- WELCOME BACK 10 THE BIG LEAGUES: Albers made his season debut for the lwins in relief on August 19 at New York-AL, as the Twins fell 7-5...entered the game in the fifth inning and allowed one run on two hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts over 4.0 innings...gave up a double to Joey Gallo in the fifth and allowed a homer to Giancarlo Stanton in the eighth inning.

 Marked Albers' first major league game since September 30, 2017 at Los Angeles-AL with Seattle.

 This season marks Albers' third separate major league stint with the Twins and he's the first player in Twins history (1961-present) to have three different stints with the club (2013, 2016 and 2021)...he's also just the third player in Twins/Senators history to do so, alongside Bobo Newsom (5 stints) and Hall-of-Famer Goose Goslin (3 stints).

 Made his MLB debut for the Twins on August 6, 2013...began his major league career with a 17.1-inning scoreless streak, the longest to beer a career by a Twins starter.
