LAST TIME OUT: Jax last started on Friday, September 10 vs. Kansas City, taking a no-decision as the Twins fell to the Royals, 6-4, in 11 innings...allowed four runs on five hits ( $1 H R$ ), with one walk and four strikeouts in a career-high-tying 6.0 innings...yielded a three-run homer to Andrew Benintendi in the opening frame, the first first-inning runs allowed in his young career....yielded another run on a Michael A. Taylor two-out RBI double in the fourth...threw 75 percent of his pitches for strikes (57-of-76), a new career high strike percentage, besting his 73.9 percent mark in his major league debut.

START PRIOR: Jax did not factor into the decision on September 5 at Tampa Bay; the Twins won, 6-5, thanks to Nick Gordon's RBI knock in the top of the ninth that drove in the go-ahead run...Jax yielded four runs on six hits ( 1 HR ), with one walk and three strikeouts in the outing...pitched scoreless first and second innings before running into trouble in the third, allowing a two-run homer to Brandon Lowe...yielded a two-out RBI single to Nelson Cruz in the fifth and departed in favor of Caleb Thielbar with the Twins still ahead, 4-3; Thielbar allowed a go-ahead homer to Austin Meadows, with one of the runs being charged to Jax.

COUNTER CLEVELAND: Jax is due to face the Indians for the third time in his career, making his second start...has gone 1-0, 4.35 ERA ( 10.1 IP, 5 ER), two walks, five strikeouts and a .250 (10-for40) opponent batting average in those two prior outings, both of which occurred at Target Field...
$\Phi$ Last pitched against Cleveland on August 16, recording his second career quality start after yielding four runs (2 ER) on seven hits ( 1 HR ), with two walks and three strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work; did not factor into the decision as the Twins won, 5-4, in 10 innings
$\Phi$ Prior to that start, tossed 4.1 innings in relief on June 25 vs. Cleveland ( $3 \mathrm{H}, 3 \mathrm{R} / E R, 1 \mathrm{HR}, 2$ $\mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{~K}$ ) and earned his first career win as the Twins emerged victorious, 8-7, over the Indians.
COMMAND CENTRAL: Tonight marks Jax's seventh career appearance and sixth start against an American League Central division opponent, going 2-1, 5.46 ERA (31.1 IP, 19 ER), 10 walks and 28 strikeouts in those outings... is 2-0, 4.84 ERA (22.1 IP, 12 ER) in four games ( 3 starts) vs. the AL Central at Target Field, compared to 0-1, 7.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 7 ER ) in two divisional road starts.

STRONG STRETCH: In five starts between July 19-August 16, Jax went 2-0, 2.73 ERA (26.1 IP, 8 ER), seven walks, 21 strikeouts and a .188 (18-for-96) opponent batting average...that run came in the wake of allowing six earned runs in his first career start on July 3 at Kansas City...his opponent batting average in that span ranked third in the majors (min. 95 AB ), behind Los Angeles-NL's Walker Buehler (.179) and Seattle's Marco Gonzales (.184)...his . 248 opponent on-base percentage also ranked third in the majors under those same criteria in that span, behind St. Louis's Adam Wainwright (.226) and Gonzales (.238).

ROOKIE SUCCESS: Jax did not factor into the decision on August 16 vs. Cleveland, as the Twins defeated the Indians, 5-4, in 10 innings on Jorge Polanco's walk-off double....Jax recorded his second career quality start (and second consecutive), after allowing four runs (2 ER) on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts over a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of work...the following night, August 17, fellow rookie starting pitcher Bailey Ober also recorded a quality start, marking the first time the Twins had quality starts by rookies in back-to-back games since August 18-19, 2012 vs. Seattle, when Scott Diamond (August 18; 6.2 IP, 2 ER) and Samuel Deduno (August 19; 6.0 IP, 2 ER) each did so.
$\Phi$ Tonight marks Jax's 11th start of the season...paired with Ober (18 starts this season), they become the first Twins rookie duo each having at least 11 starts in the same season since the rookie quartet of Samuel Deduno (15 starts), Cole De Vries (16 starts), Scott Diamond (16 starts) and Liam Hendriks ( 16 starts) each did so in 2012.
$\Phi$ Jax is also holding opposing hitters to a 172 (22-for-128) batting average with two strikes, the lowest mark by a Twins rookie pitcher (min. 115 opp. AB) since Ryan Pressly (.138) in 2013.

EARLY DOMINANCE: Jax is holding opposing hitters to a .183 (20-for-109) batting average the first time through the lineup so far in his major league career...this increases to .296 (20-for-109) the second time around and jumps further to .333 ( $15-$ for- 45 ) the third time he sees opposing hitters... these stats correspond to his numbers in each respective inning, as he is holding opposing hitters to a. 159 (18-for-113) batting average in the first three innings combined...this compares to the .325 (38-for-117) mark opponents have against him in innings four to six.
$\Phi$ The three runs Jax allowed in the first inning of his last start were the first he has permitted in the opening frame in his major league career...despite the tallies, he's still holding opposing hitters to a 111 (4-for-36) batting average in the first inning in his career.
THE ARSENAL: Jax has used four different offerings so far in his major league career, relying primarily on his four-seam fastball...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire, per Baseball Savant.

ACROSS THE RIVER: Jax did not play a professional game in 2020 and was not part of the Twins' 60man player pool...participated in the Twins Fall Instructional League in Fort Myers in October 2020... opened 2021 in the rotation for Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-1, 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER) in five starts June 24...made one start for the Saints during his most recent Triple-A stint, on July 25 at Omaha ( 6.0 IP, $5 \mathrm{H}, 3 \mathrm{R} / \mathrm{ER}, 1 \mathrm{BB}, 5 \mathrm{~K}$ ) and went 4-1, 3.76 ERA ( $40.2 \mathrm{IP}, 17 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in eight starts overall for the Saints.
