

Twins overpower Phillies

Lyman Bostock, Bob Gorinski and Terry Bulling smashed home runs Monday to power the Minnesota Twins to an 8-5 victory over the Philadelphia Phillies in the 35th annual Hall of Fame exhibition baseball game.

Minnesota rookie Gary Serum hurled hitless ball over the final three innings, helping himself with two excellent fielding plays, to earn the victory before an overflow crowd of 9,892 at Doubleday Field following the annual Hall of Fame installation ceremonies.

The loser was Frank Ciammachilli, who was brought up from the Phillies' Eastern League Reading farm club for the game.

The Phils jumped out to a 5-2 lead on home runs by Richie Hebner, Jerry Martin and Ollie Brown and a sacrifice fly. But Gorinski's three-run homer in the sixth knotted the score and the Twins went
