THE TWINS: The Twins began their 62nd season in Minnesota with a 2-4 homestand, going 2-2 against the Mariners and 0-2 against the Dodgers...this afternoon they will begin their first roadtrip of 2022 with four against the Red Sox at Fenway Park through Monday, followed by three against the Royals from Tuesday-Thursday.

SIGHTS AND SOUNDS: Twins baseball will not air on WCCO radio tomorrow or Tuesday night against the Royals due to Minnesota Timberwolves NBA playoff scheduling conflicts...the broadcasts will still be aired on the Treasure Island Baseball Network, on 102.9 FM The Wolf and the main channel of the Audacy App...additionally, Bally Sports North **Extra** will televise tomorrow's game with the Red Sox.

TWINS SWEPT IN MINNESOTA: The Twins lost to the Dodgers on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 7-0, suffering the two-game sweep...Chris Paddack (0-1) made his Twins debut and was issued the loss, allowing three runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the Twins were held without a baserunner until a Gary Sanchez eighth-inning single to rightfield — their only base hit of the afternoon...additionally, they struck out 14 times and walked just once.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have selected the contract of outfielder Kyle Garlick from Triple-A St. Paul...Garlick, who was reassigned to St. Paul from Twins spring training on April 7, played in four games for the Saints, hitting .231 (3-for-13) with one triple, one home run, four RBI, two runs scored, four walks and a .412 on-base percentage...the 30-year-old played in 36 games for the Twins last season, hitting .232 (23-for-99) with eight doubles, five home runs, 10 RBI, 17 runs scored and a .745 OPS...to make room on the 28-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Derek Rodriguez for release or assignment...Rodriguez appeared in relief on Wednesday afternoon against the Dodgers, allowing three runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with three walks and two strikeouts.

HOMECOMING KING: Twins manager and former Red Sox outfielder (2009) Rocco Baldelli, has a career managerial record against Boston of 5-8 (since 2019), 3-3 at Fenway Park...the Woonsocket, Rhode Island native grew up approximately 49 miles southwest of Fenway Park...he attended Bishop Hendricken High School in Warwick, RI...he grew up a Red Sox fan, watching Wade Boggs, Ellis Burks, Roger Clemens, Mike Greenwell, et al.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the first of seven games in 2022...Minnesota will host Boston for three games at Target Field from August 29-31...last season, the Twins went 2-5 against the Sox, going 1-3 at Target Field from April 13-15 and 1-2 at Fenway from August 24-26...Twins were outscored last season 46-29 (-17).

- ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .350 (50-for-143) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 25 RBI, 31 runs scored, 25 walks, a .445 on-base percentage, a .615 slugging percentage and a 1.060 OPS in 38 career regular season games against the Red Sox...his second highest career batting average against a single opponent (min. 50 AB)...additionally, he has reached base safely in 18 of 19 regular season games at Fenway Park.
- ☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .305 (46-for-151) with 11 doubles, six home runs, 27 RBI and an .834 OPS in 46 career regular season games vs. the Sox.
- ☞ On August 25, 2021, Miguel Sanó hit the longest home run of the season and tied for fifth-longest in the Statcast Era (since 2015), crushing a 495-foot solo shot out of the ballpark in centerfield, off Nick Pivetta...a list of top five longest homers of 2021 to the right.

POWER OUTAGE: Of the 20 runs scored for the Twins this season, their first 13 came via home run, while their last seven have not...the Twins' last home run came on a Carlos Correa solo shot in the sixth inning on Sunday vs. the Mariners, their sixth of the game...they have not homered now in three straight games, marking their longest stretch since July 22-24, 2021 (also 3)...their last four-plus-game stretch without a homer came September 27-29, 2018 (4).

JACKIE ROBINSON DAY: As has been tradition each season since 2004, MLB and Clubs are commemorating Jackie Robinson Day at ballparks throughout the league today — the anniversary of Robinson's historic MLB debut as he broke baseball's color barrier in 1947.

- ☞ Players, managers and coaches will once again wear Robinson's iconic number, with all teams for the first time using Dodger blue "42" jersey numbers (regardless of their primary team colors).
- ☞ MLB has created a special logo for the Diamond Anniversary (lower right).
- ☞ **ADDITIONALLY:** Twins are 20-31 all-time on Jackie Robinson Day (since 1961)...they beat Boston at Target Field by a score of 4-3 on Jackie Robinson Day 2021.

THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ Byron Buxton is playing in his 500th career game today...he enters today with 16 total bases this season, tied for eighth in the AL.
- ☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .424 (14-for-33) in his last 11 games against right-handed pitching, dating back to September 24, 2021.
- ☞ Cody Stashak (10-day IL - right biceps tendinitis) began his rehab assignment with Low-A Fort Myers last night and pitched 1.0 scoreless inning with two strikeouts.
- ☞ High-A Cedar Rapids beat Quad Cities last night by a score of 8-5, giving Brian Dinkelman his 150th career managerial victory.
- ☞ The Twins have the highest launch angle in baseball at 21°.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan was the Twins' Opening Day starter on April 8 vs. Seattle at Target Field...took the loss after yielding two runs – both on a Mitch Haniger two-run homer with two outs in the first inning – on two hits, with a career-high four walks and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings as the Twins lost, 2-1...the Haniger home run was the first hit he's allowed in the first inning in his major league career.

- ☞ Ryan became the second rookie in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to start on Opening Day, alongside Tom Hall in 1969, and just the third player in MLB's Expansion Era (since 1961 – the Twins' first season in Minnesota) to make an Opening Day start within the first six games of his career, joining Steve Busby for the Kansas City Royals in 1973 and José Guzman for the Texas Rangers in 1986.
- ☞ At age 25 years, 307 days old, Ryan was the eighth Twins Opening Day starting pitcher under age 26 in the last 30 years, joining: José Berrios in 2019 (age 24.305), Vance Worley in 2013 (age 25.188), Francisco Liriano in 2009 (age 25.162), Brad Radke in 1997 (age 24.156), Radke in 1996 (age 23.157) and Scott Erickson in 1992 (age 24.064).

NEW SEASON, NEW OPPONENTS: Facing Boston and a team from the American League East division for the first time in his major league career this afternoon...prior to Opening Day, when he faced the AL West, all of his career outings had come against the teams of the American and National League Central divisions.

- ☞ Made one start against the Red Sox in 2022 spring training, on March 27 at Hammond Stadium...tossed 3.0 hitless innings (1 BB, 5 K).
- ☞ Also started twice against the Red Sox in 2021 spring training while with Tampa Bay, working a combined 2.0 perfect frames with two strikeouts...in 2020, took the loss in relief at JetBlue Park on February 22, allowing one run on two hits, with two walks and one strikeout.

AT HOME ON THE ROAD: Ryan has fared better on the road than at home so far in his career – is 0-2, 5.79 ERA (18.2 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 19 strikeouts in four career starts at Target Field, compared to 2-0, 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 2 ER) with one walk and 15 strikeouts in two career starts on the road...arguably the best outing of his career to date – his 7.0-inning, one-hit start on September 8, 2021 at Cleveland – occurred on the road...he also recorded a career-best 11 strikeouts in 5.0 innings at Wrigley Field on September 22, 2021.

THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE: Below are some facts and figures that summarize Ryan's major league career to date.

- ☞ Ryan has 34 career strikeouts, tied with Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven for the Twins/Senators franchise record for most strikeouts through a pitcher's first six career games...the record for most strikeouts through a pitcher's first seven career games is 43, held by Blyleven.
- ☞ His 3.78 strikeout-to-walk ratio (34 K, 9 BB) is tied with Blyleven for third in Twins/Senators history (min. 30.0 IP) through a pitcher's first six career games, behind Andrew Albers (5.00 for the Twins in 2013) and Dixie Walker (3.86 for the Senators from 1909-10).
- ☞ Ryan worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four-or-fewer base runners in each of his first four career games (from September 1-22, 2021), the only pitcher in baseball history (1901-present) to do so.
- ☞ He became one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three-or-fewer hits in each of his first four career games (September 1-22, 2021), alongside San Francisco's Matt Cain, who did so in 2005.
- ☞ On September 8, 2021 at Cleveland, Ryan worked 7.0 shutout innings and allowed one base runner, a single...became the first pitcher in American League history to toss seven-or-more shutout innings and allow one-or-fewer base runners within his first two career starts (*Stats Perform*)...also retired the first 19 batters he faced, becoming the first Twins pitcher to do so since Francisco Liriano retired the first 19 Rangers on June 12, 2011 vs. Texas (*Elias Sports Bureau*).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and for 60.0% of the time in his first start of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire, per Baseball Savant.

2021 REDUX: Ryan began the 2021 season in Triple-A in the Tampa Bay organization, earned a silver medal after pitching for Team USA at the Tokyo Olympics and ended the year with one of the most dominant rookie seasons in Twins/Senators history.

- ☞ Was a non-roster invitee to Tampa Bay Rays spring training and made three appearances.
- ☞ Began the season at Triple-A Durham, named Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week for July 5-11; allowed one hit and one walk, with a season-high-tying nine strikeouts, over a career-high-tying 7.0 shutout innings on July 11 at Norfolk.
- ☞ Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- ☞ Pitched for Team USA at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, going 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts...became the first Twins farmhand to record an Olympic victory since Brian Duensing earned the win for Team USA over Team Canada on August 16, 2008 at the Beijing Olympics.
- ☞ Made his MLB debut on September 1 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).

TOMORROW'S STARTER – RHP SONNY GRAY [2022 SEASON: 0-0, 3.86 ERA // CAREER: 82-72, 3.61 ERA]

Right-hander Sonny Gray is scheduled to start the second game of this four-game series in Boston tomorrow afternoon...made season/Twins debut on April 9 vs. Seattle at Target Field...took no-decision after allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings; Twins lost, 4-3...due to make his 10th career appearance and ninth start vs. Boston, first since 2018 with New York-AL; is 1-6, 6.64 ERA (42.0 IP, 31 ER), 13 walks and 37 strikeouts in prior outings against the Red Sox...last faced Boston on September 28, 2018 at Fenway Park; tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in relief (1 H, 3 K) of 8-5 Yankees win – marked lone career relief appearance against the Red Sox.

- Currently ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the Twins organization, per MLB.com...2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020.
- His 34 career strikeouts are tied with Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven for most in Twins/Senators history (since 1901) through a pitcher's first six career games.
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
