TWINS SWEEP UP ON NORTHSIDE: The Twins beat the Cubs last night at Wrigley Field by a score of 5-4, recording their fourth sweep of the season....oe Ryan (2-1) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched with a career-high 11 strikeouts... the offense recorded nine hits, seven going for extra-bases...Max Kepler went 3 -for-4 with one double (21) and two home runs ( 18,19 ), marking his 11th career multi-homer game and fourth career game with three extra-base hits.
$\Phi$ Ryan became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history (since 1901) to strike out 11 batters in a start of 5.0 innings-or-less.... his 25 total strikeouts through his first four career games are tied with Dixie Walker (1909) and Dave Boswell (1964) for most in Twins/Senators history.

TWINS AND JAYS: The Twins are playing the fourth of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season...they played the Jays last weekend, going 1-2 at the Rogers Centre, taking game one but losing games two and three...the Twins have gone just $27-44$ vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 9-5 in their last 14 , dating back to May 2, 2018.
© Byron Buxton is hitting. 313 ( 21 -for-67) with six doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI and a 979 OPS in 17 career games vs. the Jays.
$\Phi$ Jorge Polanco is hitting. 330 ( 31 -for- 94 ) with eight doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, 11 walks, a .400 on-base percentage and a .943 OPS in 24 career games against the Jays. $\Phi$ Josh Donaldson is hitting. 316 ( 6 -for-19) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, six walks, a 500 on-base percentage and a 1.395 OPS in his last six games against the Jays.

START PRIOR：Pineda won his second－consecutive decision September 11 vs．Kansas City in a 9－2 Twins victory at Target Field．．．permitted just one run on five hits，with no walks（1 hit batter）and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched．．．the only run he allowed came on an Andrew Benintendi RBI single in the fourth inning as the first three men in the frame reached base．．．Big Mike rebounded to retire the next three batters without any further damage．．．tossed a scoreless fifth to conclude his outing
© Marked his fifth start of the season of at least 5.0 innings and no walks，last done August 7 at Houston（6．0 IP， 0 BB）．

YOU AGAIN，EH？：Pineda is making his 16th career start（and second consecutive）vs．Toronto tonight，his most against any opponent．．．is 3－5，4．29 ERA（84．0 IP， 40 ER），with 25 walks and 64 strikeouts in his career vs．the Blue Jays．
$\boldsymbol{T}$ Is $1-1,5.86$ ERA（ $35.1 \mathrm{IP}, 23 \mathrm{ER}$ ），with 11 walks and 28 strikeouts in seven starts vs．the Blue Jays as the home pitcher．．．．his last home start vs．the Jays came on April 18， 2019 at Target Field （L，3．2 IP， 7 H， 6 R／ER， 2 HR， 1 BB， 1 K ）．
$\Phi$ Worked a career－high－tying 8.0 innings on May 5， 2015 at Toronto，earning the win in a 6－3 Yankees victory．
$\Phi$ Tonight marks his third time facing the same opponent in back－to－back outings this season opposed Baltimore in consecutive starts May 26－June 1 （1－1，9．0 IP， 6 R／ER， $10 \mathrm{H}, 1 \mathrm{HR}, 2 \mathrm{BB}$ ， 9 K ）and faced Chicago－AL consecutively July 7－21（1－1，10．1 IP， 6 R／ER， 16 H， 1 HR， 1 BB， 7 K ）．

RETURN TO FORM？：Since being reinstated from the 10－day Injured List on September 6，Big Mike has gone 3－0，1．32 ERA（ $13.2 \mathrm{IP}, 2 \mathrm{ER}$ ），with three walks and eight strikeouts across three outings（2 starts， 1 relief appearance）．
$\Phi$ Pineda has limited opposing hitters to a 196 （10－for－51）batting average in that span，including .100 （1－for－10）with runners in scoring position．
F Has lowered his season ERA from 4.13 to 3.74 over his current stretch．．．the last time his season ERA was under 4.00 was August 7 （3．83）．．．additionally，his career ERA currently sits at 3．99， marking the first time it＇s been under 4.00 since June 8 （3．99）．

AT HIS BEST AGAINST THE BEST：Pineda has pitched his best against the heart of opposing lineups， limiting the number two to five hitters to a combined .188 batting average（ 35 －for－186）with six doubles，eight home runs，eight walks and 41 strikeouts．．．．by contrast，leadoff batters are slashing ．463／．491／．704（25－for－54）with five doubles，one triple，two home runs and three walks，while the six to nine slots are hitting a combined .264 （38－for－144）with 12 doubles，one triple，six home runs， nine walks and 34 strikeouts．
※ Big Mike has been especially stingy against opposing five－hole hitters，limiting those batters to seven hits in 43 at－bats（．163），with three doubles，one walk，seven strikeouts and a ． 414 OPS．
Opposing cleanup hitters are also just 8 －for－47（．170），with two doubles，two home runs，two walks， 11 strikeouts and a 545 OPS

－Missed last 21 games of 2019，the entire ALDS and the first 36 contests of 2020 due to a 60－ game suspension for violating MLB＇s Joint Drug and Prevention Treatment Program．
－Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List，recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow．．．also missed the entire 2012 campaign with New York－AL recovering from right shoulder surgery，and was out of the majors in 2013 while rehabbing．
－Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016，setting the fifth－lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200＋strikeouts in American League history．
－Was an AL All－Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners，posting a 3.03 ERA（113．0 IP， 38 ER）with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of .198 in the first half，and finished the year fifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting．
－In 2011，he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era（1961－present）to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters，and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka （Boston，2007）．
－Was signed by Seattle as a 16 －year－old undrafted free agent December 12，2005．．．signed by Patrick Guerrero，brother of Fred Guerrero，Twins＇Director of Latin American Scouting \＆U．S． Integration．
－He owns a farm in his native Dominican Republic，where he raises chickens in addition to growing a number of crops．
