

Phils, Twins Raise 40 Gees for Amateurs

Sandlot baseball players in the Philadelphia and Minneapolis - St. Paul areas benefited when the Phillies beat the **Twins**, 6 to 5, in their annual exhibition game at Connie Mack Stadium, July 26.

More than \$40,000 was realized from the game for which about 30,000 tickets were sold, although only 18,395, mostly youngsters, turned out to see the Phillies score the winning run in the eighth on a double by Mel Roach and a single by Rookie Bobby Wine.

In the top of the eighth, Johnny Goryl hit the game's only home run, an opposite-field drive over the right field fence, to tie the score, and Center Fielder Ted Savage kept the **Twins** from taking the lead with a strong throw home to nip Don Mincher. Mincher had reached second when Shortstop Ruben Amaro muffed his pop to short left field and tried to score on Jerry Zimmerman's single to center.

Key Blow by Savage

Savage had driven in two runs in the fourth inning, when the Phillies scored four times to take a 5 to 1 lead. Joe Bonikowski, a local high school product who was honored before the game, pitched the first inning for the **Twins** and gave up a run, then was followed by two youngsters from the Twins' minor league system.

Jim Merritt, up from Erie (NYP), hurled five innings and was touched for four runs, while Jerry Fosnow, with Wilson, N. C., finished and gave up the winning run.

Rookie John Boozer, recalled from Buffalo (International), went the route for the Phillies.
