THE TWINS: The Twins opened their 62nd season in Minnesota with consecutive losses to the Mariners...they will continue the four-game series against Seattle with the third of four today...following this series, the Twins will host Los Angeles-NL for two games on Tuesday and Wednesday... following this homestand, the Twins will travel to Boston to begin their first roadtrip of 2022 with an off-day on Thursday, followed by four against the Red Sox from April 15-18, then three against the Royals from Ápril 19-21.

TWINS ONE-RUNNED AGAIN: The Twins lost to the Mariners yesterday afternoon by a score of $4-3$, suffering their second-straight one-run defeat...Sonny Gray made his Twins debut by allowing two runs on four hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded four hits, including a go-ahead two-run homer from Byron Buxton in the bottom of the eighth...Luis Arraez celebrated his 25 th hirthday and added a solo home run in the first inning, the seventh of his career..TVler Duffey was called on to save it in the ninth but allowed two runs on three hits and was dealt the loss and blown save.
TWINS AND M'S: The Twins and Mariners are playing each other for the third of seven scheduled games in 2022...they will travel to Seattle for three games at T-Mobile Park from June 13-15..the Twins are just $1-6$ in their last seven vs. the M's, dating back to Apriil 10, 2021
$\Phi$ Carlos Correa has reached safely in 18 -straight games against the Mariners, hitting. 329 (23-for-70) with seven doubles, six RB1, 14 runs scored, nine walks, a 405 ' 0 BP and an .862 OPS in those games...his 99 career hits and 99 career games against the M's are his most vs. any opponent... more information to the lower right.

FOUR-POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton hit his first home run of the season yesterday...it marked his 20th homer in 63 games ( 242 at-bats) since that start of last season...in that span, he ranks fourth in the American League (minimum of 225 AB's) with a 12.10 home run-per-atbat radio, trailing Tampa Bay's Mike Zunino (10.18), Chicago-AL's Yasmani Grandal (11.92) and Los Angeles-AL's Shohei Ohtani (11.96).

SERIES STUFF: The Twins are looking to avoid losing the four-game series today...last season they went 17-29-6 in series play, including 9-16-1 at home and 8-13-5 on the road...they they went 17-29-6 in series play, includ
were 3-3-3 in four-game series in 2021.
PLATINUM RECORDS: Shortstop Carlos Correa will be presented with his Rawlings® Gold Glove and Platinum Glove Awards in a special pregame ceremony tomorrow night at approximately 6:30...last season, he recorded a major league-best 2.9 WAR on defense, also the top defensive WAR in baseball, ahead of infielder Ryan McMahon (2.5) and outfielder Michae A. Taylor (2.3)... he committed just 11 errors on the season in 578 total chances...he ranked second among all major league fielders with 20 defensive runs saved and was sixth among MLB shortstops in Statcast's outs above average metric (plus-12)

major league debut...the oldest on the club is Joe Smith ( 38 years, 0 months, 19 days) and the youngest is Gilberto Celestino ( 23 years, 1 month, 28 days).

SPRING CLEANING: The Twins finished their 32nd Spring Training in Fort Myers, FL on Tuesday with a record of 9-10...Byron Buxton led the club in hits (15), runs (8), doubles (5), home runs 5) and RBI (13)...Bailey Ober led the club in innings pitched (12.0), while Dylan Bundy and Jhoan Duran tied for team-lead in strikeouts (10)...additionally, the Twins drew 45,055 over 19 openings for an average of 5,006-per-game.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Made his major league debut on May 18,2021 vs. Chicago-AL...earned first career win on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL ( $5.0 \mathrm{IP}, 2 \mathrm{H}, 0 \mathrm{R} / \mathrm{ER}, 3 \mathrm{BB}, 7 \mathrm{~K}$ )....first career quality start on August 17 vs. Cleveland ( $6.0 \mathrm{IP}, 5 \mathrm{H}, 3 \mathrm{R} / 2 \mathrm{ER}, \mathrm{O} \mathrm{BB}, 3 \mathrm{~K}$ )..fanned a career-high seven batters thrice - June 11 vs. Houston, July 5 vs. Chicago-AL and August 25 at Boston...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10 -straight starts from July 20 -September 12 , going $1-1$ with a 3.24 ERA ( 50.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 50 strikeouts in that span...named 2021 winner of Bill Boni Award for Twins minor league Player of the Year.

HEY, ROOKIE! YOU WERE GOOD: Ober's 20 starts marked the most by a Twins rookie since Adalberto Meía had 21 in 2017, while his 96 strikeouts were the most since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...96 strikeouts also matched Nick Blackburn (2008) and Gerry Arrigo (1964) for 10th most in a single season by a Minnesota rookie...ranked sixth among American League rookies in ERA (minimum 90.0 IP) and 12th in innings pitched (92.1).

AND ALL'S FAIR IN LOVE AND WAR: Posted a 1.1 WAR in 2021, per Baseball Reference....became the first Twins rookie pitcher to surpass 1.0 WAR in a single season since Tyler Duffey in 2015 (1.6 WAR).

SIT 'EM DOWN: Struck out a career-high seven batters in third start on June 11 vs. Houston (5.0 IP)... matched career high two more times: July 5 vs. Chicago-AL ( 5.0 IP ) and August 25 at Boston ( 5.0 IP ).
$\Phi$ Posted a 5.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the highest single-season mark by a Twins/Senators rookie pitcher (min. 70.0 IP ), and tops among all major league rookies this season (also min. 70.01 P ).

OBERACHIEVER: Allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10 -straight starts from July 20-September 12 , going 1-1 with a $3.24 \mathrm{ERA}(50.0 \mathrm{IP}, 18 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in that span...span included his two quality starts on the season, August 17 vs. Cleveland ( $6.01 \mathrm{IP}, 3 \mathrm{R} / 2 \mathrm{ER}$ ) and August 30 at Detroit ( $6.0 \mathrm{IP}, 2 \mathrm{ER}$ ).
$\Phi$ Went 1-1, 2.30 ERA (27.1 IP, 7 ER) with three walks and 26 strikeouts in five August starts...his
ERA for the month ranked third among AL rookies and his strikeouts ranked 12th.
BAILEY AND JOE: Ober, along with Joe Ryan, are the lone remaining starters from the 2021 season, when it was Kenta Maeda (now injured), José Berríos (traded), Matt Shoemaker (released), J.A. Happ (traded) and Michael Pineda (left as a free agent)...the two returners will join incoming veterans Sonny Gray, Chris Archer and Dylan Bundy.
$\Phi$ Ober debuted in May 2021 and amassed 92.1 innings of work with a 4.19 ERA.
$\Phi$ Ryan, who came to the Twins at the trade deadline in 2021, debuted in September and pitched 26.2 innings with a 4.05 ERA.

MINOR LEAGUE MASTERY: Produced a combined 18-3 record with a 2.41 ERA across four seasons in the Minnesota Twins system....made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, soing $1-0,2.81$ ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a 217 opponent batting average ( 13 -for- 60 )...
went $3-0$ with a 0.38 ERA ( 24.0 PP , 1 ER) in four starts for Double-A Pensacola in 2019 _his mark led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) and he also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2 -or-more innings pitched since at least 1961...also marked the second-lowest single-season ERA by any minor league pitcher since 1992 (min. 75.0 IP), trailing only Erasmo Ramirez's $0.51 \mathrm{ERA}(88.01 \mathrm{IP}$, 5 ER ) in 2009 for the VSL Mariners....boasted a a 0.99 ERA ( $45.2 \mathrm{IP}, 5 \mathrm{ER}$ ) over eight starts with High-A Fort Meyers, recording 53 strikeouts and allowing six walks...went 7-1 for Low-A Cedar Rapids with a 3.84 ERA ( $75.0 \mathrm{IP}, 7 \mathrm{FR}$ ) in 2018.
