THE TWINS: The Twins opened their 62nd season in Minnesota by going 1-2 against the Mariners over the weekend...tonight they will complete the four-game series...tomorrow night the Twins will host Los Angeles-NL for two games through Wednesday...following Wednesday afternoon's series finale against the Dodgers, the Twins will travel to Boston to begin their first roadtrip of 2022 with an off-day on Thursday, followed by four against the Red Sox from April 15-18, then three against the Royals from April 19-21.

BIG FIRST INNING, BIG FIRST WIN: The Twins beat the Mariners yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 10-4, recording their first victory of the 2022 season...Bailey Ober (1-0) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched with two walks, four strikeouts and a home run allowed (Mitch Haniger 3-run shot)...the offense recorded 10 hits, six going for home runs by Byron Buxton (2), Carlos Correa, Jorge Polanco, Max Kepler and Gary Sánchez, who hit his fourth career grand slam.

☞ The Twins scored their first 13 runs of the season all via home run until a seventh inning Gary Sánchez RBI-double yesterday...it marked the most runs scored via home run to start a team's season since 1900. (*Elias Sports Bureau*)

☞ Nine home runs are the most in Twins history in a three-game span to start a season.

PLATINUM RECORDS: Shortstop Carlos Correa will be presented with his Rawlings® Gold Glove and Platinum Glove Awards in a special pregame ceremony tonight at approximately 6:30...last season, he recorded a major league-best 2.9 WAR on defense, also the top defensive WAR in baseball, ahead of infielder Ryan McMahon (2.5) and outfielder Michael A. Taylor (2.3)...he committed just 11 errors on the season in 578 total chances...he ranked second among all major league fielders with 20 defensive runs saved and was sixth among MLB shortstops in Statcast's outs above average metric (plus-12).

TWINS AND M'S: The Twins and Mariners are playing each other for the fourth of seven scheduled games in 2022...they will travel to Seattle for three games at T-Mobile Park from June 13-15...the Twins are just 2-6 in their last eight vs. the M's, dating back to April 10, 2021.

☞ Carlos Correa has reached safely in 19-straight games against the Mariners, hitting .320 (24-for-75) with seven doubles, one home run, seven RBI, 15 runs scored, nine walks, a .393 OBP and an .873 OPS in those games...his 100 career hits and 100 career games against the M's are his most vs. any opponent...more information to the lower right.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .321 (9-for-28) with four walks, a .394 on-base percentage and a .965 OPS in 10 career games vs. Seattle...additionally, two of his seven career homers have come against Mariners pitching.

EXIT SIGNS: The Twins enter today with nine home runs, leading baseball, ahead of Houston (8), Toronto (7) and Texas (6)...below is where they rank in baseball in exit velocity, average distance and launch angle:

BUCK 162: Over his last 162 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .281 (157-for-559) with 44 doubles, two triples, 44 home runs, 98 RBI, 105 runs scored, a .324 on-base percentage, a .603 slugging percentage and a .927 OPS...in that span, the Twins are 100-62.

☞ Buxton is the only player in baseball with three home runs, 11 others have hit two.

☞ Dating back to September 24, Buxton has five doubles, eight home runs, a .978 slugging percentage and a 1.401 OPS in 12 games.

I SEE A BAD MAN ARRAEZ-ING: Luis Arraez enters today with an eight-game hitting streak which dates back to September 26...his career high is 12, done July 2-19, 2019...in his career, he has hit .331 (219-for-662) against right-handed pitching, compared to .258 (54-for-209) against left-handed pitching...additionally, in 247 career games, Arraez's batting average has never dipped below .307 (September 26, 2021).

SERIES STUFF: The Twins are looking to split the four-game series tonight...last season they went 17-29-6 in series play, including 9-16-1 at home and 8-13-5 on the road...they were 3-3-3 in four-game series in 2021.

THE ROSTER: The Twins opened the 2022 season with 19 players on their 28-man roster who were not on the 2021 Opening Day roster: pitchers (13) - Chris Archer, Dylan Bundy, Jharel Cotton, Danny Coulombe, Jhoan Duran, Sonny Gray, Bailey Ober, Chris Paddack, Emilio Pagan, Jhon Romero, Joe Ryan, Joe Smith and Josh Winder; catchers (1) - Gary Sánchez; infielders (3) - Carlos Correa, Nick Gordon and Gio Urshela; and outfielders (2) - Gilberto Celestino and Alex Kirilloff...of the 28 players on the Twins' active roster, 11 began their professional careers in the Twins organization...Winder is the only remaining player looking to make his major league debut...the oldest on the club is Joe Smith (38 years, 0 months, 20 days) and the youngest is Gilberto Celestino (23 years, 1 month, 29 days).

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, KING! Kenta Maeda is celebrating his 34th birthday today...Maeda is currently on the 60-day Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow, a procedure he had done last September...he shares a birthday with Toronto's Cavan Biggio (26) and former first baseman Mark Teixeira (42).

2021 NOTES:

- ☞ Made 23 appearances (19 starts) for Los Angeles-AL, going 2-9 with a 6.06 ERA (90.2 IP, 61 ER).
- ☞ Was the Angels Opening Day starter on April 1st vs. Chicago-AL tossing 6.0 innings while allowing three runs (all earned) with one walk and six strikeouts and taking a no decision...was his second career Opening Day start with his previous one being with Baltimore on March 29, 2018 vs. Minnesota resulting in a Baltimore 11-inning walk-off win.
- ☞ Struck out six or more batters in his first six starts of the season going 0-3 with a 4.00 ERA (36.0 IP, 16 ER) and 40 strikeouts...marked his second-longest streak in his career of at least six or more K's in a start...his longest is seven consecutive from Sept. 12, 2019-Aug. 11, 2020.
- ☞ Held opponents to a .200 batting average (4-for-20) as a reliever (four appearances).
- ☞ Held a 3.47 run support average...marked his lowest in his career and the fourth lowest in the American League.
- ☞ Made five starts against AL Central opponents, going 1-1 with a 3.29 ERA (27.1 IP, 10 ER)...was the lowest ERA against any division in 2021.
- ☞ Was placed on the 60-Day IL from August 25 to the end of the season with a right shoulder strain.

SPRING RECAP: Went 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 3 ER) with one walk, 10 strikeouts and allowed five hits with three of them being home runs in three starts during Spring Training...his 10 strikeouts led the club...in his last Spring Training start Bundy went 4.0 innings with five strikeouts at Boston...allowed two runs in those 4.0 innings with both coming via solo home run.

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Signed to a one-year contract with Minnesota on December 1, 2021...this marks his third professional organization as he spent the previous two seasons with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and his first five Major League seasons with Baltimore (2012-19).

- ☞ Has made three career starts at Target Field, going 0-3 with a 10.13 ERA (13.1 IP, 15 ER) along with six walks and 14 strikeouts...his last start came on April 28, 2019 in a 4-1 Twins victory with Bundy going 5.0 innings with four earned runs, three walks and eight strikeouts.

CAREER VS. SEATTLE: Has made nine appearances (six starts) against Seattle in his career (7 seasons)...Bundy is 3-3, 2.70 ERA (34-for-170), with 10 walks and 52 strikeouts.

- ☞ Tossed his only career complete-game shutout on Aug. 29, 2017 against Seattle where he went 9.0 innings allowing just one hit, a bunt single by Kyle Seager in the top of the fourth inning...went on to retire 17 of his next 19 batters faced.
- ☞ Threw his third career complete game on Aug 6, 2020 in Seattle...Bundy went 9.0 innings allowing one run (earned), a solo home run by Daniel Vogelbach, allowed four hits, no walks and 10 strikeouts.
- ☞ Has fanned eight-or-more batters in four of his six career starts against the Mariners (10.0 SO/9).

AN A-BUNDY-ANCE OF VOTES: Placed ninth in AL Cy Young voting in 2020 going 6-3 with a 3.29 ERA (65.2 IP, 24 ER).

- ☞ Was tied for ninth-most strikeouts in the American League (72), and ranked sixth in opponent batting average (.208 (51-for-245)), fifth in opponent OPS (.614), third in home runs allowed per nine innings (0.69) and tied for second in pitching WAR (2.2).
- ☞ Led the Angels pitching staff in 2020 in wins (6), strikeouts (72) BB/9 (2.3) and quality starts (6)...was second in ERA (3.29), SO/9 (9.8), and opponent OPS (.614) (min. 30 IP).

APRIL BLOOMING: Owns a 3.72 ERA (125.2 IP, 52 ER) in 27 appearances (20 starts) with 35 walks and 123 strikeouts in the month of April throughout his career...his 3.72 ERA marks his lowest in any single month (min. 3 starts)...has made five or more starts in the month of April in his last four seasons (excluding 2020).

WILD WILD WEST: Owns a 14-13 record with a 4.11 ERA (229.2 IP, 105 ER) against the AL West in his career and is his lowest career ERA against any division (second: AL Central 4.16 ERA)...went 1-4 with a 5.90 ERA (27.1 IP, 26 ER) against the AL West last season.

YOU'RE DOIN FINE, OKLAHOMA!: Among MLB pitchers active and non-active born in the state of Oklahoma, Bundy ranks second in strikeouts per nine innings (8.85), sixth in opponent BA (.253), and seventh in opponent OBP (.318), eighth in WHIP (1.31) (min. 750 IP).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: According to Baseball Savant, Bundy has mixed between a five-pitch distribution that includes a four-seam, sinker, change-up, curveball, and slider...has increased his sinker usage from (8.3%) in 2020 to (17.3%) in 2021, while decreasing his change-up usage from (21.3%) in 2020 to (13.7%) in 2021.

- ☞ His .237 opponent batting average against his four-seam fastball marked the lowest of his career (min. 500 FB pitches).
- ☞ Bundy's sinker received a whiff percentage of (11.8%), his highest whiff rate in his career with the sinker...previous high was (11.1%) in 2020.
