THE TWINS: The Twins began their first roadtrip of the 2022 season with a four-game series
split at Fenway Park, winning the book end games of the seriestonight the Twins will play
the first of three at Kauffman Stadium against the Royals through Thursday afternoonafter
this trip, the Twins will play their second homestand of the season by hosfing the White Sox
for three April 22-24 and the Tigers for three April 26-28.
▼ Twins have won five of their last eight games at Kauffman Stadium.

RAISED BY WOLVES: Twins baseball will not air on WCCO radio tonight against the Royals due to Minnesota Timberwolves NBA playoff scheduling conflicts...the broadcast will still be aired on the Treasure Island Baseball Network, 102.9 FM The Wolf and the main channel of the Audacy App...additionally, the telecast will be on CW Twin Cities due to Wolves and Wild games on the Bally Sports North stations.

TWINS WIN ON PATRIOTS' DAY: The Twins beat the Red Sox yesterday afternoon at Fenway Park by a score of 8-3...Dylan Bundy (2-0) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, as the top four in the lineup combined to go 8-for-16 (Polanco, Correa, Urshela and Garlick)...Polanco hit his second home run of the season and Garlick hit his first...the Twins went 1-for-10 with runners in scoring position, finishing the series 4-for-27 (.148) with RISP.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the first of 19 meetings in 2022... last season, the Twins went 9-10 against Kansas City, including 5-5 at Kauffman Stadium and 4-5 at Target Field...the Twins finished up their 2021 season by winning the three-game series at Kauffman Stadium two games to one from October 1-3.
 ▼ Twins hitters had a .774 OPS at Kauffman Stadium last season, their second highest in any AL ballpark (Fenway Park - .841)...their 47 runs scored here were their second most in an opposing ballpark (Progressive Field - 50).
 ▼ Notable individuals offensively vs. KC last season: Trevor Larnach hit .407 (11-for-27) with five walks and a .529 OBP...Byron Buxton hit .359 (14-for-39) with six doubles, three home runs and a 1.134 OPS...Luis Arraez hit .350 (14-for-40) with seven walks and a .451 OBP...Jorge Polanco hit .328 (22-for-67) with six doubles, five home runs and 12 RBI.
 ▼ Miguel Sanó has 19 career home runs against the Royals...he has 67 career RBI against KC, his most vs. any opponent...he has 45 career hits, 12 home runs and 42 RBI at Kauffman Stadium — all his most in any opposing park...since 2017, he has 11 homers at Kauffman, the most among opponents (30 games).
 ▼ Luis Arraez is hitting .354 (34-for-96) with four doubles, one triple, eight RBI, 13 walks, a .434 on-base percentage and an .850 OPS in 27 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 24 of those 27...his batting average is tops among actives (min. 90 AB)...he has 10 hits in his last 16 at-bats at Kauffman.

ROTATIONAL PULL: Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 4-4, 2.96 ERA (45.2 IP, 15 ER) with 11 walks, 37 strikeouts, a .201 opponent batting average and a 0.98 WHIP this season... among all starting staffs in baseball, they rank fifth in ERA and opponent batting average, and sixth in opponent OPS (.615)...with Sonny Gray landing on the 10-day IL on Sunday (low grade right hamstring strain), below are some numbers on the rest of the current Twins rotation:

STANKONIA: Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher John Stankiewicz has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week...the 22-year-old made one start for the Mighty Mussels on Friday vs. Jupiter, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, no walks and 11 career-high strikeouts...the Voorhees, NJ native was signed by the Twins as a free agent on December 14, 2020 out of Fordham University.

LAST TIME OUT: Archer made his season and Twins debut on April 12 in the opener of a two-game series against Los Angeles-NL at Target Field, tossing 4.0 innings of two-hit, shutout ball...did not walk a batter, while striking out three...locked horns with the Dodgers' Andrew Heaney, departing a scoreless contest after 63 pitches (39 for strikes)...game was tied 1-1 heading into the eighth, before LA erupted for six runs off the Twins' bullpen and, after a one-hour, 28-minute rain delay, handed Minnesota a 7-2 loss.

Retired his first 11 batters faced...pitched around a pair of doubles (by Gavin Lux with two outs in the third and by Freddie Freeman leading off the fourth) by holding the Dodgers hitless in four at-bats with runners in scoring position (including a strikeout of lustin Turner to end his outing)

- at-bats with runners in scoring position (including a strikeout of Justin Turner to end his outing). Archer's 4.0 shutout innings marked his longest scoreless start since April 1, 2019, when he blanked St. Louis over 5.0 frames (2 H, 3 BB, 8 K) for Pittsburgh at PNC Park...was his longest scoreless outing without issuing a walk since he dominated Kansas City over 8.0 innings (5, 11 K) on May 10, 2017 at Tropicana Field (with Tampa Bay).

VS. THE ROYALS: Archer is set to make his eighth career start and appearance tonight vs. Kansas City, but first since earning a 2-1 win on September 19, 2018 with Pittsburgh (7.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 8 K)...in fact, has won his last two starts vs. the Royals (also May 10, 2017 with Tampa Bay), while posting a 0.60 ERA (15.0 IP, 1 ER) with one walk, 19 strikeouts and just 11 hits allowed...is 2-4, 4.02 ERA (47.0 IP, 21 ER) in his first seven starts against KC.

The Has three career starts with at least 8.0 innings pitched, no runs allowed and 10-or-more strikeouts...one of those came in that May 10, 2017 game at Tropicana Field, when he blanked the Royals on five hits over 8.0 innings, with one walk and 11 strikeouts, in a 12-1 win.

Tonight marks Archer's first appearance here at Kauffman Stadium since June 1, 2016 (with Tampa Bay)...has struggled in this ballpark, going 0-3, 6.20 ERA (24.2 IP, 17 ER) in four starts (one apiece in the 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016 seasons, all while with the Rays)...did turn in 7.0 innings of shutout ball here on April 8, 2014, a no-decision in Tampa's 1-0 victory.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Tonight marks Archer's first road start of the season and the 110th of his career (113th appearance)...has traditionally been a better pitcher in his home ballparks, where he has posted a 3.38 ERA (626.2 IP, 235 ER), .231 opponent batting avg. (543-for-2351) and .658 opponent OPS in 107 starts and appearances...those numbers rise to a 4.35 ERA (631.2 IP, 305 ER), .248 BAA (604-for-2432) and .724 OPS on the road.

◆ Is looking for his first road win since September 25, 2018 at Wrigley Field, when he worked the first 6.0 innings (4 H, 2 BB, 9 K) of a combined 6-0 Pittsburgh shutout of the Cubs...has not recorded a win as a visitor in an American League ballpark since May 17, 2018 in Anaheim, a 7-1 victory for Tampa Bay over the Angels (6.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 4 BB, 5 K).

◆ Went 0-1, 5.40 ERA (10.0 IP, 6 ER) in three road games (2 starts) for Tampa Bay in 2021 (although the Rays did win both of his starts)...finished 0-5, 6.55 ERA (57.2 IP, 42 ER) in 11 road starts for Pittsburgh in 2019 (Pirates went 2-9).

UNDER THE LIGHTS: Tonight's series opener is just the Twins' third night game in their first 11 contests, following a 6:41 p.m. first pitch on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL at Target Field and a 6:40 p.m. start on April 11 vs. Seattle, also at home. Archer got the ball in that April 12 game and pitched 4.0 scoreless innings vs. the Dodgers, lowering his career night ERA to 3.96 (771.1 IP, 339 ER) in 134 games (133 starts)...he has held opponents to a .246 batting average (723-for-2935) and .705 OPS under the lights; however, his numbers are better across the board in day games, to the tune of a 3.71 ERA (487.0 IP, 201 ER), .229 BAA (424-for-1848) and .670 OPS.

MEANT TO BE: Upon signing with Minnesota, Archer took to his personal Instagram page to post a photo of himself from his Little League days wearing a Twins uniform...the young, then-outfielder was supporting a blue Twins top with the "M" hat...in his Bally Sports North interview, Archer mentioned being a fan of the Twins' "Soul Patrol" outfields of Torii Hunter, Jacque Jones and Matt Lawton (and later with Hunter, Jones and Shannon Stewart).

SPRING RECAP: Inked a free agent deal with Minnesota on March 27...had spent the majority of his offseason working out in Florida, but spent two weeks prior to signing with the Twins in Arizona throwing to a group of fellow then-unsigned free agents.

◆ Made one Grapefruit League start for the Twins, on April 1 vs. Atlanta at Hammond Stadium... threw 50 pitches over 2.2 innings, allowing five runs on three hits, with no walks and one strikeout...touched 95 mph on the radar gun.
