL's Walker Buehler (.179) and Seattle's Marco Gonzales (.184)...his .248 opponent on-base percentage also ranked third in the majors under those same criteria in that span, behind St. Louis's Adam Wainwright (.226) and Gonzales (.238).

ROOKIE SUCCESS: Jax did not factor into the decision on August 16 vs. Cleveland, as the Twins defeated the Indians, 5-4, in 10 innings on Jorge Polanco's walk-off double...1sx recorded his second career quality start (and second consecutive), after allowing four runs (2 ER) on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts over a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of work...the following night, August 17, fellow rookie starting pitcher Bailey Ober also recorded a quality start, marking the first time the Twins had quality starts by rookies in back-to-back games since August 18-19, 2012 vs. Seattle, when Scott Diamond (August 18; 6.2 IP, 2 ER) and Samuel Deduno (August 19; 6 D IP 2 ER) each did so

- 6.0 IP, 2 ER) each did so.

 Tonight marks Jax's 10th start of the season...paired with Ober (17 starts this season), they become the first Twins rookie duo each having at least 10 starts in the same season, since Trevor May (16 starts) and Tyler Duffey (10 starts) in 2015.

 Jax is also holding opposing hitters to a .171 (20-for-117) batting average with two strikes, the lowest mark by a Twins rookie pitcher (min. 115 opp. AB) since Ryan Pressly (.138) in 2013.

EARLY DOMINANCE: Jax is holding opposing hitters to a .178 (18-for-101) batting average the first time through the lineup so far in his major league career...this increases to .292 (26-for-89) the second time around and jumps further to .385 (15-for-39) the third time he sees opposing hitters... these stats correspond to his numbers in each respective inning, as he is holding opposing hitters to a .157 (16-for-102) batting average in the first three innings combined...this compares to the .333 (35-for-105) mark opponents have against him in innings four to six.

THE ARSENAL: Jax has used four different offerings so far in his major league career, relying primarily on

ACROSS THE RIVER: Jax did not play an official professional game in 2020 and was not part of the Twins' 60-man player pool...participated in the Twins Fall Instructional League in Fort Myers in October 2020...opened 2021 in the rotation for Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-1, 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER) in five starts during May...did not pitch upon being optioned to the Saints on June 16 and returned to the Twins on June 24...made one start for the Saints during his most recent Triple-A stint, on July 25 at Omaha (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/ER, 1 BB, 5 K).

Pitched at least 5.0 innings in all seven of his Triple-A starts, while holding opponents to one-or-

- zero runs in five of his seven starts...went 4-1, 3.32 ERA (38.0 IP, 14 ER) overall with the Saints.

 The line his final Triple-A start before his first major league stint on May 28 at lowa, established
- a career high across any level with 10 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-hit, shutout ball (2 walks)...matched the 10 strikeouts at the major league level on August 10 vs. Chicago-AL.
