**THE TWINS:** After completing their three-game series against Cleveland at Target Field with a record of 1-2 earlier this week, the Twins began their five-game, six-day roadtrip by splitting the first two games in Toronto on Friday and Saturday...today they will play the three-game series finale against the Blue Jays...following today's game, they will travel to Chicago to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, followed by two games against the Cubs at Wrigley Field on Tuesday and Wednesday...the Twins have gone 34-40 at home this season and 31-44 on the road.

**NO CANADA:** The Twins lost to the Blue Jays yesterday afternoon at Rogers Centre by a score of 6-2...Bailey Ober (2-3) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded just four hits, highlighted by Josh Donaldson's two-run home run in the first inning...it marked Donaldson's 24th homer of the season and second this series...it also marked the 249th of Donaldson's career.

**TWINS AND JAYS:** The Twins are playing the third of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season...they will host the Jays for four games at Target Field from September 23-26...the Twins have gone just 27-43 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 9-4 in their last 13, dating back to May 2, 2018...they are looking to win their fourth-straight series at the Rogers Centre, a streak that stretches back to August of 2017.

Byron Buxton is hitting .317 (20-for-63) with five doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI and a .993 OPS in 16 career games vs. the Jays...he is hitting .333 (11-for-33) at Rogers Centre.  
 Jorge Polanco is hitting .344 (31-for-90) with eight doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, 11 walks, a .416 on-base percentage and a .983 OPS in 23 career games against the Jays...he has reached safely in 12 straight against Toronto, hitting .489 (22-for-45) with nine walks and a .574 on-base percentage in that span.

Josh Donaldson has six hits in his last 14 at-bats (.429) against the Blue Jays, including two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, six runs scored and three walks in that span.

**#OLDFRIEND:** Today's Jays starter José Berríos was traded by Minnesota to Toronto on July 30, in exchange for infielder/outfielder Austin Martin (Twins No. 2 prospect per MLB.com) and right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson (Twins No. 4 prospect per MLB.com) — both currently with playoff-bound Double-A Wichita...Berríos was selected by the Twins in the first round (32nd overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft out of Papa Juan High School in Bayamon, Puerto Rico...the 27-year-old pitched for the Twins from 2016-21, going 55-43, 4.08 ERA (781.1 IP, 354 ER), 253 walks and 779 strikeouts in 136 games (135 starts)...below is more on Berríos' time in Minnesota:  
 Ranks 12th on Twins all-time list (since 1961) in strikeouts and 15th in wins.  
 Two-time American League All-Star in 2018 and 2019.  
 Joseph W. Haynes Award winner as Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2018.  
 Carl R. Pohlad Award winner for outstanding community service in 2018.  
 Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year in 2014 and '15.

**TWINS ML WEEKLYS:** The Twins have named Single-A Cedar Rapids first baseman Aaron Sabato and Cedar Rapids left-handed pitcher Louie Varland as the minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.  
 Sabato, 22, played in seven games for the Kernels, hitting .292 (7-for-24) with four home runs, six RBI, six walks, a .792 slugging percentage and a 1.211 OPS, including two two-homer games...the Rye, NY native was selected by the Twins in the first round (27th overall) of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of North Carolina.  
 Varland, 23, made one start for the Kernels on Wednesday at Peoria, allowing two runs (1 earned) on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched with no walks and a season-high 11 strikeouts...the St. Paul, MN native was selected by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul...this marks his second honor this season, previously winning it on July 25.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** On this day in 2019, the Twins beat the Royals by a score of 8-5 and improved to 94-59 on the season...the 94 wins made Rocco Baldelli the fifth rookie manager in Twins/Senators franchise history to reach that mark...Ron Gardenhire went 94-67 in 2002, Billy Martin went 97-65 in 1969, Bill Rigney went 98-64 in 1970 and Joe Cronin went 99-53 in 1933...in 2020, the Twins clinched a playoff berth with an 8-1 victory over the Cubs...they went on to win the American League Central on the season's final day, then were swept in two games by Houston in the American League Wild Card Series.

**MUSSEL UP:** Last night Single-A Fort Myers threw a seven-inning combined no-hitter in a 3-0 victory over Tampa at Hammond Stadium...Regi Garcia, Landon Leach, Brad Hanner and Matthew Swain were the Mighty Mussels pitchers as it marked the first no-no for the Fort Myers franchise (since 1992) since September 3, 2011, when Alex Wimmers threw a seven-inning no-hitter against Jupiter...the only other no-hitter in franchise history was in 2007, when Yohan Pino pitched a seven-inning no-hitter against St. Lucie.
