THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-2 through four games on their seven-game roadtrip, going 1-2 against the Rays at Tropicana Field over the weekend, followed by a win over Cleveland at Progressive Field last night...tonight they will play the second of four with the Indians and complete the series on Thursday night...the Twins have gone 32-36 at home this season and 28-41 on the road...the Twins are seeking their third-straight road win...their longest road winning streaks this season are four straight from June 16-20 and three straight from April 3-5.

CONGRATS ROCCO AND ALLIE!!: Manager Rocco Baldelli and his wife, Allie, had their first child, a girl named Louisa Sunny, weighing in at 6 lbs, 8 oz...mom and baby are doing fine... Rocco left the team on Sunday from St. Petersburg to travel back to Minneapolis...his return to the club is yet to be determined.

THE SKIP: With Rocco returning to Minneapolis, Major League Coach Bill Evers is serving as acting manager...2021 marks Evers' 46th season coaching at some capacity in professional baseball and sixth at the major league level...he was the bench coach under Joe Maddon from 2006-07, the same time that Baldelli was an outfielder for the Devil Rays...he spent 23 seasons in Tampa Bay's organization; was manager at Triple-A Durham as part of the Devil Rays' inaugural season in 1998...he also managed at various levels of Tampa Bay's organization from 1987-2005, compiling a record of 1381-1206 (.534).

**WORTH NOTHING: According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, any win in Baldelli's absence is still credited under Rocco's managerial record.

LAST TIME OUT: Gant last pitched a week ago on August 31 vs. Chicago-NL at Target Field, taking his ninth loss of the season in a 3-1 Twins setback...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings pitched...yielded single tallies in the first and second innings on a Frank Schwindel solo home run and Robinson Chirinos RBI triple...tossed three scoreless frames and retired his final 10 batters overall to conclude his outing; departed after the fifth with the Twins down, 2-1.

◆ Five strikeouts tied his season high for the fourth time, last done May 6 vs. New York-NL while pitching for St. Louis.

◆ Marked his first start without a issuing a free pass since August 14, 2018 vs. Washington... also marked his forth career start of at least 5.0 innings, no walks and five strikeouts, joining his aforementioned outing vs. Washington (5.1 IP, 0 BB, 6 K), May 25, 2018 at Pittsburgh (5.1 IP, 0 BB, 7 K) and June 22, 2016 at Miami (5.2 IP, 0 BB, 5 K).

◆ Fell to 0-3, 7.30 ERA (12.1 IP, 10 ER), with four walks and 12 strikeouts in three starts so far for the Twins.

TWO OUTINGS AGO: Gant made his second start as a Twin August 26 in the series finale at Boston, a 12-2 Twins defeat...took his eighth loss of the season after allowing four runs on three hits (1 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings...worked a scoreless first before yielding three runs in the second on a Bobby Dalbec three-run homer, and an additional tally in the third on an Alex Verdugo RBI single...exited after the fourth inning, giving way to the Twins bullpen which allowed eight additional runs.

GATEWAY TO THE TWIN CITIES: On July 30, Gant was acquired by Minnesota from St. Louis, along with minor league LHP Evan Sisk, in exchange for LHP J.A. Happ just before the trade deadline...prior to his acquisition, he went 4-6, 3.42 ERA (76.1 IP, 29 ER), with 56 walks and 56 strikeouts in 25 games (14 starts) for the Cardinals...since being acquired by the Twins, he has gone 0-3, 6.00 ERA (21.0 IP, 14 ER), with six walks and 25 strikeouts in 10 games (three starts).

© Simply swapped clubhouses at Busch Stadium when he was traded, as the Twins were on a roadtrip in St. Louis at the time of the transaction.

© His Twins debut came against his former team, entering in relief of Michael Pineda in the fifth inning on August 1 at St. Louis (1.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 1 K).

© Had 56 strikeouts and 56 walks (1.00 K/BB ratio) in 25 games with St. Louis, compared to 25 strikeouts and just six walks (4.17 K/BB ratio) in his 10 games with Minnesota so far.

VS. CLEVELAND: Tonight marks Gant's sixth career game and third start vs. Cleveland...is 1-0, 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER), with eight walks and eight strikeouts vs. the Tribe.

◆ Has made two relief appearances vs. Cleveland this season (one for St. Louis, one for Minnesota), combining to work 2.0 scoreless innings with no hits, two walks and two strikeouts.

Tonight marks his first start vs. Cleveland since June 25, 2018, when he tossed seven innings of one-hit, shutout ball to earn the win in a 4-0 Cardinals victory at Busch Stadium...7.0 innings marked a career high (tied that mark two months later, tossing 7.0 innings on August 25, 2018 at Colorado).

Φ With the Iwins, Gant is 0-3, 7.30 ERA (12.1 IP, 10 ER) in three starts, while posting a 4.15 ERA (8.2 IP, 4 ER) in seven relief outings (5 scoreless efforts).

SPLITS ROUNDUP: Gant is 2-6, 3.70 ERA (58.1 IP, 24 ER) and holding opposing hitters to a .205 (42-for-205) batting average in 22 games (11 starts) on the road, while going 2-3, 4.38 ERA (39.0 IP, 19 ER) and yielding a .255 (39-for-153) opponent batting average in 13 games (six starts) at home..has performed better vs. left-handed hitters this season, limiting them to a .208 (33-for-159) average, compared to the .241 (48-for-199) mark he's allowed to righties; this trend coincides with his career numbers, as he's held lefties to a .218 batting average (130-for-597) while righties are hitting .237 (173-for-730) off of him.

© Gant has performed particularly well in scoring situations this season, limiting hitters to a .168 (17-for-101) mark with runners in scoring position, including .140 (6-for-43) with RISP and two outs; both these numbers are substantially lower than his career marks of .228 (74-for-325) with RISP, and .212 (31-for-146) with RISP and two outs...his .140 opponent batting average with RISP and two outs this season ranks ninth among all pitchers in baseball (min. 40 opp. AB).
