- Making his 12th career start and 16th appearance.
Facing Chicago-NL for the first time in his career; making his third career Interleague start and appearance...has gone 0-1, 6.30 ERA (10.0 IP, 7 ER) in his two prior starts.
On June 8, became the first Air Force Academy graduate ever to play in the majors...originally selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Jax's last start came on September 15 vs. Cleveland at Target Field; was saddled with his third-straight loss as the Twins fell, 12-3...allowed five runs (3 ER) on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts...

START PRIOR: Jax started on September 10 vs. Kansas City, taking a no-decision as the Twins fell to the Royals, 6-4, in 11 innings...allowed four runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in a career-high-tying 6.0 innings...

NATIONAL HISTORY: Jax is making his third career Interleague start and appearance tonight, as he faces Chicago-NL for the first time...his other Interleague starts occurred on July 30 at St. Louis (ND, 5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 2 K; Twins lost, 5-1) and on August 29 vs. Milwaukee (L, 5.0 IP, 6 H, 6 R/ER, 2 HR, 3 BB, 5 K; Twins lost, 6-2).

JAX IN THE BOX: Jax made his professional debut at the plate in his start at St. Louis on July 30...by his own estimation, prior to that game he hadn't stepped into the batter's box against live pitching since 2013, when he was named the hitting MVP of the Air Force Academy's fall intrasquad series...

EARLY DOMINANCE: Jax is holding opposing hitters to a .179 (21-for-117) batting average the first time through the lineup so far in his major league career...this increases to .308 (33-for-107) the second time around and jumps further to .354 (17-for-48) the third time he sees opposing hitters...

- The three runs Jax allowed in the first inning of his September 10 start were the first and only he has permitted in the opening frame in his major league career...despite the tallies, he's still holding opposing hitters to a .128 (5-for-39) batting average in the first inning in his career.

ROAD WOES: Jax is 1-2, 7.16 ERA (32.2 IP, 26 ER), 15 walks and 24 strikeouts in seven road appearances (six starts).

- Jax is 0-1, 12.54 ERA (9.1 IP, 13 ER) combined across his last two road starts; this compares to the 1-0, 1.88 ERA (14.1 IP, 3 ER) he posted in his three prior road starts, from July 19-August 5.

NIGHT OWL: Jax has fared better in night games than in day games so far in his career...he's gone 3-2, 5.80 ERA (54.1 IP, 35 ER) in 12 games (eight starts) under the lights compared to 0-2, 9.82 ERA (14.2 IP, 16 ER) in three starts under the sun.

THE ARSENAL: Jax has used four different offerings so far in his major league career, relying primarily on his four-seam fastball...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire, per Baseball Savant.

STRONG STRETCH: In five starts between July 19-August 16, Jax went 2-0, 2.73 ERA (26.1 IP, 8 ER), seven walks, 21 strikeouts and a .188 (18-for-96) opponent batting average...that run came in the wake of allowing six earned runs in his first career start on July 3 at Kansas City...

ROOKIE SUCCESS: Jax did not factor into the decision on August 16 vs. Cleveland, as the Twins defeated the Indians, 5-4, in 10 innings on Jorge Polanco's walk-off double...Jax recorded his second career quality start (and second consecutive), after allowing four runs (2 ER) on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts over a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of work...

- Tonight marks Jax's 12th start of the season...paired with Ober (19 starts this season), they become the first Twins rookie duo each having at least 12 starts in the same season since the rookie quartet of Samuel Deduno (15 starts), Cole De Vries (16 starts), Scott Diamond (16 starts) and Liam Hendriks (16 starts) each did so in 2012.
Jax is also holding opposing hitters to a .182 (25-for-137) batting average with two strikes, the lowest mark by a Twins rookie pitcher (min. 115 opp. AB) since Taylor Rogers (.179) in 2016.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2021 SEASON: 1-1, 2.12 ERA // CAREER: 1-1, 2.12 ERA)

Rookie right-hander Ryan is due to start tomorrow night's season series finale against the Cubs...his last outing occurred in the first game of the doubleheader on September 14 vs. Cleveland, as he did not factor into the decision in a 3-1 Twins loss...permitted one run on three hits (1 HR) over 5.0 innings of work, with one walk and five strikeouts...

CAREER NOTES

- Made his major league debut on June 8, 2021, becoming the first Air Force Academy graduate to ever play in the majors...is a Captain in the United States Air Force Reserve, after completing his two-year active duty commitment in 2019.
Enters his sixth year as a member of the Twins organization in 2021; did not play in 2020 when the minor league season was cancelled due to COVID-19.
In 2019 for Double-A Pensacola, was a two-time Southern League Pitcher of the Week on May 5 (1-0, 0.75 ERA, 12.0 IP, 1 ER, 3 BB, 7 K) and June 30 (1-0, 0.69 ERA, 13.0 IP, 1 ER, 2 BB, 8 K)...also named SL Midseason All-Star, after going 2-2, 1.92 ERA (51.2 IP, 11 ER) with 11 walks and 34 strikeouts in 10 starts pre-break.
Named best control in Twins minor league system by Baseball America in 2019.
Selected by Twins in third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of the Air Force Academy...was rated 95th-best prospect entering the draft by Baseball America.
Pitched for Air Force for three seasons, going 15-20 with a 4.28 ERA (298.2 IP, 142 ER), 76 walks and 205 strikeouts in 46 appearances (44 starts).
Finished his junior season at the U.S. Air Force Academy going 9-2 with a school-record 2.05 ERA (105.1 IP, 24 ER), 20 walks and 90 strikeouts in 15 starts...in 2016, was named the Mountain West co-Pitcher of the Year and All-Mountain West First-Team after leading the MWC in ERA, innings, complete games (6) and shutouts (2).

ACROSS THE RIVER: Jax did not play a professional game in 2020 and was not part of the Twins' 60-man player pool...participated in the Twins Fall Instructional League in Fort Myers in October 2020...opened 2021 in the rotation for Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-1, 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER) in five starts during May...did not pitch upon being optioned to the Saints on June 16 and returned to the Twins on June 24...made one start for the Saints during his most recent Triple-A stint, on July 25 at Omaha (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/ER, 1 BB, 5 K) and went 4-1, 3.76 ERA (40.2 IP, 17 ER) in eight starts overall for the Saints.

JAX AND THE AIR FORCE ACADEMY: Jax is the first graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy to ever play in the major leagues...became the sixth Academy product ever to be drafted when he was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft...played baseball full-time through 2019 while concurrently serving in the Air Force through the Air Force's World Class Athlete Program (WCAP); he was accepted into the program in April 2018, following baseball's readmittance as an Olympic sport, as a Second Lieutenant (the rank all cadets receive after graduating from the academy).

- Completed his two-year active duty commitment in 2019 and was transferred to the Air Force Reserve in November 2019, while continuing with his five-year Reserve requirement with around 24 days per year of military activity.
Received the email informing him of his promotion to Captain on June 5, his first day in a big league uniform (made his MLB debut June 8)...matched the current rank of his wife, Savannah, who is an intelligence officer in the Air Force based out of Moody Air Force Base (GA)...Savannah also completed a six-month tour of duty in Afghanistan within the last 18 months and is scheduled to deploy again in the early part of the offseason.
Jax was presented with the 2021 Bob Feller Act of Valor Award prior to the nightcap on September 14...the MLB award honors major leaguers who embody the spirit of the late Hall-of-Famer Feller, both in terms of his commitment to country and love for baseball.
