**THE TWINS:** The Twins began their first roadtrip of the 2022 season with a four-game series split at Fenway Park, followed by a loss to the Royals last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three at Kauffman Stadium against the Royals...after tomorrow's series finale in Kansas City, the Twins will travel to Minneapolis to begin their second homestand of the season by hosting the White Sox for three April 22-24 and the Tigers for three April 26-28.

**ROYAL PAINS:** The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 4-3...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched...Tyler Duffey (0-2) was issued the loss and blown save, allowing two runs on three hits in 1.0 innings pitched, including solo home runs from Salvador Pérez and Hunter Dozier...the offense recorded nine hits, two from both Luis Arraez (single, double) and Gary Sánchez (2 doubles)...they went 3-for-11 with runners in scoring position and left nine men on base...the Twins have now lost five of their last seven games overall.

**TWINS AND ROYALS:** The Twins and Royals are playing the second of 19 meetings in 2022...their next series will come in three games at Kauffman from May 20-22...the Twins will host the Royals for the first time for four games from May 26-29...last season, the Twins went 9-10 against Kansas City, including 5-5 at Kauffman Stadium and 4-5 at Target Field.

⚡ Miguel Sanó has 19 career home runs against the Royals...he has 67 career RBI against KC, his most vs. any opponent...he has 45 career hits, 12 home runs and 42 RBI at Kauffman Stadium — all his most in any opposing park...since 2017, he has 11 homers at Kauffman, the most among opponents (30 games).

**ROTATIONAL PULL:** Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 4-4, 3.06 ERA (50.0 IP, 17 ER) with 14 walks, 42 strikeouts, a .204 opponent batting average and a 1.04 WHIP this season...among all starting staffs in baseball, they rank fourth in WHIP, sixth in opponent batting average and OPS (.634), and ninth in ERA...with Sonny Gray landing on the 10-day IL on Sunday (low grade right hamstring strain), below are some numbers on the rest of the current Twins rotation:

**ADDITIONALLY:** This time last year, Archer was on the Rays IL with right forearm tightness, Paddack was in San Diego's rotation, Ryan was in Tampa Bay's minor league system, Ober was in Minnesota's minor league system and Bundy was in Los Angeles-AL's rotation...through games of April 20, 2021, José Berrios, Kenta Maeda, Michael Pineda, Matt Shoemaker, J.A. Happ and Lewis Thorpe all had made starts for the Twins.

**LEFTORIUM:** The Twins are facing a left-handed starter today for the sixth time (2-3) in 11 games...they faced Robbie Ray on April 8 vs. SEA, Marco Gonzales on April 10 vs. SEA, Andrew Heaney on April 12 vs. LAD, Clayton Kershaw on April 13 vs. LAD and Rich Hill on April 18 at Boston...they are hitting just .191 (27-for-141) with 14 walks, four doubles and six home runs against lefties this season.

⚡ Gio Urshela is hitting .333 (5-for-15) with one home run (Robbie Ray), two RBI and one walk against lefties this season...his average against lefties is tied for third-highest in the AL.  
⚡ Ryan Jeffers has a .455 on-base percentage against lefties this season (2 hits, 3 walks in 11 plate appearances)...Jeffers career average vs. lefties compared to righties is 47 points higher (.239 vs. left / .192 vs. right).  
⚡ Eight of Kyle Garlick's nine career home runs have come against left-handed pitching...one this season off Rich Hill on Friday at Boston.

**WITE-OUT AND ERASERS:** Trevor Larnach's at-bat on April 15 at Boston in the eighth inning, which was originally ruled an error on centerfielder Kiké Hernández in the "triangle" at Fenway Park, has been changed by Major League Baseball and is now a double.

**STONE COLD KELLER:** Twins communications intern, Sadie Keller, was named Sports Information Director of the Year by College Gym News yesterday...the University of Minnesota Athletic Communications Student Assistant is a junior in the Carlson School of Management...she worked with the program the last two seasons and served as the primary media relations contact for Minnesota's record-setting gymnastics team.

#### THIS AND THAT:

- ⚡ Gary Sánchez drove in his eighth run of the season last night, which leads the team, ahead of Jorge Polanco (7)...Sánchez's single-season career-high is 90, done in 2017 with New York-AL.
- ⚡ Jorge Polanco has 149 doubles, needing one to reach 150 for his career...he has two doubles this season...he finished 2021 with 35.
- ⚡ Miguel Sanó's next home run will tie him with Tom Brunansky (163) for 10th on the Twins all-time list.
- ⚡ Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Marco Raya struckout a career-high 10 batters last night against Dunedin (6.0 IP)...Raya, 19, was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of United South High School in Laredo, TX.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Paddack made his season and Twins debut on April 13 in the finale of a two-game series against Los Angeles-NL at Target Field...took the 7-0 loss after allowing three runs on six hits, with three strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...marked his 13th career start with zero walks allowed as well as his second career Interleague start with no walks (September 5, 2021 vs. Houston)...the Twins were shut out and held to just one hit...Los Angeles-NL starting pitcher Clayton Kershaw was perfect for 7.0 innings and struck out 13 batters.

- ☞ Was the final of four Minnesota starters to make their Twins debut during the club's season-opening homestand (Sonny Gray vs. Seattle on 4/9, Dylan Bundy vs. Seattle on 4/11 and Chris Archer vs. Los Angeles-NL on 4/12).

**NICE TO MEET YOU, KC:** Tonight marks Paddack's first career outing against the Kansas City Royals and any team from the American League Central...will have faced every division in Major League Baseball after tonight's start.

- ☞ Has 12 career appearances (all starts) against the AL, going 5-4, 4.55 ERA (63.1 IP, 32 ER) in those outings...nine of those starts have come against the AL West with the Padres and he's 4-2, 3.73 ERA (50.2 IP, 21 ER) against the West...is 1-2, 7.82 ERA (12.2 IP, 11 ER) in three starts against the AL East.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Paddack is set to make his first road start/appearance of the season and 33rd of his career...has remained consistent whether on the road or at home...has posted a 4.18 ERA (161.1 IP, 75 ER), .238 (147-for-618) opponent batting average and .733 opponent OPS for an 8-10 record on the road...those numbers slightly rise to a 4.30 ERA (150.2 IP, 72 ER), .243 (141-for-580) opponent batting average and .694 OPS when pitching at his home ballpark.

- ☞ Is looking for his first road win since July 21, 2021 at Atlanta, when he worked 5.0 scoreless innings (3 H, 0 BB, 1 K) in a 3-2 Padres victory over the Braves.
- ☞ Tonight will be just his third start and appearance in an American League stadium...is 0-2, 7.24 ERA (13.2 IP, 11 ER) in three starts at AL ballparks (Yankee Stadium, Oakland Coliseum, Globe Life Field).
- ☞ Went 4-3, 4.05 ERA (60.0 IP, 27 ER) in 12 road starts for San Diego in 2021.

**MENACE OF THE NIGHT:** Most of Paddack's career starts have come in night games...tonight will mark his first of the 2022 season...is 15-14, 4.37 ERA (226.1 IP, 110 ER) in 44 starts at night...holds a 5-6 record, 3.89 ERA (85.2 IP, 37 ER) in 18 appearances (17 starts) in day games.

- ☞ Last start at night came on September 11, 2021 at Los Angeles-NL, a 5-4 Padres loss (L, 4.2 IP, 3 H, 4 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K).
- ☞ Last victory under the lights was on July 27, 2021 vs. Oakland, working 6.0 innings of three-run ball (9 H, 1 BB, 6 K)...San Diego won 7-4.

**A LOOK BACK AT 2021:** Made 23 appearances (22 starts) for San Diego, going 7-7, 5.07 ERA (108.1 IP, 61 ER) and a staff-leading 1.83 walks-per-9.0 IP ratio that also tied for ninth in the majors (min. 100.0 IP) and tied for fourth in the NL.

- ☞ Did not allow a home run in his first three starts (April 4-15), tying his career high, and posted another homerless three-start stretch from July 21-August 30...it was his first three-start stretch without allowing a home run since he did so during his rookie 2019 season when he began his major league career without allowing a home run in his first three starts and then did so again in his fifth through seventh career starts.
- ☞ His lone three-walk outing came in his season debut on April 4 vs. Arizona...went on to allow one-or-fewer walk in 17 of his 22 starts.
- ☞ Was the only San Diego starter to receive double-digit runs of support, getting 12 runs on May 21 vs. Seattle and a franchise-high 19 runs on July 16 at Washington in San Diego's record setting 24-8 victory...it was the second-most runs any pitcher received in the majors in 2021, behind only Toronto's Steven Matz's 22 on September 12 at Baltimore.
- ☞ Snapped a streak of 54 consecutive starts to begin his major league career, making his first relief appearance in the first half finale on July 11 vs. Colorado due to Ryan Weathers' injury...he tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball behind four hits and four strikeouts.
