THE TWINS: After completing their three-game series against Cleveland at Target Field with
a record of 1-2 earlier this week, the Twins began their five-game, six-day roadtrip with a win
in Toronto last nighttoday they will play the second of three against the Blue Jaysfollowing in
tomorrow's series finale, they will travel to Chicago to enjoy an off-day on Monday, followed
by two games against the Cubs at Wrigley Field on Tuesday and Wednesdaythe Twins have
gone 34-40 at home this season and 31-43 on the road.

ROGER THAT: Twins have won eight-straight games at Rogers Centre (since August 27, 2017), their longest winning streak in this ballpark, surpassing their previous high of seven, done from April 5, 2002-May 17, 2004...below are the club's all-time longest winning streaks in opposing ballparks (since 1961):

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed outfielder Rob Refsnyder on the 10-day Injured List with right elbow impingement...Refsnyder has played in 51 games, hitting .245 (34-for-139) with seven doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, 17 walks and a .325 on-base percentage...to replace Refsnyder on the 28-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of infielder Drew Maggi (pronounced MAJ-ee) from Triple-A St. Paul...the 32-year-old has played in 86 games for the Saints this season, hitting .261 (74-for-284) with 12 doubles. 16 home runs, 48 RBI, 36 walks, a .364 on-base percentage and an .850 OPS...the 6-foot, 192-pound infielder has spent the last three years in the Twins' organization after originally signing a minor league contract prior to the 2019 season...additionally, the Twins have transferred left-handed pitcher Taylor Rogers to the 60-day Injured List (left middle finger sprain).

TWINS AND JAYS: The Twins are playing the second of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season...they will host the Jays for four games at Target Field from September 23-26...the Twins have gone just 27-42 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 9-3 in their last 12, dating back to May 2, 2018.

Byron Buxton is hitting .322 (19-for-59) with five doubles, five home runs. 13 RBI and a 1.026 OPS in 15 career games vs. the Jays...he is hitting .345 (10-for-29) at Rogers Centre.

Jorge Polanco is hitting .356 (31-for-87) with eight doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, 10 walks, a .423 on-base percentage and a 1.009 OPS in 22 career games against the Jays...he has reached safely in 11 straight against Toronto, hitting .524 (22-for-42) with eight walks and a .600 on-base percentage in that span.

Josh Donaldson has 64 home runs in 247 career games and 913 career at-bats at Rogers Centre...his 14.27 at-bats-per-home run ratio at this ballpark is the third-highest ever in Toronto (minimum 900 at-bats), trailing José Bautista (14.18) and Carlos Delgado (14.26)...additionally, he is tied with Shawn Green for seventh most homers all-time at Rogers Centre.

POWER PLAYS: The Twins enter today fourth in baseball in home runs with 210...since the start of 2019, they have hit 608, the most in baseball...below are where the Twins and Blue Jays rank this season (left), where they rank since the start of 2019 (center) and the team percentage of hits that have been home runs in 2021 (right):

BYE BYRON: Byron Buxton is hitting .325 (27-for-83) with nine doubles, nine home runs. 14 RBI, a .759 slugging percentage and a 1.115 OPS in 21 road games this season...among all players in baseball with a minimum of 75 road at-bats, he ranks first in slugging percentage and OPS, and ninth in batting average.

© In fact, since August 5, 2020, he is hitting .345 (48-for-139) with 11 doubles, 18 home runs, 28 RBI and a 1.181 OPS in 36 road games.

BIRTHDAY SHOUTS: Twins reliever Juan Minaya is celebrating his 31st birthday today,..he has never appeared on his birthday at the major league level...also celebrating birthdays today are Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Beau Burrows, who turns 25 and Twins area scout Joe Bisenius, who turns 39.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1975**, Harmon Killebrew hit the 573rd and final home run of his career in a Kansas City Royals uniform off Minnesota's Eddie Bane at Metropolitan Stadium...in **1980**, Gary Ward became the sixth Twins player to hit for the cycle (11 now — last being Jorge Polanco on April 5, 2019 at Philadelphia) in a 9-8 loss at Milwaukee.

LAST START: Ober did not factor into the decision in his last start, of the Twins' 5-3 defeat on September 12 in the series finale against Kansas City...allowed three runs on three hits (1 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts over 4.1 innings...marked his second career start with no walks and at least six strikeouts, previously done June 16 at Seattle (also 6 K)...allowed single tallies in the first and second innings, and departed with two on, one out in the fifth; an inherited run then scored off Jovani Moran, who made his major league debut...the Twins tied the game at 3-3 in the sixth, but the Royals scored twice more in the eighth and ninth innings to win.

START PRIOR: Ober did not factor into the decision in the Twins' 5-2 victory on September 6 at Cleveland...allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR) over 4.0 innings of work, with no walks and four strikeouts...gave up a two-run home run to Franmil Reyes in the fourth inning, the only two runs Ober allowed during his start.

NEW OPPONENTS MEANS NEW OPPORTUNITY: Today will be Ober's first career start and appearance against Toronto...has only faced the American League East division once in his career on August 25 at Boston...did not factor into the decision despite pitching 5.0 scoreless innings, with one walk and a career-high-tying seven strikeouts.

- HEATING UP: Ober is 1-1, 2.95 ERA (39.2 IP, 13 ER) with four walks and 42 strikeouts across his last eight starts, lowering his season ERA from 5.19 to 4.12 in that time span...also owns a 1-0 record and 2.40 ERA (15.0 IP, 4 ER) with just one walk and 16 strikeouts in his last three starts on the road.

 © Ober enters today's start with a professional career high of 99.0 innings pitched this season between the Twins (83.0 IP) and Triple-A St. Paul (16.0 IP), surpassing his previous high of 78.2 innings amassed in 2019 across three levels of Minnesota's minor league system.

 © The Twins have won six of Ober's last eight starts, while the team stands at 11-7 in his 18 starts overall.

 © Ober's 10.50 strikeout-to-walk ratio since July 31 is second in the majors (min. 35.0 IP), behind only Los Angeles-NL's Max Scherzer (14.40).

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his 18 career major league starts, Oher is holding opponents to a .160 batting average (4-for-25) with runners in scoring position and two outs, as well as a .240 (12-for-50) overall mark with RISP..his opponent batting average with RISP and two outs this season is the lowest by a Twins rookie pitcher (min .25 opp. AB) since Samuel Deduno's .107 (3-for-28) mark in 2012...has allowed multiple hits with runners in scoring position just once in his career, on July 20 at Chicago-AL (2-for-5)...in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, Ober held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position.

This 5.0 walk percentage ranks in the 94th percentile of all pitchers while his 31.6% chase rate ranks in the 84th percentile and his 25.5 strikeout percentage ranks in the 62nd percentile.

THAT'S ALRIGHT: Ober has held right-handed batters to a .240 (40-for-167) batting average, with five doubles, three triples, nine home runs, five walks and 49 strikeouts, as compared to a .288 (44-for-153) batting average, with eight doubles, eight homers, 12 walks and 38 strikeouts by left-handed batters in his MLB career.

SKOL TWINS: Ober attended Charlotte Christian School in Charlotte, North Carolina, where he was batterymates on the baseball team and friends with Vikings center Garrett Bradbury. Bradbury had just arrived in the Twin Cities for OTAs at the time of Ober's debut on May 18, and attended the game with his wife, Carson...Carson is also the older sister of Kansas City Royals No. 5 prospect Jackson Kowar, who made his major league debut for Kansas City on June 7.

WALKING TALL: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins and Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or Washington...the last pitcher 6-9-or-taller to make at least 18 starts was Chris Young (6-10), who started 18 times for the Kansas City Royals in 2015...the other pitchers 6-8-or-taller to play for the Twins are:

 Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, Single-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
