the Twins have gone 32-36 at home this season and 29-41 on the road.

**GANT GETS 'EM GOING, 'PEN PULLS 'EM THROUGH:** The Twins beat the Indians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 3-0, marking their seventh shutout of an opponent this season and second time in Cleveland in 2021...the last time the Twins shut out the Tribe in Cleveland multiple times in a season came in 2017 (3 times)...John Gant (5-9) earned his first win as a Twin, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, four walks and a career-high-tying seven strikeouts...the bullpen combined for 4.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by a Brent Rooker solo home run, his seventh of the season.

**SAFE TRAVELS:** The Twins are seeking their fourth-straight road win, which would tie their season-long, previously done from June 16-20, taking one in Seattle, followed by a threegame sweep in Texas...their last five-game road winning streak was September 24-28, 2019.

THE SKIP: Rocco Baldelli is currently in Minneapolis after he and his wife, Allie, welcomed their first child, a baby girl, Louisa Sunny, into the world late Monday night...Major League Coach Bill Evers is serving as acting manager...2021 marks Evers' 46th season coaching at some capacity in professional baseball and sixth at the major league level...he was the bench coach under Joe Maddon from 2006-07, the same time that Baldelli was an outfielder for the Devil Rays...he spent 23 seasons in Tampa Bay's organization; was manager at Triple-A Durham as part of the Devil Rays' inaugural season in 1998...he also managed at various levels of Tampa Bay's organization from 1987-2005, compiling a record of 1381-1206 (.534).

\*\*WORTH NOTHING: According to the Elias Sports Bureau, any win in Baldelli's absence is still credited under Rocco's managerial record...Rocco is two wins away from 200 for his career.

**SERIOUS ABOUT THE SERIES:** The Twins are looking to win their 14th series of the season... they have gone 13-25-6 in series play this season, 8-13-1 at home and 5-12-5 on the road... the Twins have gone 5-4-0 in series play since August 5, with four of the five series victories coming against first-place teams (Houston, Chicago-AL, Tampa Bay and Milwaukee)...the Twins are 3-1 in series play against the Indians this season...their last series win over the Indians came in three games at Target Field from August 16-18...last series win at Progressive Field also came in three games from May 21-23.

**PEN STRONG:** In its last 11 games, since August 27, the Twins bullpen has posted a 0.84 ERA (43.0 IP, 4 ER) with 30 hits allowed, 12 walks, 44 strikeouts, a .197 opponent batting average and a .573 opponent OPS...below are the bullpen ranks in the AL since that date:

13 of Juan Minaya's last 14 appearances have been scoreless, posting a 0.98 ERA (18.1 nine games...13 of Juan Minaya's last 14 appearances have been scoreless, posting a 0.98 ERA [18.1] IP, 2 ER) with 23 strikeouts and a .156 opponent batting average in that span...eight of Jorge Alcala's last nine appearances have been scoreless, posting a 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER) with 14 strikeouts and a .179 opponent batting average in that span...Alex Colomé leads baseball with 12 saves since August 1.

CLEVELAND ROCKS: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 15th of 19 meetings in 2021... the Twins have gone 9-5 against Cleveland this season, going 4-2 at Target Field and 5-3 at Progressive Field.

▼ The Twins need one more win in the final five games against the Tribe to secure the season series for the second-straight season (7-3 in 2020)...last time they won consecutive season series' was 2008 (10-8), 2009 (10-8) and 2010 (12-6).

▼ Twins have won five of their last six at Progressive Field, outscoring the Indians 39-14 in that span.

Wills have woll live of their last six at ringlessive rield, outstoring the middles of 1-in that span.
 Since the start of 2020, 20 of the 24 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 13 have been decided by two runs-or-less...five of the 14 meetings this season have gone extra innings (Twins are 3-2).
 Max Kepler has 18 career home runs and 72 career hits against the Tribe, both his most against any opponent...13 of the 18 homers have been hit at Progressive Field, his most in an opposing ballpark.
 Jorge Polanco is hitting .312 (44-for-141) with 13 doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 25 RBI and a .957 OPS in 35 career games at Progressive Field.

**POWER PLAY:** The Twins enter today third in the American League and sixth in all of baseball in home runs with 192, trailing Toronto (213), San Francisco (207), Atlanta (204), Los Angeles-NL (196) and Tampa Bay (195)...the Twins have 94 home runs at home and 98 on the road.

**POLO POP:** Since July 1, Jorge Polanco is hitting .315 (73-for-232) with 15 doubles, one triple, 18 home runs, 52 RBI, a .357 on-base percentage, a .621 slugging percentage and a .978 OPS...below are his American League ranks since July 1 (among qualifiers): HITS

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2012, the Twins retired number 10 in honor of Tom Kelly as he joined Harmon Killebrew (3-1975), Rod Carew (29-1987), Tony Oliva (6-1991), Kent Hrbek (14-1995), Kirby Puckett (34-1997) and Bert Blyleven (28-2011) as the seventh Twin, at the time (Mauer #7 in 2019), to have his number retired by the organization (the Twins, in conjunction with all of MLB, retired Jackie Robinson's No. 42 in 1997)...Kelly is the club's all-time leader in managerial wins with 1,140...he had a Postseason record of 16-8, leading the Twins to two World Championships in 1987 over the St. Louis Cardinals and 1991 over the Atlanta Braves.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan made his major league debut on September 1 vs. Chicago-NL at Target Field, starting and taking the loss as the Twins were shut out, 3-0...allowed three runs on three hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work, tossing 89 pitches (60 strikes)...began his major league career with a one-two-three first inning and fanned lan Happ to end the frame for his first career strikeout...also worked a three-up, three-down second inning before running into trouble in the third... walked leadoff batter Alfonso Rivas and allowed a one-out double by Andrew Romine to start the inning; retired Rafael Ortega on a flyout before yielding a three-run homer to Frank Schwindel — the only runs by either team in the game. permitted a single to Happ before inducing an inning-ending flyout...Ryan closed out his debut with scoreless fourth and fifth innings; the four base runners he allowed in the third were his only of the outing.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan displayed a four-pitch mix in his major league debut on September 1, throwing his fastball 70.8 percent of the time...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire, per Baseball Savant.

SAINTS SUMMARY: Ryan made his Twins organization debut on Friday, August 20 vs. lowa; did not factor into the decision as the Saints won, 7-4...allowed just one hit — a fourth-inning solo homer by Nick Martini — and walked one batter while striking out nine, including the first six batters he faced, in 4.0 innings of work...his performance earned him the Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week award for that timeframe.

that timeframe.
This last Triple-A start prior to his call-up came on August 25 in Toledo; had no part in the decision as the Saints fell to the Mud Hens, 4-2...allowed one run on four hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...fanned at least eight batters for the sixth time in 13 starts this season, as well as the 21st time in 42 career minor league starts.

MINOR LEAGUE SEASON SUMMARY: Ryan was optioned out of major league camp on March 16 and began the season at the Rays' alternate training site, before being assigned to Triple-A Durham — his first career taste of Triple-A baseball...made his season debut on May 5 at Memphis, earning the win after K-ing nine batters and walking none over 5.0 shutout innings (2 hits)...struggled in his next two outings, yielding 10 runs combined from May 11-16, including a career-high-tying six runs in 2.2 innings of work on May 16 vs. Jacksonville...finished May with a 4.57 ERA (21.2 IP, 11 ER) but rebounded with a strong June, going 1-1, 2.79 ERA (19.1 IP, 6 ER), three walks and 22 strikeouts in four outings (3 starts)...missed time at the end of May/early June to play for Team USA in the WBSC Baseball Americas Olympic Qualifier (more on that in the note below).

\*\*The Was named the Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week for July 5-11, after allowing just one hit and one walk, with a season-high-tying nine strikeouts, over a career-high-tying 7.0 shutout innings on July 11 at Norfolk.

MEDAL MAN: Ryan played an important role on Team USA's silver medal-winning baseball squad at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...started twice for the Stars and Stripes, going 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER) with one walk and eight strikeouts...was traded to the Twins while in Japan with Team USA..started and won Team USA's Olympic opener vs. Israel, becoming the first Twins farmhand to record an Olympic victory since Brian Duensing earned the win for Team USA over Team Canada on August 16, 2008 at the Beijing Olympics.

♣ Ryan came to Target Field and threw out the first pitch — while wearing his silver medal — on Sunday, August 15, prior to the Twins' game against the Tampa Bay Rays, his former organization.

♣ Ryan also left Triple-A Durham from May 30-June 11 to participate in the WBSC Baseball Americas Qualifier...started once for Team USA against the Dominican Republic on June 1, taking a nodecision after allowing three runs on four hits, with one walk and 10 strikeouts; two of those 10 K's were against former Toronto Blue Jays slugger José Bautista, who was punched out twice by Ryan...Team USA won that game, 8-6, and went on to win the qualifier and clinch an Olympic berth.

♣ In 2014, Ryan also played for the Team USA 15U squad that finished second at the WBSC World Cup in Mexico...was teammates with Twins' No. 2 prospect (and trade deadline acquisition from Toronto) Austin Martin on that team; the pair were also roommates during the tournament.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT: Ryan became the eighth player to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of four pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), RHP Bailey Ober (May 18), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2), RHP Griffin Jax (June 8) and LHP Charlie Barnes (July 17).

Ryan was the 15th different pitcher to start a game for the Twins this season, the third-highest total in a single season in club history (1961-present)...both the 2017 and 2018 Twins had 16 different pitchers make a start for the club.

TAKE THE BACK ROAD: Ryan grew up in Marin County, California, across the Golden Gate Bridge from San Francisco...his father, Kurtis, is an ultra-marathon runner and extreme athlete whose family has lived in Marin County for five generations...when Joe was younger, Kurtis used to take him on week-long camping trips and hiking and hunting after school...baseball wasn't his central focus, though; his main sport was water polo, which he played year-round, even during baseball season.

Ryan told Sports Illustrated in May 2021 that all those years of water polo set the foundation for his mechanics on the mound, particularly his release point, and the movement and spin he gets on his fastball: "In water polo you learn how to skip the ball. I spent 10 years trying to skip the ball in water polo, and it's the same concept as throwing a fastball: Get the shoulder in position and then let the hand work and get it out front. Throwing a baseball feels the same way. You get that zip right at the end. The ball just takes off. There's not a lot of stress on the body. There's nothing on the TrackMan to suggest that this pitch is anything crazy. But I guess it looks like I'm throwing harder than it is."

Ryan also used the pandemic pause last year to take Muay Thai training lessons via Zoom and did a lot of hiking while staying at his girlfriend's parents' house in Malibu, California, mirroring the fitness trends of his youth.
