OR START STRONG: Below are some facts and figures that summarize Ryan's career to date.
Ryan has worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four-or-fewer base runners in each of his first four career games to date, the only pitcher in baseball history (1901-present) to do so.
He is one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow who did so in 2005 . Ryan's 25 career strikeouts are tied with Dixie Walker (1909) and Dave Boswell (1964) for most
in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first four career games...the franchise record for most through a pitcher's first five career games is 29, done by Fernando Romero (2018) and Jim Merritt (1965).
On September 8 at Cleveland, worked 7.0 shutout innings and allowed one base runner, a single... allow one-or-fewer base runners within his first two career starts (Stats Perform)...also retired the first 19 batters he faced, becoming the first Twins pitcher to do so since Francisco Liriano retired the first 19 Rangers on June 12, 2011 vs. Texas (Elias Sports Bureau).
LAST TIME OUT: Ryan's last start came on September 22 at Chicago-NL; earned his second career victory as the Twins won, $5-4 \ldots$ fanned a career-high 11 batters (including six caught looking) and allowed two
runs on three hits, with one walk in 5.0 innings...worked a scoreless first before yielding two runs in the second on a one-out, two-run single by Nico Hoerner... retired 10 of the next 11 batters he faced - including seven-straight strikeouts - before departing after the fifth with the Twins ahead 3-2.

Fanned the final seven batters he faced, one shy of the Twins record (1961-present) for consecutive strikeouts....also became the first Twins rookie with seven-straight strikeouts...per ESPN Stats \& Info, Ryan also became the fourth starter in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to strike out the and Jacob deGrom (2021). Paired with Griffin Jax (10 K on August 10), marks the first time in Twins history (1961-presen
that two different rookie pitchers recorded a 10 -plus strikeout game in the same season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan started the first game of the Twins' September 14 doubleheader vS. Cleveland; did not factor into the decision of a 3-1 Minnesota loss...allowed one run on three hits ( 1 HR), with one
walk and a then-career-high-tying five strikeouts in 5.0 innings...departed in the sixth with the score walk and a then-career-high-tying five strikeouts in 5.0 innings...departed in the sixth with the score
tied at 1-1, after being hit on the right wrist by a Myles Straw liner; Cleveland scored two runs in the top tied at 1-1, after being hit on the

RY OF THE TIGER: Ryan is facing a team other than Chicago-NL and Cleveland for the first time in his career tonight; all four of his major league starts to date have come against either the Cubs or Indians...

MEDAL MAN: Ryan played an important role on Team USA's silver medal-winning baseball squad at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...started twice for the Stars and Stripes, going 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER) with won Team USA's Olympic opener vs. Israel, becoming the first Twins farmhand to record an Olympic victory since Brian Duensing earned the win for Team USA over Team Canada on August 16, 2008 at the Beiling olympics.

Qualifier...started once for Team USA against the participat Republic decision after allowing three runs on four hits, with one walk and 10 strikeouts; two of those 10 K's were against former Toronto Blue Jays slugger José Bautista, who was punched out twice by Ryan...Team USA won that game, 8-6, and went on to win the qualifier and clinch an Olympic berth. In 2014, Ryan also played for the Team USA 15U squad that finished second at the WBSC World
Cup in Mexico...was teammates with Twins' No. 2 prospect (and trade deadline acquisition from Toronto) Austin Martin on that team; the pair were also roommates during the tournament.
