TWINS SPLIT THE DAY WITH CLEVELAND: The Twins and Indians split the doubleheader yesterday at Target Field as Minnesota lost the first game by a score of 3-1 and won the second game, 6-3...Joe Ryan was the game one starter, allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, walking one and striking out five...he left the game in the top of the sixth inning after getting struck in the right wrist by a Myles Straw line drive...the offense recorded just three hits in the first game, including doubles from Andrelton Simmons (200th of career) and Josh Donaldson (250th of career)...the game two starter was 29th man Charlie Barnes, as he allowed three runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined for 3.0 scoreless innings as Kyle Barraclough (1-0) earned his first win as a Iwin...the offense recorded nine hits in the season.

BOB FELLER ACT OF VALOR AWARD: The Twins, in conjunction with the Bob Feller Act of Valor Award Foundation, announced vesterday that tonight's starter Griffin Jax has been named the 2021 MLB winner of the Bob Feller Act of Valor Award...Jax embodies the duality of love for baseball and service to the United States that was so crucial to the character of the late Hall-of-Famer Bob Feller...Jax was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft and, when he made his major league debut on June 8, became the first Air Force Academy graduate to play in the majors...he completed his two-year active duty commitment in 2019 and maintains the rank of Captain in the Air Force Reserves.

TWINS AND TRIBE: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 19th and final time in 2021...the Twins have gone 11-7 against Cleveland this season, going 5-3 at Target Field and 6-4 at Progressive Field...the Twins have won consecutive season series against the Indians (also 7-3 in 2020) for the tirst time since winning three straight from 2008-10.

♣ Since the start of 2020, 24 of the 28 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 13 have been decided by two runs-or-less...five of the 16 meetings this season have gone extra innings (Iwins are 3-2).

♣ Miguel Sanó has 10 home runs in his last 24 games against Cleveland.

♣ In 63 career games against the Indians, Josh Donaldson is hitting .292 (70-for-240) with nine doubles, two triples, 14 home runs, 48 RBI, 33 walks and a .898 OPS.

♣ The Twins are looking to win their 12th game against Cleveland this season...the club record (since 1961) is 13, done in 1963:

CLEMENTE DAY: Major League Baseball is celebrating Roberto Clemente Day today, honoring the late Hall-of-Famer's achievements on the field as well as hit humanitarian work off the field...Twins players wearing uniform number 21 will be left-handed pitcher Joyani Moran and right-handed pitcher Tyler Duffey (his usual number)...Moran is a native of Mayaguez, Puerto Rico.

CATCHING ON: Ryan Jeffers has caught 75 games for the Twins this season, including making 68 starts, both the most among all rookies in baseball...he currently ranks sixth on the Twins' all-time list (since 1961) for games caught by a rookie, trailing Butch Wynegar (137 in 1976), Mark Salas (115 in 1985), Matt Walbeck (95 in 1994), Tim Laudner (93 in 1982) and Mitch Garver (86 in 2018).

Additionally, among all AL rookies, he ranks eighth with 13 home runs, a Twins rookie record for a catcher.

SERIOUS ABOUT THE SERIES: The Twins are looking to win their 15th series of the season... they have gone 14-26-6 in series play this season, 8-14-1 at home and 6-12-5 on the road... the Twins have gone 6-5-0 in series play since August 5, with four of the five series victories coming against first-place teams (Houston, Chicago-AL, Tampa Bay and Milwaukee)...the Twins are 4-1 in series play against the Indians this season...their last series win over the Indians came in four games (3-1) at Progressive Field from September 6-9...their last series victory over Cleveland at Target Field came in three games (2-1) from August 16-18.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS/SENATORS HISTORY: In 1876, Nick Altrock was born; he made his major league debut in 1898 and served a variety of roles with the Senators between 1909-33 as a player and part-time coach, becoming one of two players in MLB history to play in five different decades (also Minnie Miñoso)...in 2002, the Twins clinched the AL Central Division title with a 5-0 win over Cleveland at then-Jacobs Field, marking the Twins first playoff appearance since 1991...they also won the division in the next two seasons...in 2017, the Twins celebrated Big Sexy Night as Bartolo "Big Sexy" Colón made the start...Colón allowed four runs on five hits in 6.0 innings as the Twins lost to the Blue Jays by a score of 4-3.

WIN SURGE: Double-A Wichita is currently in first place trailed by Arkansas (3.0 GB) who they play a six-game series against this week...the team needs to win just two games at home to clinch a postseason berth in the Double-A Central playoffs...Wichita ranks first league-wide in strikeouts (1,161) and are second in batting average (.256) and third in home runs (146).
