**THE TWINS:** After completing their first homestand with a record of 2-4 (2-2 against the Mariners and 0-2 against the Dodgers), the Twins began their first roadtrip of the season with a win over the Red Sox on Friday afternoon, followed by a loss yesterday...today they will play the third of four at Fenway Park...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Kansas City to play the Royals for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.

**ON THE DIAL:** Twins baseball will not air on WCCO radio Tuesday night against the Royals due to Minnesota Timberwolves NBA playoff scheduling conflicts...the broadcast will still be aired on the Treasure Island Baseball Network, 102.9 FM The Wolf and the main channel of the Audacy App.

NOT SO SONNY SATURDAY: The Twins lost to the Red Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 4-0, getting shut out for the second time this season, both coming in their last three games (also, April 13 vs. LAD)...Sonny Gray (0-1) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing two runs on one hit in 1.2 innings pitched, exiting the game in the second inning with a tight right hamstring...Josh Winder made his second career appearance with 5.1 innings of relief, becoming the first Twins rookie to pitch at least 5.1 innings in relief since Kohl Stewart (6.0 IP) on September 2, 2018 vs. Detroit...Winder also became the first Twins pitcher to record at least 5.1 innings in relief within his first two career games since Pat Dean (5.1 IP) on May 16, 2016 at Detroit...the offense recorded five hits, three coming from Trevor Larnach (double, 2 singles), matching his career high.

**BAILEY DOSE:** In Bailey Ober's 21 career starts, the Twins have a record of 13-8, good for a .619 winning percentage, their highest among starting pitchers since the start of last season... they are 5-2 in their last seven Ober starts and 8-3 in their last 11.

LOVE THAT DIRTY WATER: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the third of seven games in 2022...Minnesota will host Boston for three games at Target Field from August 29-31.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .333 (50-for-150) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 25 RBI, 33 runs scored, 27 walks, a .434 on-base percentage, a .587 slugging percentage and a 1.021 0PS in 40 career regular season games against the Red Sox.

♣ Gary Sánchez has 54 RBI in his career against the Red Sox (69 games), his most vs. any opponent (Baltimore - 52, Tampa Bay - 42).

♣ Miguel Sanó has reached base safely in each of his last 12 starts against Boston (.460 OBP)...additionally, he is hitting .296 (8-for-27) with five runs scored, three home runs, nine RBI, and eight walks in his last eight games at Fenway Park

♣ Luis Arraez is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with 10 walks and a .436 on-base percentage in 14 career games against Boston, reaching base safely in 11 of those.

ARRAEZ TO THE TOP: Luis Arraez is leading off for the second-straight game...he led the club in 2021 with 70 starts from the leadoff spot and hit .312 (88-for-282) with a .368 on-base percentage while there...he is hitting .320 (112-for-350) from the leadoff spot in his career... he is hitting .400 (48-for-120) with a .427 on-base percentage in his career when hitting in the first inning.

**FYI:** Right-handed pitcher Derek Rodríguez cleared waivers yesterday and was outrighted to Triple-A St. Paul...he was designated for release or assignment on Friday after appearing in relief on Wednesday vs. Los Angeles-NL.

HOME RUNS IN 2022

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids infielder Christian Encarnacion-Strand and left-handed pitcher Cade Povich are the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

▼ Encarnacion-Strand, 22, played in seven games for the Kernels to start the season, hitting .467 (14-for-30) with two doubles, five home runs, 20 RBI, seven runs scored and a 1.033 OPS...the 2021 fourth-round pick is the only player in minor league or major league baseball to reach the 20-RBI plateau so far this season.

▼ Povich, 22, made one start for the Kernels on Tuesday at Quad Cities, earning the win while pitching 5.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts on his 22nd birthday...the Reno, Nevada native was drafted by the Twins in the third round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In **2018**, the Twins played host to Cleveland in San Juan, Puerto Rico at Hiram Bithorn Stadium...it was game one of a two-game series on the island...the Twins lost by a score of 6-1 as Jake Odorizzi was the starter and loser, allowing four runs in 5.0 innings pitched, including a home run to Puerto Rico native Francisco Lindor...the game was played in front of 19,516 fans...in **2009**, Jason Kubel became the ninth Twin (11 now) to hit for the cycle against Los Angeles-AL in the Metrodome...he went 4-for-5 in the game, doubling in his first at-bat (1st inning), singling in his second at-bat (3rd inning), tripling in his third at-bat (6th inning) and completing the cycle with a grand slam in his fifth at-bat, capping off a seven-run inning and giving the Twins an 11-9 lead and eventual win...he became the third player in 100 years to finish a cycle with a grand slam (Yankees Tony Lazzeri in 1932 and Oakland's Miguel Tejada in 2001).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his season debut on April 10 vs. Seattle, his second career start against the Mariners and his 21st overall as a Twin...earned the win after allowing four runs on four hits, with two walks in 5.0 innings pitched...also allowed a home run to Mitch Haniger with two on and two out in the third inning...compiled four strikeouts in the start to reach 100 in his career...was also supported with a career-high-tying eight runs of support, as the Twins' offense exploded for six home runs en route to a 10-4 win over the Mariners

**DEEP ARSENAL:** Here's a look at Ober's pitch selection in his 2022 debut, per Baseball Savant...the rookie throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his 4-Seam Fastball and Slider.

SECOND START IN BEANTOWN: Facing the Red Sox for the second time in his career this afternoon. his first start against Boston came on August 25, 2021 at Fenway Park...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings with four hits, two walks and tied his single-game career high with seven strikeouts in a no-decision... the Twins eventually won, 9-6, in 10 innings.

 $\Phi \ \ {\sf Faced Boston twice in 2022 spring training... first start came on March 19 at Hammond Stadium}$ (ND, 2.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 0 K)...traveled to JetBlue Park for his second start (W, 4.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Today's start will be his 11th career outing on the road...has a 1-2 record, 4.26 ERA (44.1 IP, 21 ER), 13 walks and 47 strikeouts away from Target Field...this compares to a 3-1 record, 4.42 ERA (53.0 IP, 26 ER), eight walks and 53 strikeouts at home.

WINNING WAYS: The Twins are 13-8 in Ober's first 21 career starts, dating back to his debut on May 18, 2021...this includes 8-3 in his last 11 starts, since July 31, 2021 – Ober is 3-2, 3.67 ERA (54.0 IP, 22 ER) with eight walks and 55 strikeouts in that span.

**LOOKING BACK AT 2021:** Made his major league debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...earned first career win on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...first career quality start on August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/2 ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...fanned a career-high seven batters thrice — June 11 vs. Houston, July 5 vs. Chicago-AL and August 25 at Boston...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10-straight starts from July 20-September 12, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (50.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 50 strikeouts in that span

AND ALL'S FAIR IN LOVE AND WAR: Posted a 1.1 WAR in 2021, per Baseball Reference...became the first Twins rookie pitcher to surpass 1.0 WAR in a single season since Tyler Duffey in 2015 (1.6 WAR).

A SUCCESSFUL SPRING: Went 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP. 2 ER), six walks and nine strikeouts in four spring training starts...tossed 2.0 scoreless innings to open the spring against Boston on March 19...recorded a spring training-high four strikeouts on March 24 against Tampa Bay...allowed his only two runs of the spring at Tampa Bay on March 29...earned the win in his final outing on April 4 against Boston, tossing 4.0 scoreless innings with three strikeouts...ranked second among Twins pitchers with nine strikeouts, trailing on Dylan Bundy (10).
