500...Luke Farrell (1-1) was the Opener, allowing all five of the Jays runs in the first inning on seven hits, including a two-run homer from Bo Bichette...the bullpen combined to pitch 7.0 scoreless innings with four hits allowed and eight strikeouts, highlighted by Juan Minaya, who fanned five with one walk and one hit allowed over 2.0 innings...the offense recorded just four hits, all extra-base hits...Ben Rortvedt homered (3) while Byron Buxton (16), Miguel Sanó (21) and Nick Gordon (8) all doubled off former teammate José Berríos.

**FASHIONABLY LATE ARRIVERS:** In its last 23 games, since August 27, the Twins bullpen has posted a 2.37 ERA (95.0 IP, 25 ER) with 73 hits allowed, 36 walks, 98 strikeouts, a .214 opponent batting average and a .649 opponent OPS...below are their ranks in the AL since that date:

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have reinstated shortstop Andrelton Simmons from the Restricted List and have returned catcher Mitch Garver from rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List.

♣ Simmons, who missed the three-game series in Toronto over the weekend, has appeared in 122 games for the Twins this season, hitting .223 (87-for-390) with 12 doubles, three home runs, 30 RBI, 36 runs scored and 31 walks.

♣ Garver, who played in three games with Triple-A St. Paul on rehab assignment and went 2-for-10 with one walk, was placed on the 10-day Injured List on August 27 with low back tightness and has missed the Twins' last 25 games...he has played in 61 games for the Twins this season, hitting .242 (44-for-182) with 13 doubles, 13 home runs, 29 RBI, 27 runs scored, 29 walks, a .527 slugging percentage and an .880 OPS.

♣ To make room for Simmons and Garver on the 28-man roster, the Twins have optioned catcher Ben Rortvedt and infielder Drew Maggi to Triple-A St. Paul...Maggi had his contract selected on Saturday and did not appear for the Twins...Rortvedt has hit .169 (15-for-89) with one double, three home runs, seven RBI, eight runs scored and six walks in 39 games across four stints for the Twins this season.

♣ Additionally, to make room for Simmons on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred left-handed pitcher Lewis Thorpe (left shoulder impingement) to the 60-day Injured List.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The Twins have gone 8-10 in Interleague Play this season, going 2-1 at Milwaukee from April 1-4, 1-2 vs. Pittsburgh from April 23-25, 1-1 vs. Cincinnati from June 21-22, 1-2 at St. Louis from July 30-August 1, 1-1 at Cincinnati from August 3-4, 2-1 vs. Milwaukee from August 27-29 and 0-2 vs. Chicago-NL from August 31-September 1...this series marks their final two IL games of the 2021 season.

◆ The Twins need to sweep these two games at Wrigley Field to finish with a .500 record against the NL in 2021...all-time the Twins have 10 winning seasons against the NL, 12 losing seasons and three splits.

◆ Twins are 240-220 all-time in IL Play, tied for fifth-most wins in baseball with Chicago-AL (240-221), trailing Boston (274-184), New York-AL (271-191), Los Angeles-AL (254-210) and Oakland (249-215).

◆ Josh Donaldson is hitting .309 (158-for-511) with 28 doubles, 32 home runs, 101 RBI, 100 runs scored and a .957 OPS in 142 career IL games...his IL OPS and on-base percentage (.397) both rank fourth among actives in all of baseball, his slugging percentage (.560) ranks fifth and his batting average ranks ninth (minimum 300 plate appearances).

◆ Jorge Polanco is hitting .315 (17-for-54) with three doubles, three home runs, six RBI, 10 runs scored, four walks and an .893 OPS in his last 13 games against the National League.

◆ Miguel Sanó has reached safely in 52 of his last 56 Interleague games, posting a .372 on-base percentage in those games (57 hits, 29 walks).

TWINS-CUBS: The Twins and Cubs are playing the third of four scheduled games in 2021...the Twins hosted the Cubs from August 31-September 1 and were swept in two games, getting outscored in the series 1-6...the Twins are 15-20 all-time against the Cubs, including a record of 6-12 at Wrigley Field...these two teams last met in Chicago for a three-game series from September 18-20, 2020, as the Twins lost the first game but won games two and three...the Twins celebrated in the visitors clubhouse at Wrigley Field on September 19, 2020, as their victory that night clinched a postseason berth.

₱ DID YOU KNOW?: Josh Donaldson was originally drafted by the Cubs as a catcher in the first round (48th overall) of the 2007 First-Year Player Draft...he played less than two seasons in Chicago's minor league system before being traded to Oakland on July 8, 2008 along with right-handed pitcher Sean Gallagher and outfielders Matt Murton and Eric Patterson, in exchange for right-handed pitchers Chad Gaudin and Rich Harden.

**BYE BYRON:** Byron Buxton is hitting .319 (29-for-91) with 10 doubles, nine home runs, 14 RBI, a .725 slugging percentage and a 1.073 OPS in 23 road games this season...among all players in baseball with a minimum of 75 road at-bats, he ranks first in slugging percentage and second in OPS.

LAST TIME OUT: Jax's last start came on September 15 vs. Cleveland at Target Field; was saddled with his third-straight loss as the Twins fell, 12-3...allowed five runs (3 ER) on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts...held Cleveland scoreless in his first 3.0 innings — in parallel with his career trends (see "early dominance" note below) — before allowing one run in the fourth on an RBI double by Bobby Bradley and four more in the fifth, two of which were unearned due to an error by Miguel Sanó...departed with two outs in the fifth and the Twins down 5-0; the Indians' offense scored seven additional runs off the Twins' bullpen.

**START PRIOR:** Jax started on September 10 vs. Kansas City, taking a no-decision as the Twins fell to the Royals, 6-4, in 11 innings...allowed four runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in a career-high-tying 6.0 innings...yielded a three-run homer to Andrew Benintendi in the opening frame, the first (and only, to date) first-inning runs allowed in his young career...threw 75 percent of his pitches for strikes (57-of-76), a new career-high strike percentage, besting his 73.9 percent in his major league debut.

NATIONAL HISTORY: Jax is making his third career Interleague start and appearance tonight, as he faces Chicago-NL for the first time...his other Interleague starts occurred on July 30 at St. Louis (ND, 5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 2 K; Twins lost, 5-1) and on August 29 vs. Milwaukee (L, 5.0 IP, 6 H, 6 R/ ER, 2 HR, 3 BB, 5 K; Twins lost, 6-2).

JAX IN THE BOX: Jax made his professional debut at the plate in his start at St. Louis on July 30...by his own estimation, prior to that game he hadn't stepped into the batter's box against live pitching since 2013, when he was named the hitting MVP of the Air Force Academy's fall intrasquad series... went 0-for-2 with a strikeout and a flyout in St. Louis; Jax said postgame that he was proud of himself for at least making contact on the flyout, which traveled 186 feet to rightfield and had a launch angle of F6 decrease are Setted. angle of 56 degrees, per Statcast.

EARLY DOMINANCE: Jax is holding opposing hitters to a .179 (21-for-117) batting average the first time through the lineup so far in his major league career...this increases to .308 (33-for-107) the second time around and jumps further to .354 (17-for-48) the third time he sees opposing hitters... these stats correspond to his numbers in each respective inning, as he is holding opposing hitters to a .156 (19-for-122) batting average in the first three innings combined...this compares to the .344 (44-for-128) mark opponents have against him in innings four to six.

© The three runs Jax allowed in the first inning of his September 10 start were the first and only he has permitted in the opening frame in his major league career...despite the tallies, he's still holding opposing hitters to a .128 (5-for-39) batting average in the first inning in his career.

ROAD WOES: Jax is 1-2, 7.16 ERA (32.2 IP, 26 ER), 15 walks and 24 strikeouts in seven road ap-

pearances (six starts)

arances (six starts).

◆ Jax is 0-1, 12.54 ERA (9.1 IP, 13 ER) combined across his last two road starts; this compares to the 1-0, 1.88 ERA (14.1 IP, 3 ER) he posted in his three prior road starts, from July 19-August 5.

**NIGHT OWL:** Jax has fared better in night games than in day games so far in his career...he's gone 3-2, 5.80 ERA (54.1 IP, 35 ER) in 12 games (eight starts) under the lights compared to 0-2, 9.82 ERA (14.2 IP, 16 ER) in three starts under the sun.

**THE ARSENAL:** Jax has used four different offerings so far in his major league career, relying primarily on his four-seam fastball...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire, per Baseball Savant.

STRONG STRETCH: In five starts between July 19-August 16, Jax went 2-0, 2.73 ERA (26.1 IP, 8 ER), seven walks, 21 strikeouts and a .188 (18-for-96) opponent batting average...that run came in the wake of allowing six earned runs in his first career start on July 3 at Kansas City...his opponent batting average in that span ranked third in the majors (min. 95 AB), behind Los Angeles-NL's Walker Buehler (.179) and Seattle's Marco Gonzales (.184)...his .248 opponent on-base percentage also ranked third in the majors under those same criteria in that span, behind St. Louis's Adam Wainwright (.226) and Gonzales (.238).

ROOKIE SUCCESS: Jax did not factor into the decision on August 16 vs. Cleveland, as the Twins defeated the Indians, 5-4, in 10 innings on Jorge Polanco's walk-off double...Jax recorded his second career quality start (and second consecutive), after allowing four runs (2 ER) on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts over a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of work...the following night, August 17, fellow rookie starting pitcher Bailey Ober also recorded a quality start, marking the first time the Twins had quality starts by rookies in back-to-back games since August 18-19, 2012 vs. Seattle, when Scott Diamond (August 18; 6.2 IP, 2 ER) and Samuel Deduno (August 19; 6.0 IR 2 ER) and Samuel Deduno (Augus

- 2012 vs. Seatue, when sector brainfold (August 16; 6.2 fr, 2 Ex) and Sainder bedding (August 18; 6.0 fr, 2 ER) each did so.
   Tonight marks Jax's 12th start of the season...paired with Ober (19 starts this season), they become the first Twins rookie duo each having at least 12 starts in the same season since the rookie quartet of Samuel Deduno (15 starts), Cole De Vries (16 starts), Scott Diamond (16 starts) and Liam Hendriks (16 starts) each did so in 2012.
   Jax is also holding opposing hitters to a .182 (25-for-137) batting average with two strikes, the lowest mark by a Twins rookie pitcher (min. 115 opp. AB) since Taylor Rogers (.179) in 2016.
