**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-3 through five games on their current six-game homestand, splitting a four-game series with the Mariners from Friday-Monday, followed by a loss to the Dodgers last night...this afternoon they will play the second of two with Los Angeles-NL... following today's game, the Twins will travel to Boston to begin their first roadtrip of 2022 with an off-day on Thursday, followed by four against the Red Sox from April 15-18, then three against the Royals from April 19-21.

**TWINS CAN'T DODGE THE RAIN:** The Twins lost to the Dodgers last night at Target Field by a score of 7-2, which included a one hour and 28-minute rain delay in the eighth inning...Chris Archer made his Twins debut, pitching 4.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, no walks and three strikeouts...the Twins used seven relievers, including Josh Winder, who made his major league debut with 1.0 inning of relief, allowing one run on two walks with one strikeout...the offense recorded five hits, two from both Carlos Correa (both doubles) and Max Kepler...they went 1-for-14 with runners in scoring position and left eight men on base.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Twins have placed outfielder Alex Kirilloff on the 10-day Injured List with right wrist inflammation and designated right-handed pitcher Jharel Cotton for release or assignment...Kirilloff, 24, played in five games for the Twins, going 1-for-17 (.059) with seven strikeouts and one run scored...Cotton, 30, made two appearances for the Twins, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings with no hits allowed, four walks and two strikeouts...to replace Kirilloff and Cotton on the 28-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder Trevor Larnach and selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Dereck Rodriguez from Triple-A St. Paul...Larnach, 25, played in five games for the Saints, going 2-for-19 (.105) with two RBI and two walks...Rodriguez, 29, made one start for the Saints on Friday at Louisville, pitching 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, two walks and five strikeouts...the 6-foot, 208-pound right-hander has appeared in 51 career major league games (35 starts) all with the San Francisco Giants from 2018-2020, going 12-15, 4.27 ERA (22.1 IP, 105 ER), 75 walks and 162 strikeouts...he is the son of Hall of Fame catcher Ivan Rodriguez and was originally selected by the Twins in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Monsignor Edward Pace High School in Miami Gardens, Florida.

**PADD-LOCKED IN:** Chris Paddack is one of four recently acquired members of the Twins starting rotation (Sonny Gray, Dylan Bundy, Chris Archer)...he was acquired via trade from San Diego, along with Emilio Pagan and a PTBNL, in exchange for Taylor Rogers, Brent Rooker and cash considerations on April 7...the 26-year-old pitched in 23 games (22 starts) for the Padres last season, going 7-7, 5.07 ERA (108.1 IP, 61 ER), 22 walks, 99 strikeouts, a .269 (115-for-427) opponent batting average and a 1.26 WHIP...the 6-foot-5, 217-pound Paddack (pronounced PAD-ik) has pitched in parts of three seasons for the Padres since 2019, going 20-19, 4.21 ERA (308.0 IP, 144 ER), 65 walks, 310 strikeouts, a .239 opponent batting average and a 9.1 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio in 61 games (60 starts)...he was named to *Baseball America's* Major League All-Rookie Team in 2019 after going 9-7, 3.33 ERA (140.2 IP, 52 ER) in 26 starts for the Padres...the Austin, TX native was originally drafted by the Miami Marlins in the eighth round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of Cedar Park High School in Cedar Park, Texas.

**EXIT SIGNS:** The Twins enter today with nine home runs, tied with Houston for most in baseball, ahead of Oakland (8), St. Louis (8) and Toronto (8)...below is where they rank in baseball in exit velocity, average distance and launch angle:

**DODGE-BALL:** The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 16th and 17th times in their history and first time since 2017...they last played the Dodgers in a three-game series in LA from July 24-26, 2017, getting swept in three...they last hosted the Dodgers from April 30-May 1, 2014, also getting swept in three...the Twins are 6-10 all-time (2-5 at Target Field, 3-0 at Metrodome and 1-5 at Dodger Stadium) and have lost seven-straight to Los Angeles, dating back to April 30, 2014...their current losing streak is the longest active streak for the Twins against one team.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY:** The Twins went 10-10 in Interleague Play last season, going 4-2 vs. Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Pittsburgh, 2-2 vs. Cincinnati, 1-2 at St. Louis and 2-2 vs. Chicago-NL.  
 ☞ Twins are 242-221 all-time in IL Play, tied with Chicago-AL (242-221) for fifth-most wins in baseball, trailing Boston (279-184), New York-AL (271-191), Los Angeles-AL (256-210) and Oakland (250-221).

**FROM THE LEFT SIDE:** The Twins are facing a left-handed starter today for the third time in five games (Robbie Ray on Friday, Marco Gonzales on Sunday, Andrew Heaney last night)...through four games, they are 17-for-67 (.254) with four home runs, 11 RBI, eight walks and an .828 OPS vs. lefties...last season, the Twins hit .244/.310/.414 vs. lefties and .240/.316/.428 vs. righties.  
 ☞ Byron Buxton hit .325 (26-for-80) with nine doubles, five home runs, six RBI, a .372 on-base percentage and a .997 OPS against left-handed pitching in 2021.

**BUCK 162:** Over his last 162 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .278 (155-for-561) with 44 doubles, two triples, 44 home runs, 98 RBI, 106 runs scored, a .321 on-base percentage, a .599 slugging percentage and a .920 OPS...in that span, the Twins are 100-62.  
 ☞ Buxton joins St. Louis' Nolan Arenado and Chicago-NL's Seiya Suzuki as the only three players in baseball with three home runs.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2013, New York-NL's Matt Harvey took a no-hitter into the seventh inning, until Justin Morneau hit a home run off the right field foul pole at Target Field with two outs...Harvey had the longest outing of his career, giving up only two hits in 8.0 innings in the Mets 4-2 win...in 2018, the second game of a four-game series vs. the White Sox was postponed (as were games 3 and 4) due to blizzard-like conditions...the Twin Cities experienced approximately 16 inches of snow over the scheduled four-game series.

- Making his first start of the season and 61st of his career...62nd career appearance.
Acquired on April 7 with fellow right-handed pitcher Emilio Pagan and a player to be named later from San Diego in exchange for left-handed pitcher Taylor Rogers, outfielder Brent Rooker and cash considerations.
The 26-year-old right-hander is making his Twins debut in today's game...is the third consecutive Minnesota starter to make his first appearance with the club (following Dylan Bundy vs. Seattle on Monday and Chris Archer vs. Los Angeles-NL on Tuesday) and the final of four newcomers in the Twins' season-opening, six-man rotation (Sonny Gray pitched Saturday vs. Seattle).
Today marks his seventh career start and appearance vs. Los Angeles-NL, his first since May 21, 2021 (with San Diego)...is 1-3, 7.07 ERA (28.0 IP, 22 ER) lifetime vs. the Dodgers.

A LOOK BACK AT 2021: Made 23 appearances (22 starts) for San Diego, going 7-7, 5.07 ERA (108.1 IP, 61 ER) and a staff-leading 1.83 BB/9 IP ratio that also tied for ninth in the majors (min. 100.0 IP) and tied for fourth in the NL.

- Did not allow a home run in his first three starts (April 4-15), tying his career high, and posted another homerless three-start stretch from July 21-August 30...it was his first three-start stretch without allowing a home run since he did so during his rookie 2019 season when he began his major league career without allowing a home run in his first three starts and then did so again in his fifth through seventh career starts.
His lone three-walk outing came in his season debut on April 4 vs. Arizona...went on to allow one-or-fewer walk in 17 of his 22 games started.
Was the only San Diego starter to receive double-digit runs of support, getting 12 runs on May 21 vs. Seattle and a franchise-high 19 runs on July 16 at Washington in San Diego's record setting 24-8 victory...it was the second-most runs any pitcher received in the majors in 2021, behind only Toronto's Steven Matz's 22 on September 12 at Baltimore.
Among all major league pitchers who tossed at least 100.0 innings, his 7.89 run support average ranked first in the NL and second in the majors behind only Steven Matz's 7.94 RSA.
Struck out a career-high-tying 11 of the 22 batters he faced on June 18 vs. Cincinnati in 5.0 IP and 87 pitches.
Snapped a streak of 54 consecutive starts to begin his major league career, making his first relief appearance in the first half finale on July 11 vs. Colorado due to Ryan Weathers' injury...he tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball behind four hits and four strikeouts.

SPRING RECAP: Went 0-2, 5.63 ERA (8.0 IP, 5 ER) with one walk and 11 strikeouts in three spring training appearances for San Diego, including one start...tossed 2.0 innings of two-run ball to open the spring in a start at Milwaukee on March 20...entered in relief on March 31 at Arizona, throwing 3.0 innings and allowing one earned run...last outing of the spring came in relief against Chicago-AL on April 5, giving up four runs (1 home run) in 3.0 innings.

BRING ON THE DODGERS: Paddack has made six career starts against Los Angeles-NL, going 1-3, 7.07 ERA (28.0 IP, 22 ER) with six walks and 25 strikeouts...most recent start against the Dodgers came on September 11, 2021 with San Diego, taking the loss after allowing four earned runs in 4.2 innings in a 5-4 loss at Dodger Stadium...his one win against LAD came on August 3, 2020 at Petco Park, allowing three runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched.

STRIKE FIRST, STRIKE HARD: Since his debut season in 2019 through the end of 2021, his 67.6 first pitch strike percentage is tied with Rick Porcello and Tyler Anderson for the highest percentage in the majors (min. 1,000 batters faced)...as a rookie in 2019, his 71.4 first pitch strike percentage led the majors (min. 140.0 IP), ahead of veterans Max Scherzer (70.4), Madison Bumgarner (69.5) and Masahiro Tanaka (68.7).

Among all pitchers who threw at least 100 curveballs during the 2021 season, Paddack's average vertical movement of 6.9 inches was the 14th highest in the major leagues.

ROOKIE SUCCESS: Made major league debut on March 31, 2019...retired his final 19 batters faced on April 24, 2019 at Seattle to earn his first major league victory.
Posted a 1.93 ERA through his first nine career starts, the lowest ERA in Padres history of any pitcher through their first nine starts...also became the only major league pitcher to debut since 1893 (when the mound was moved to its current distance) to record at least 56 strikeouts while allowing 42-or-fewer baserunners (via hit, walk or HBP) through his first nine career starts.
Became just the third pitcher since 1908 to allow five-or-fewer hits in each of his first nine career starts (min. 3.0 IP per start).
Was one of just six pitchers in 2019 with multiple starts of one-or-fewer hits allowed in 7.0+ innings, along with Trevor Bauer, Luis Castillo, Gerrit Cole, Jack Flaherty and Justin Verlander.
Became one of only 14 rookies in major league history to make more than 25 starts and have a sub-1.00 WHIP.

FRIDAY'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2022 SEASON: 0-1, 4.50 ERA // CAREER: 2-2, 4.11 ERA)

Ryan is scheduled to make his second start of the 2022 season in Thursday's series opener at Boston...making his first career start and appearance against the Red Sox...was just the second rookie pitcher to start on Opening Day in Twins/Senators history (1901-present), joining Tom Hall on April 8, 1969...took the loss on April 8, 2022 against Seattle (4.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R/2 ER, 1 HR, 4 BB, 4 SO)...currently ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the Twins organization, per MLB.com...acquired by the Twins from Tampa Bay on July 22, 2021, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for Nelson Cruz.

- Twins are his third organization, following time with Miami (2015-2016) and San Diego (2016-2021).
Made 23 appearances (22 starts) for San Diego in 2021, going 7-7 with a 5.07 ERA (108.1 IP, 61 ER) and a staff-leading 1.83 BB/9 IP ratio that also tied for ninth in the majors (min. 100.0 IP) and tied for fourth in the NL.
Earned the win in three consecutive outings from July 16-27, 2021, tying a career high from his rookie 2019 season (April 24-May 6, 2019; the fifth, sixth and seventh starts of his career).
Made his first career Opening Day start on July 24, 2020 vs. Arizona, tossing six shutout innings of four-hit ball in San Diego's 7-2 victory.
Posted 58 strikeouts to 12 walks for a 4.83 SO/BB ratio...among all major league pitchers who made at least 12 starts, his 4.83 SO/BB ratio ranked 10th in the majors and fifth in the NL.
Made his first career Postseason start and appearance in Game 1 of the 2020 Wild Card Series vs. St. Louis, allowing six runs and eight hits in 2.1 IP in San Diego's 7-4 defeat.
Broke camp with the Padres and spent a majority of the 2019 season with San Diego, ranking second on the club in wins (9) and strikeouts (153), and third in starts (26) and innings pitched (149.2).
Rode a perfect game into the sixth inning and a no-hitter into the eighth on July 17, 2019 at Miami before Starlin Castro ended the bid with a solo shot to open the frame.
