**THE TWINS:** After completing their five-game, six-day roadtrip with a record of 3-2 (1-2 against Toronto and 2-0 against Chicago-NL), the Twins began their final homestand of 2021 with a victory over the Blue Jays last night...tonight they will play the second of four with Toronto...they will conclude the series on Sunday afternoon, then enjoy an off-day on Monday and finish their home schedule with three against the Tigers from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 35-40 at home this season and 33-45 on the road.

**TWINS TAKE DOWN THE JAYS IN GAME ONE:** The Twins beat the Blue Jays last night at Target Field by a score of 7-2...Michael Pineda (8-8) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched with one walk and two strikeouts...the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings of relief with three hits allowed and three walks...Ralph Garza Jr. stranded all three runners he inherited in the eighth inning and earned his first career save with 1.1 perfect innings to finish off the win...the offense recorded 13 hits, three from both Mitch Garver and Nick Gordon...Gordon hit a three-run homer in the fifth inning, marking the fourth of his career, and added a run-scoring single in the seventh for a career-best four-RBI.

**TWINS AND JAYS:** The Twins are playing the fifth of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season...the Twins have gone just 28-44 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 10-5 in their last 15, dating back to May 2, 2018.

- Byron Buxton is hitting .324 (23-for-71) with seven doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.002 OPS in 18 career games vs. the Jays.
- Jorge Polanco is hitting .327 (32-for-98) with eight doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, 12 walks, a .400 on-base percentage and a .931 OPS in 25 career games against the Jays.
- Josh Donaldson has reached base 14 times in his last 31 plate appearances against the Blue Jays, posting a .484 on-base percentage in that span (6 hits, 8 walks).

**#OLDFRIEND:** Tonight's Jays starter José Berríos was traded by Minnesota to Toronto on July 30, in exchange for infielder/outfielder Austin Martin (Twins No. 2 prospect per MLB.com) and right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson (Twins No. 4 prospect per MLB.com) - both currently with Double-A Wichita...Berríos was selected by the Twins in the first round (32nd overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft out of Papa Juan High School in Bayamón, Puerto Rico...the 27-year-old pitched for the Twins from 2016-21, going 55-43, 4.08 ERA (781.1 IP, 354 ER), 253 walks and 779 strikeouts in 136 games (135 starts)...below is more on Berríos' time in Minnesota:

- Ranks 12th on Twins all-time list (since 1961) in strikeouts and 15th in wins.
- 32 career wins at Target Field are tied with Kyle Gibson for most in the ballpark's history (since 2010)...411 strikeouts are second to Gibson's 425.
- Two-time American League All-Star in 2018 and 2019.
- Joseph W. Haynes Award winner as Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2018.
- Carl R. Pohlad Award winner for outstanding community service in 2018.
- Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year in 2014 and '15.

**'PEN IS STILL MIGHTY:** In its last 26 games, since August 27, the Twins bullpen has posted a 2.39 ERA (109.0 IP, 29 ER) with 87 hits allowed, 42 walks, 115 strikeouts, a .221 opponent batting average and a .641 opponent OPS...below are their ranks in the AL since that date:

The Kernels lost to Quad Cities on Wednesday night in game two of the HACL Championship Series by a score of 6-0...Sean Mooney was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on three hits in 3.0 innings pitched...game three in the best-of-five series is at 6:30 p.m. (CT) tonight in Quad Cities as Casey Legumina gets the start for the Kernels...the series is tied 1-1.

Triple-A St. Paul began its "Final Stretch" with a 4-1 home loss last night to Iowa...the Triple-A team with the best winning percentage in those final 10 games receives a prize from Major League Baseball.

**ON THIS DAY IN DAZZLE HISTORY:** In 1984, the original Ironman, Dan Gladden, played both games of a doubleheader while playing for San Francisco, hosting San Diego, leading off and playing centerfield...Gladden had four hits in eight at-bats on the day, with one RBI, two runs scored, two walks, one strikeout and one stolen base...Gladden played 349 career games in centerfield, tied with Chicago-AL's Adam Engel for 222nd most all-time among right-handed-throwing players born in the U.S., trailing Tony Gwynn, Jr. (350) and ahead of Hersh Martin (346); 38 more games and he would have tied Peanuts Lowrey (387) for 208th.

**LAST START:** Ober was dealt his third career loss during his last start on September 18 at Toronto from the Twins' 6-2 defeat...allowed four runs on four hits (2 HR) over 4.0 innings of work, with two walks and three strikeouts...marked his first time allowing multiple walks since July 10 vs. Detroit (also 2) and his fifth time allowing multiple homers in a start, last done August 6 at Houston (also 2)...did not give up any runs until the fourth inning when he allowed a solo homer to Marcus Semien and a three-run home run to Teoscar Hernández.

**START PRIOR:** Ober did not factor into the Twins' 5-3 defeat on September 12 in the series finale against Kansas City...allowed three runs on three hits (1 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts over 4.1 innings...marked his second career start with no walks and at least six strikeouts, previously done June 16 at Seattle (also 6 K)...allowed single tallies in the first and second innings, and departed with two on, one out in the fifth; an inherited run then scored off Jovani Moran, who made his major league debut...the Twins tied the game at 3-3 in the sixth, but the Royals scored single runs in both the eighth and ninth innings to win.

**0 CANADA:** Tonight will be Ober's second-straight start and second career appearance against Toronto...he is 0-1, 4.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 4 ER) with three walks and 10 strikeouts in two starts against the American League East division.

**RECENT RECAP:** Ober is 0-1, 6.57 ERA (12.1 IP, 9 ER) in his last three starts after going 1-1, 1.61 ERA (22.1 IP, 4 ER) in his four prior starts...also owns an 0-1 record and 2.87 ERA (15.2 IP, 5 ER) with just one walk and 15 strikeouts in his last three starts at Target Field.

- Ober enters tonight's start with a professional career high of 103.0 innings pitched this season between the Twins (87.0 IP) and Triple-A St. Paul (16.0 IP), surpassing his previous high of 78.2 innings amassed in 2019 across three levels of Minnesota's minor league system.
- The Twins have won six of Ober's last nine starts, while the team stands at 11-8 in his 19 starts overall.
- Ober's 7.50 strikeout-to-walk ratio since July 31 is second in the majors (min. 35.0 IP), behind only Los Angeles-NL's Max Scherzer (10.63).

**LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD:** Through his 19 career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .154 batting average (4-for-26) with runners in scoring position and two outs, as well as a .245 (13-for-53) overall mark with RISP...his opponent batting average with RISP and two outs this season is the lowest by a Twins rookie pitcher (min. 25 opp. AB) since Samuel Deduno's .107 (3-for-28) mark in 2012...has allowed multiple hits with runners in scoring position just once in his career, on July 20 at Chicago-AL (2-for-5)...in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, Ober held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position.

**2021 ARSENAL:** Here's a look at the rookie's repertoire, per Baseball Savant...the right-handed pitcher relies heavily on his four-seam fastball.

- His 5.3 walk percentage ranks in the 91st percentile of all pitchers, while his 31.6% chase rate ranks in the 84th percentile and his 25.1 strikeout percentage ranks in the 61st percentile.

**THAT'S ALRIGHT:** Ober has held right-handed batters to a .239 (43-for-180) batting average, with five doubles, three triples, 11 home runs, six walks and 51 strikeouts, as compared to a .288 (45-for-156) batting average, nine doubles, eight homers, 13 walks and 39 strikeouts by left-handed batters in his MLB career.

**SKOL TWINS:** Ober attended Charlotte Christian School in Charlotte, North Carolina, where he was batterymates on the baseball team and friends with Vikings center Garrett Bradbury...Bradbury had just arrived in the Twin Cities for OTAs at the time of Ober's debut on May 18, and attended the game with his wife, Carson...Carson is also the older sister of Kansas City Royals No. 5 prospect Jackson Kowar, who made his major league debut for Kansas City on June 7.

**WALKING TALL:** Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins and Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or Washington...the other pitchers 6-8-or-taller to play for the Twins are:
