- ⚡ Tonight marks his 22nd appearance of the season and 21st start...also his 170th career appearance and 169th start.
⚡ Making his 11th career start vs. Detroit tonight...is 4-2, 3.81 ERA (59.0 IP, 25 ER), with nine walks and 65 strikeouts vs. the Tigers in his career.
⚡ Is 4-0, 1.93 ERA (18.2 IP, 4 ER) in four games (3 starts) since being activated from the 10-day Injured List on September 6.

RETURN TO FORM: Since being reinstated from the 10-day Injured List on September 6, Big Mike has gone 4-0, 1.93 ERA (18.2 IP, 4 ER), with four walks and 10 strikeouts across four outings (3 starts, 1 relief appearance).

- ⚡ Pineda has limited opposing hitters to a .133 (2-for-15) average with runners in scoring position in that span.
⚡ Has lowered his season ERA from 4.13 to 3.73 over his current stretch...the last time his season ERA was that low was June 13 (3.70).

LAST TIME OUT: Pineda earned his eighth win of the season in the Twins' 7-2 victory last Thursday, September 23 vs. the Blue Jays at Target Field to open this current homestand...allowed two runs on eight hits (1 HR), with one walk and two strikeouts...permitted single tallies in the second and fourth innings, on a Lourdes Gurriel Jr. RBI double and Teoscar Hernández solo home run...yielded a base hit in each of his 5.0 innings pitched but stranded six total Jays base runners...the Twins bullpen tossed 4.0 scoreless innings to secure the win.

- ⚡ Won his season-high fourth-consecutive decision...marks his longest win streak since winning a career-best eight-consecutive decisions from July 26, 2019-April 4, 2021.
⚡ Eight hits allowed marked his second-highest total this season, behind only his season-high 12 hits allowed on July 7 vs. Chicago-AL.

START PRIOR: Big Mike earned the win in the Twins' 7-3 victory September 17 at Toronto...allowed three runs (1 ER) on three hits (1 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 5.2 innings of work...tossed a scoreless first inning before allowing two unearned runs in the second...permitted his lone earned run of the outing on a Vladimir Guerrero Jr. solo shot in the third...retired 10-consecutive batters following the home run before allowing a two-out walk in the sixth and departing the game.

- ⚡ Three hits allowed marked his fewest in a start since also allowing three on May 26 vs. Baltimore (6.0 IP)...permitted two free passes, walking multiple batters for the first time since June 8 vs. New York-AL (also 2).
⚡ With the win, Pineda became the 29th Dominican-born pitcher to reach 60 career major league victories.

EYE OF THE TIGER: Pineda is making his 11th career start vs. Detroit...is 4-2, 3.81 ERA (59.0 IP, 25 ER), with nine walks and 65 strikeouts against the Tigers in his career.

- ⚡ Tonight also marks Pineda's second start vs. Detroit this year, after taking a no-decision vs. the Tigers at Target Field on July 26 (6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 6 K)...the Twins eventually walked off as 6-5 winners when Max Kepler singled in Kenta Maeda in the 10th.
⚡ Has not lost a decision vs. the Tigers in a Twins uniform...is 3-0 with a 3.75 ERA (36.0 IP, 15 ER), three walks and 36 strikeouts across six starts for the Twins vs. Detroit, dating back to April 13, 2019...Minnesota is 5-1 in those games.

HOW SUPPORTIVE: In his last three starts, Pineda has been supported with a combined 19 runs (6 on 9/11 vs. KC, 7 on 9/17 at TOR, 6 on 9/23 vs. TOR), good for a major league-leading 10.91 run support average in that span (min. 15.0 IP).

- ⚡ Big Mike's recent stretch of heavy run support comes on the heels of receiving six-plus runs of support just twice in his first 17 starts this season.

2021 ARSENAL: Below is a breakdown of Pineda's 2021 three-pitch repertoire, according to Baseball Savant...his offerings this season are similar to his pitching patterns in 2020.

- ⚡ Since his first start of the 2020 season, opponents are hitting .174 (30-for-172) with 64 strikeouts against Pineda's slider.
⚡ In two-and-a-half seasons with the Twins, he has used his four-seam fastball more than half the time (53.8% in 2021, 50.1% in 2020, 54.1% in 2019)...after a career-high 59.5% use rate as a Mariners rookie, he never topped 47.7% as a Yankee.

AT HIS BEST AGAINST THE BEST: Pineda has pitched his best against the heart of opposing lineups, limiting the number two to five hitters to a combined .202 batting average (40-for-198) with seven doubles, nine home runs, nine walks and 41 strikeouts...by contrast, leadoff batters are slashing .439/.467/.667 (25-for-57) with five doubles, one triple, two home runs and three walks, while the six to nine slots are hitting a combined .272 (41-for-151) with 13 doubles, one triple, six home runs, 10 walks and 36 strikeouts.

- ⚡ Big Mike has been especially stingy against opposing cleanup hitters, limiting those batters to nine hits in 50 at-bats (.180), with two doubles, two home runs, two walks, 11 strikeouts, and a .552 OPS.
⚡ Opposing five-hole hitters are also just 9-for-46 (.196), with four doubles, one home run, one walk, seven strikeouts and a .561 OPS.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2021 SEASON: 2-1, 2.45 ERA // CAREER: 2-1, 2.45 ERA)

Rookie right-hander Ryan is due to take the mound tomorrow evening for the Twins' 2021 home finale vs. Detroit...it will mark his first start since being reinstated from the Family Medical Emergency/Bereavement List...last pitched on September 22 at Chicago-NL, earning his second career victory after allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with a career-high 11 strikeouts...became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history (since 1901) to strike out 11 batters in a start of 5.0 innings-or-less...his 25 strikeouts through his first four career games are tied with Dixie Walker (1909) and Dave Boswell (1964) for most in Twins/Senators history.

CAREER NOTES

- Missed last 21 games of 2019, the entire ALDS and the first 36 contests of 2020 due to a 60-game suspension for violating MLB's Joint Drug and Prevention Treatment Program.
• Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...also missed the entire 2012 campaign with New York-AL recovering from right shoulder surgery, and was out of the majors in 2013 while rehabbing.
• Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200+ strikeouts in American League history.
• Was an AL All-Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners, posting a 3.03 ERA (113.0 IP, 38 ER) with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of .198 in the first half, and finished the year fifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting.
• In 2011, he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters, and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka (Boston, 2007).
• Was signed by Seattle as a 16-year-old undrafted free agent December 12, 2005...signed by Patrick Guerrero, brother of Fred Guerrero, Twins' Director of Latin American Scouting & U.S. Integration.
• He owns a farm in his native Dominican Republic, where he raises chickens in addition to growing a number of crops.

START 'EM WITH STRIKE ONE, THEN GET 'EM TO CHASE: This season, Pineda has poured in strike one at a 69.7 percent clip, the best among all American League hurlers (min. 375 batters faced)...he has also induced opposing batters to chase a career-best-tying 34.0 percent of the time to rank in the 95th percentile among all big league hurlers...in his career, Big Mike owns a 65.5 percent first-strike rate and a 33.5 percent chase rate.

- ⚡ When Pineda starts a batter with strike one this season, those opposing hitters are hitting just .231 (55-for-238) with 13 doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 11 walks and 62 strikeouts.
⚡ Once Big Mike gets to a two-strike count, opposing batters are 39-for-209 (.187) with six doubles, three home runs, 16 walks and 83 strikeouts.

SEPTEMBER SUCCESS: Big Mike is 6-0, 2.78 ERA (45.1 IP, 14 ER) in nine games (8 starts) over his last two Septembers, and owns a career 12-6 mark with a 3.05 ERA (171.1 IP, 58 ER) mark in 31 games (30 starts) during the season's final month...his career September ERA is his lowest of any month.
