afternoon's series finale, they will travel to Cleveland for four games at Progressive Field from afternoon's series tinale, they will travel to Cleveland for four games at Progressive Field from Monday-Thursday...the Twins have gone $32-36$ at home this season and 26-39 on the road.

TWINS SHUT OUT AND SWEPT OUT OF MINNESOTA: The Twins lost to the Cubs on Wednesday night at Target Field by a score of 3-0, suffering the two-game sweep while getting outscored
$1-6$ in the series...they were shut out for the seventh time this season and first time at home... Joe Ryan ( $0-1$ ) made his major league debut as the club's starter and allowed three runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...his only runs allowed came on a two-out three-run homer from Frank Schwindel in the third inning...the bullpen combined for 4.0 innings of scoreless relief with one hit allowed...the offense recorded just two hits, both coming from Brent Rooker, who singled twice and was hit by a pitch.
WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Joe Ryan, who was acquired via trade with Tampa Bay in exchange for Nelson Cruz on July 22, became the eighth different Twin to make their major league debut in 2021...below is the list of Twins to debut this season:

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: Dobnak is set to make his first major league start and appearance since June 19 at Texas, when he pitched 5.0 innings of the Twins' $3-2$ victory over the Rangers... had been hampered by injury and the resulting ineffectiveness, and was placed on the 10-day Injured List with a right middle finger strain on June 24 (retroactive to June 21)...was transferred to the 60-day IL on July 17; was later sent on a rehabilitation assignment to Single-A Fort Myers on August 21, and then to Triple-A St. Paul on August 24...was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the IL on Wednesday, after missing the Twins' previous 61 games.
I In his last big league start and appearance back on June 19, Dobnak held the Rangers to two runs on four hits (including a two-run, third-inning homer by Isiah Kiner-Falefa) over 5.0 innings, with one walk and one strikeout in a no-decision...departed with the score tied 2-2; Twins eventually won, 3-2, in the middle contest of a three-game sweep in Arlington.
WORKING HIS WAY BACK: Dobnak made a pair of minor league starts while on a rehab assignment, pitching for Single-A Fort Myers on August 21 and for Triple-A St. Paul on August 26...combined to work 7.2 innings, allowing one run on five hits with four walks and seven strikeouts
$\Phi$ Tossed 3.0 perfect innings for the Mighty Mussels at Dunedin, compiling five strikeouts on just 32 pitches ( 24 strikes).

WELL GROUNDED: As noted above, Dobnak's primary pitch is his sinker, which is the ideal tool for inducing ground-ball contact...since his debut on August 9, 2019, Dobnak ranks among the major league leaders (min. 400 BF ) in ground ball/fly ball ratio (4th, 3.21), ground ball percentage (5th, 57.8) and opponent grounded into double plays-per-9.0 IP (1st, 1.44).
$\Phi$ Those numbers, however, are down (and balls in play off Dobnak are up in the air) across the board this season, as Dobnak has a 2.87 ground ball/fly ball ratio, a 55.6 ground ball percentage and is inducing 1.24 double plays-per-9.0 IP.
$\Phi$ Dobnak has also yielded a career-worst 11 home runs in just 43.2 innings pitched (2.27 HR-per-9.0 IP)...entering this season, he had allowed just four longballs in 75.0 career innings

START ME UP: Dobnak enters tonight's game 9-8, 4.24 ERA (93.1 IP, 44 ER) in 20 career major league starts...was 7-2, 1.81 (49.2 IP, 10 ER) in his first 11 starts (through Augus 22, 2020), but is just 2-6, 7.01 ERA (43.2 IP, 34 ER) in his nine starts since.
$\Phi$ Has an opponent slash line of .271/.334/.392 as a starter, with opposing batters going 98 -

UNDER THE DOME: Tonight will be Dobnak's third time pitching indoors in the big leagues, all in 2021...took the relief loss on Opening Day at Milwaukee's American Family Field, entering in the 10th inning and facing two batters (a single and a run-scoring fielder's choice)...also $\Phi$ Started in Milwaukee on August 10, 2020, but the roof was open that evening.

HE'LL GIVE YOU A LYFT: Dobnak, who drove for both Uber and Lyft during offseasons and while playing in the minors, signed a marketing deal with Lyft this spring centered on athletes,
