BARNES BACK IN THE BIGS, PART TWO: The $25-y e a r-o l d ~ B a r n e s ~ w a s ~ r e c a l l e d ~ f r o m ~ T r i p l e-A ~ S t . ~ P a u l ~$ yesterday following John Gant's placement on the 10-day Injured List...he will make his eighth career start and ninth appearance this afternoon...today marks Barnes' fifth major league stint this season, as he was also recalled as the 27th man to make his debut as Minnesota's starter in Game 1 of a July 17 doubleheader at Detroit, was again with the club from July 30 through August 29, was recalled
as the 29th man to make a start in Game 2 of a September 14 doubleheader vs Cleveland and was as the 29th man to make a start in Game 2 of a September 14 doubleheader vs. Cleveland and was with the Twins as recently as last Tuesday, September 28, when he started against the Detroit Tigers (was optioned following the outing - for more on the start, please see "LAST TIME OUT" note below).

$\Phi$ After dropping his first two career starts, the Twins have won four of his last five trips to the hill - including victories at home over eventual division champions Tampa Bay (August 15) and Milwaukee (August 28), followed by a September 14 triumph over American League Central division rival Cleveland and a 3-2 win over Detroit in his last start on September 28...he is 0-3, 5.87 ERA ( $30.2 \mathrm{IP}, 20 \mathrm{ER}$ ) as a starter.
$\Phi$ In MLB.com's prospect rankings released August 19, Barnes was named the No. 30 prospect in the Twins' system.

LAST TIME OUT: Barnes did not factor into the decision of his last start last Tuesday, September 28 against Detroit at Target Field, a 3-2 Twins win...was recalled from Triple-A prior to the game and optioned after...scattered three hits - all doubles - across 4.0 scoreless innings, with three walks and two strikeouts...the Twins scored one run in the third inning and two more in the seventh en route to the win.
$\Phi$ Became the second pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) to allow precisely three extra-base hits and no runs in a start, joining Scott Baker on August 4, 2010 at Tampa Bay (ND, 8.0 IP, $3 \mathrm{H}, 1 \mathrm{BB}, 7 \mathrm{~K}$ )...also became the fourth pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) to allow at least three extra-base hits, at least three walks and no runs in a start, joining Jake 0dorizzi (August 10, 2019), Frankie Rodriguez (June 25, 1996, Game 1) and Jim Perry (Åpril 7, 1970). $\Phi$ The outing marked Barnes' first career scoreless appearance, in either a starting or relief role.
FINALE FACTS: As he takes the mound in this afternoon's season finale, Barnes becomes the first rookie to start the final game of the season for the Twins since Zack Littell on September 30, 2018 vs. Chicago-AL.
$\Phi$ Paired with Griffin Jax last night, this season marks the first time that the Twins have had two rookies start regular-season games in the month of October since Jason Ryan (October 1) and Dan Perkins (October 2) in 1999.

THE ARSENAL: As a pitcher who relies primarily on finesse and pinpoint location rather than overpowering speed, Barnes' fastball averages between 88-90 MPH...as a result, MLB's Statcast has had trouble registering his tastball and has consistently labelled it as a changeup or sinker...with that caveat, here's a picture of the rookie's arsenal, per Baseball Savant.

CENTRAL OF ATTENTION: Today marks Barnes's first career outing against Kansas City, as we as his fifth career appearance and fourth start against the American League Central division... has gone 0-1, 3.63 ERA (17.1 IP, 7 ER ), seven walks and eight strikeouts in his four prior outings.

ROAD TRIPPER: Barnes owns three career road starts, going 0-3, 8.56 ERA (13.2 IP, 13 ER), eight walks and five strikeouts in those outings....atter yielding just one run in 4.2 innings in his major league debut on July 17 at Detroit, has permitted 12 runs in 9.0 innings combined across his last two outings away from Target Field.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT: Barnes is one of nine players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of five pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/ OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), RHP Bailey Ober (May 18), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2), RHP Griffin Jax (June 8), RHP Joe Ryan (September 1) and LHP Jovani Moran (September 12).
ST. PAUL SEASON SUMMARY: Barnes went 6-4, 3.79 ERA (76.0 IP, 32 ER) with 24 walks, 62 strikeouts, a 1.28 WHIP and a 251 (73-for-291) opponent batting average in 16 starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season.
