THE TWINS: The Twins opened their 62nd season in Minnesota by splitting a four-game series with the Mariners, losing on Friday and Saturday, followed by wins on Sunday and Monday... tonight they will begin a two-game series with Los Angeles-NL... following tomorrow afternoon's series finale against the Dodgers, the Twins will travel to Boston to begin their first roadtrip of 2022 with an off-day on Thursday, followed by four against the Red Sox from April 15-18, then three against the Royals from April 19-21.

DYLAN DEALIN', TWINS SHUT OUT M'S: The Twins shut out the Mariners last night by a score of 4-0, winning their second straight and splitting the four-game series. Dylan Bundy (1-0) made his Twins debut, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed and one walk... Caleb Thielbar, Tyler Duffey, Joe Smith and Jhoan Duran combined for 4.0 scoreless innings of relief... the offense recorded 10 hits for the second straight game, three coming from Luis Arraez, who is now 5-for-9 on the season... Byron Buxton added two hits, both doubles, his first two of the season.

NEW JAX CITY: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala on the 10-day Injured List (retro to April 11) with right elbow inflammation... Alcala appeared in two games against the Mariners over the weekend, pitching 2.1 scoreless innings of relief with two hits allowed, two walks and two strikeouts, throwing 40 total pitches... to replace Alcala on the 28-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Griffin Jax from Triple-A St. Paul. Jax, who had yet to appear for the Saints, was optioned from Twins spring training to St. Paul on April 7... he pitched in three games for the Twins in spring training, going 0-1, 13.50 ERA (4.2 IP, 7 ER), two walks and five strikeouts... the 27-year-old pitched in 18 games (14 starts) for the Twins in 2021, going 4-5 with a 6.37 ERA (82.0 IP, 58 ER), 29 walks and 65 strikeouts.

ONCE UPON A TIME IN HOLLYWOOD: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 16th and 17th time in their history and first time since 2017... they last played the Dodgers in a three-game series in LA from July 24-26, 2017, getting swept in three... they last hosted the Dodgers from April 30-May 1, 2014, also getting swept in three... the Twins are 6-9 all-time (2-4 at Target Field, 3-0 at Metrodome and 1-5 at Dodger Stadium) and have lost six-straight to Los Angeles, dating back to April 30, 2014... their current losing streak is the longest active streak for the Twins against one team.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The Twins went 10-10 in Interleague Play last season, going 4-2 vs. Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Pittsburgh, 2-2 vs. Cincinnati, 1-2 at St. Louis and 2-2 vs. Chicago-NL. The Twins are 242-220 all-time in IL Play, tied with Chicago-AL (242-221) for fifth-most wins in baseball, trailing Boston (279-184), New York-AL (271-191), Los Angeles-AL (255-210) and Oakland (250-221).

FROM THE LEFT SIDE: The Twins will be facing two left-handed starters this series after facing two through their first four games (Robbie Ray on Friday and Marco Gonzales on Sunday)... through four games, they are 12-for-45 with four home runs, 10 RBI, six walks and an .899 OPS vs. lefties... last season, the Twins hit .244/.310/.414 vs. lefties and .240/.316/.428 vs. righties. Byron Buxton hit .325 (26-for-80) with nine doubles, five home runs, six RBI, a .372 on-base percentage and a .997 OPS against left-handed pitching in 2021.

BUCK 162: Over his last 162 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .281 (157-for-558) with 45 doubles, two triples, 44 home runs, 98 RBI, 106 runs scored, a .326 on-base percentage, a .606 slugging percentage and a .931 OPS... in that span, the Twins are 100-62.

Buxton is the only player in baseball with three home runs, 18 others have hit two.

Dating back to September 24, Buxton has seven doubles, eight home runs, a 1.000 slugging percentage and a 1.446 OPS in 13 games.

THANK YOU, JACKIE: With Major League Baseball and its 30 clubs set to honor the 75th anniversary of Jackie Robinson's historic MLB debut this Friday, the Twins will spotlight Jackie's enduring impact on the game and society before and during tonight's game:

Ceremonial First Pitch: Ceremonial first pitches will be thrown by local grade schoolers Nah'Lyiah Davis, Abigail Mutua and Aniyah Stewart - winners of the Twins' Martin Luther King Jr. Day Writing Competition, in which the team and the St. Paul-based Planting People, Growing Justice Leadership Institute (PPGJLI) asked local youth to detail "What it truly means to be a drum major for justice."

National Anthem: Will be performed by Richfield, Minnesota resident and Minnehaha Academy junior Mayah Ruiters.

The Next Generation: Members of the North Community High School baseball team and Thomas Edison High School softball team will be part of the on-field, pregame ceremony... in-game inning breaks will highlight additional local youth athletes, including members of the Twins RBI program, along with Dr. Anika Tyner and PPGJLI, which seeks to plant seeds of social change through education, training and community outreach.

Countdown to Cooperstown: Twins RBI Coordinator and local historian Frank White will join athletes from the Twins RBI program to change the number on the "Countdown to Cooperstown" counter prior to the start of the sixth inning.

Take Me Out to the Ballgame: Members of the Twins RBI program will lead the crowd in "Take Me Out to the Ballgame"

"Thank You 42" T-shirts: All youth, guests and Twins employees on the field during pregame ceremonies and in stands during the game will be wearing special "Thank You 42" T-shirts.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, the Twins played their first ever game at Target Field, hosting the Boston Red Sox and winning 5-2... Carl Pavano was the starter and winner while Jon Rauch earned the save... Joe Mauer went 3-for-5 with two RBI and Jason Kubel went 3-for-4 with a home run and two RBI.
