THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE: The Twins beat the Indians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 3-0...Joe Ryan (1-1) was the starter and earned his first major league win (2nd career start), pitching 7.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed...he retired his first 19 batters faced and carried a perfect game through 6.1 innings, until allowing an Amed Rosario single to leftfield... the offense recorded six hits, including a home run from Miguel Sano, his 25th of the season.

Ryan became the first pitcher in AL history to throw 7.0-plus shutout innings while allowing no more than one baserunner in either his first or second career start. (STATS Inc.)

10 of Ryan's first 12 major league innings have been perfect frames.

Ryan is the first Twins pitcher to retire 19-in-a-row to start a game since Francisco Liriano on June 12, 2011 vs. Texas. (Elias Sports Bureau)

The combined one-hitter for the Twins staff marked the 20th in club history and third this season, the previous two being April 3 at Milwaukee and April 23 vs. Pittsburgh...the three one-hitters in 2021 ties their 1973 total for most one-hitters in a single season (since '61).

Ryan told the media postgame that current active manager Bill Evers was the first person he met when he arrived at Single-A Hudson Valley in 2018 for his professional debut...Evers was the Tampa Bay minor league field coordinator at the time and was filling in as manager that game.

The Twins shut out the Tribe for the second-straight game, their first back-to-back blanks of an opponent since May 6 and 7, 2019 at Toronto (8-0 & 3-0)...last time they had three-straight shutouts of an opponent was July 5-7, 2004 vs. Kansas City (9-0, 4-0 & 12-0).

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak on the 10-day

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak on the 10-day Injured List with a right middle finger strain...Dobnak, who was scheduled to make the start tonight against the Indians, was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 60-day Injured List on September 1 after missing 61 games with the same injury...to replace Dobnak on the roster, the Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Andrew Albers from Triple-A St. Paul...Albers, who was optioned to Triple-A after Sunday's game against Tampa Bay, has appeared in three games (2 starts) for the Twins this season, going 1-1 and allowing 10 runs on 15 hits in 12.1 innings pitched, with three walks and eight strikeouts...additionally, right-handed pitcher Derek Law, who was designated for release or assignment on Sunday, has cleared waivers and been outrighted to Triple-A St. Paul.

CLEVELAND ROCKS: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 16th of 19 meetings in 2021...
the Twins have gone 10-5 against Cleveland this season, going 4-2 at Target Field and 6-3 at Progressive Field...six wins at Progressive Field matches their most in a single season (also 2003, 10, 12, 15 & 17)...in fact, they have won seven games in Cleveland just once in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901), that coming in 1955 when they went 7-4 at Cleveland Stadium.

© Last night's victory secured the season series for the second-straight season (7-3 in 2020)...

© Twins have won six of their last seven at Progressive Field, outscoring the Indians 42-14 in that span.

WE'RE THE MILLERS: FCL Twins infielder Noah Miller went 5-for-5 with a triple, a home run and five RBI last night against the FCL Orioles Orange...the Twins' first round, 36th overall selection in the 2021 First-Year Player Draft is the younger brother of Indians infielder Owen Miller.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1976, Rod Carew hit a pinch-hit grand slam in the seventh for the Twins, as Minnesota beat Texas, 6-0...it marked Carew's third grand slam of that year...it was the eighth pinch-hit grand slam in Twins history and one of 13 to date... the last to do it was Matt LeCroy on May 19, 2004 at Toronto.

LAST START: Albers did not appear for Triple-A St. Paul during his most recent minor league stint and last pitched for Minnesota on September 4...took the loss in the Twins' 11-4 defeat at Tampa Bay... allowed a career-high nine runs on 10 hits (including a career-high 4 HR) over 3.0 innings of work, with one walk and two strikeouts...yielded two runs in the opening frame on RBI singles by Wander Franco and Yandy Díaz and ran into further trouble in the second inning, permitting five additional tallies, including one on a balk...allowed two more runs in the third inning before departing.

START PRIOR: Albers earned his first win of the season (and first overall since September 14, 2017 while pitching for Seattle) in the Twins' 2-0 shutout victory on August 27 against Milwaukee...tossed 5.1 scoreless innings, yielding just three hits with one walk and two strikeouts...did not allow any extra-base hits...marked his first start of the season and his first start in a Twins uniform since September 23, 2016 when facing Seattle at Target Field.

The victory marked Albers' first win in a Twins uniform since August 12, 2013 vs. Cleveland... his span of eight years and 15 days between wins is sixth longest in Twins/Senators history, trailing only: Harry Kelley (13 years, 66 days—April 16, 1925-June 21, 1938), Mike Fornieles (10 years, 284 days—September 19, 1952-June 30, 1963), Hall-of-Famer Bert Blyleven (9 years, 77 days—May 23, 1976-August 8, 1985), Nick Altrock (8 years, 324 days—July 17, 1909-June 6, 1918) and Joey Haynes (8 years, 321 days—July 4, 1940-May 21, 1949).

BACK IN THE BIG LEAGUES: Albers made his season debut for the Twins in relief on August 19 at New York-AL, as the Twins fell 7-5...marked Albers' first major league game since September 30, 2017 at Los Angeles-AL with Seattle.

player in Twins history (1961-present) to have three different stints with the club (2013, 2016 and 2021)...he's also just the third player in Twins/Senators history to do so, alongside Bobo Newsom (5 stints) and Hall-of-Famer Goose Goslin (3 stints).

Made his MLB debut for the Twins on August 6, 2013...began his major league career with a 17.1-inning scoreless streak, the longest to begin a career by a Twins starter.

CLEVELAND ENCOUNTERS: Albers is making his sixth career appearance and fourth start against Cleveland tonight...is 1-1, 3.54 ERA (20.1 IP, 8 ER), with seven walks and eight strikeouts in his career against the Indians...last faced Cleveland in a relief appearance on September 11, 2016 at Target Field (1.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 K).

On August 12, 2013 Albers pitched a complete-game shutout against Cleveland, allowing

Became the fourth Twins rookie to allow two hits-or-fewer in a complete-game shutout, joining Gary Serum on August 19, 1978 vs. Toronto (2 H), Tom Hall on April 18, 1969 vs. California (2 H) and Gerry Arrigo on June 26, 1964 vs. Chicago-AL (1 H). According to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first pitcher not to allow a run in either of his first two major league games, while pitching at least 8.0 innings in each game, since Baltimore's Tom Phoebus began his career with consecutive shutouts in September 1966.

WHEN THE SAINTS COME MARCHING IN: Albers has appeared in 16 games (15 starts) for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 6-4, 3.86 ERA (91.0 IP, 39 ER), with nine walks and 78 strikeouts.

♣ Was the Saints' Opening Day starter on May 4 at Omaha.

♣ Nine of his 15 starts have been quality, including a stretch of five-straight quality starts from June 18-July 11...posted a 2.40 ERA (30.0 IP, 8 ER) in that stretch.

♣ Tossed a season-high 8.0 shutout innings on August 15 at Indianapolis (his last game with St. Paul before being called up for the first time)...earned the 8-0 win after allowing yielding five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts.

♣ Left the Saints at the end of May to pitch for Team Canada in a qualifier for the Tokyo Olympics from May 31-June 5...went 1-0, 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP, 3 ER), with three walks and nine strikeouts in two starts...Canada did not qualify.

♣ Did not pitch for the Saints during his most recent stint with the team (September 5-8).
