**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-4 through six games on their seven-game roadtrip, splitting a four-game series with Boston, followed by two consecutive losses in Kansas City... following today's series finale at Kauffman Stadium, the Twins will travel to Minneapolis to begin their second homestand of the season by hosting the White Sox for three games over the weekend...they will enjoy an off-day on Monday, then host the Tigers for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.

**TWINS DROP SERIES TO KC:** The Twins were shut out by the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 2-0, suffering their third shutout of the season, all coming in their last seven games...Chris Paddack (0-2) was the loser, allowing two runs on five hits with no walks in 5.0 innings pitched in his second start for the Twins...the offense recorded just five hits (all singles) and walked twice...just two runners reached scoring position...the loss secured the series victory for the Royals, making the Twins 0-2-2 in series play in 2022.

**TWINS AND ROYALS:** The Twins and Royals are playing the third of 19 meetings in 2022... their next series will come in three games at Kauffman from May 20-22...the Twins will host the Royals for the first time for four games from May 26-29.

⚡ Miguel Sanó has 19 career home runs against the Royals...he has 67 career RBI against KC, his most vs. any opponent...he has 46 career hits, 12 home runs and 42 RBI at Kauffman Stadium — all his most in any opposing ballpark...since 2017, he has 11 homers at Kauffman, the most among opponents (31 games).

⚡ Luis Arraez is hitting .356 (36-for-101) with five doubles, one triple, eight RBI, 14 walks, a .437 on-base percentage and an .863 OPS in 29 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 25 of those 29...his batting average is tops among actives (min. 90 AB)...he has 12 hits in his last 21 at-bats at Kauffman (.571 avg).

**ROTATIONAL PULL:** Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 4-5, 3.11 ERA (55.0 IP, 19 ER) with 14 walks, 46 strikeouts, a .210 opponent batting average and a 1.04 WHIP this season...among all starting staffs in baseball, they rank third in WHIP, fifth in opponent OPS (.629), seventh in opponent batting average and eighth in ERA...with Sonny Gray landing on the 10-day IL on April 17 (low grade right hamstring strain), below are some numbers on the rest of the current Twins rotation:

**BUCK YEAH:** Byron Buxton is in the lineup today for the first time since April 15 at Boston, missing the club's last five games after injuring his right knee while doubling to open the roadtrip...he is starting at DH for the second time in his career, the previous coming on April 13 vs. Los Angeles-NL...over his last 162 games, he is hitting .280 (156-for-557) with 44 doubles, two triples, 44 home runs, 97 RBI, 106 runs scored, a .323 on-base percentage, a .603 slugging percentage and a .927 OPS...in that span, the Twins are 99-63.

⚡ Entering that series opener at Fenway Park, Buxton ranked tied for second in the AL in home runs (3) and tied for eighth in total bases (16).

**CLOSE THE BROOM CLOSET:** The Twins are looking to avoid being swept today for the second time this season...their other sweep came in two games by the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13...last season, the Twins were swept six times.

**ICYMI:** Right-handed pitcher Jharel Cotton has cleared waivers and has been outrighted to Triple-A St. Paul...Cotton was designated for release or assignment on April 13 after 2.0 scoreless innings for the Twins.

**NO, IT'S IOWA:** Minor League Baseball today announced the August 9 game between the Quad Cities River Bandits (Royals) and the Cedar Rapidsernels (Twins) will take place at the now iconic MLB ballpark next to the historic Field of Dreams movie site near Dyersville, Iowa... similar to last year's MLB at Field of Dreams game in Dyersville where the New York Yankees and Chicago White Sox donned throwback jerseys that replicated their 1919 uniforms, the host River Bandits will become the Davenport Blue Sox (their name during the 1913-1916, 1929-1933 and 1934-1937 seasons), while the visiting kernels will become the Cedar Rapids Bunnies (their name from 1904-1932) for the MiLB at Field of Dreams game.

**BEIN' GREEN:** In recognition of the club's near-100 percent waste diversion rate last year, Major League Baseball today announced that the Twins have won the 2021 Green Glove Award...the Green Glove Award is given to the MLB club with the highest diversion rate during the previous year; in 2021, the Twins saved nearly 99 percent of Target Field waste from landfills — a process driven by both the club's partners and the in-ballpark efforts of fans.


**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1961, the Twins played their first game in Minnesota at Metropolitan Stadium after moving from Washington...they lost that game to the expansion "new" Washington Senators by a score of 5-3...Camilo Pascual was the starter for the Twins, allowing three runs on eight hits in 8.0 innings pitched...Ray Moore was the losing pitcher, allowing two runs in the top of the ninth inning...the Twins went on to win their first ever game in Minnesota the following day against the Senators.

- ⚡ After starting the season 0-for-7 with a walk, Jorge Polanco has posted a .381 on-base percentage in his last 10 games.
- ⚡ Jorge Polanco has 149 doubles, needing one to reach 150 for his career...he has two doubles this season...he finished 2021 with 35.
- ⚡ Miguel Sanó's next home run will tie him with Tom Brunansky (163) for 10th on the Twins all-time list.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his first win of the season last Friday, April 15 at Boston, as the Twins defeated the Red Sox 8-4...yielded one run on five hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts in 6.0 innings... lone run he allowed came on a solo homer by Alex Verdugo in the second inning...marked his second career quality start as well as his second career start with no walks allowed, previously achieving both feats on September 8, 2021 at Cleveland (W, 7.0 IP, 1 H, 4 K).

☞ His seven strikeouts marked his second most in a single start in his career, behind only his career-best 11 on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL...ended the game with 41 career strikeouts, second most in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first seven career games.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ryan was the Twins' Opening Day starter on April 8 vs. Seattle at Target Field and took the loss after yielding two runs on two hits (1 HR), with a career-high four walks and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings as the Twins lost, 2-1...became the second rookie in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to start on Opening Day, alongside Tom Hall in 1969, and just the third player in MLB's Expansion Era (since 1961 – the Twins' first season in Minnesota) to make an Opening Day start within the first six games of his career, joining Steve Busby for the Kansas City Royals in 1973 and José Guzman for the Texas Rangers in 1986.

**DIVISIONAL DO'S AND DON'TS:** Facing Kansas City for the first time in his career...also making his fourth career start and appearance against the American League Central division...he's 1-0, 3.78 ERA (16.2 IP, 7 ER) with three walks, 14 strikeouts and a .167 (10-for-60) opponent batting average in his three prior starts...lone road start against the division occurred on September 8, 2021 at Cleveland, when he earned the win after allowing one hit and no walks in 7.0 shutout innings, with four strikeouts.

**AT HOME ON THE ROAD:** Ryan has fared better on the road than at home so far in his career – is 0-2, 5.79 ERA (18.2 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 19 strikeouts in four career starts at Target Field, compared to 3-0, 1.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 3 ER) with one walk and 22 strikeouts in three career starts on the road...arguably the best outing of his career to date – his 7.0-inning, one-hit start on September 8, 2021 at Cleveland – occurred on the road...he also recorded a career-best 11 strikeouts in 5.0 innings at Wrigley Field on September 22, 2021...additionally, all three of his career victories have come on the road (September 8, 2021 at Cleveland; September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL; April 15, 2022 at Boston).

**SHINING IN THE SUN:** Including today, all three of Ryan's starts this season will have occurred in day games...has pitched slightly better under the sun than under the lights so far in his career – is 1-1, 2.40 ERA (15.0 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and 16 strikeouts in three career day starts, compared to 2-1, 4.57 ERA (21.2 IP, 11 ER) in four career night starts.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and 48.0% of the time through his first two starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire, per Baseball Savant.

**THE GOAL IS...TO THROW STRIKES:** Ryan posted a 73.2 strike percentage (80 pitches, 62 strikes) in his last start on April 15 in Boston, the fourth time in seven career starts he's thrown at least 70 percent of his pitches in the zone in a single outing (career best percentage is 74.6%, done in the first game of the doubleheader on September 14, 2021 vs. Cleveland)...owns a 69.5 career strike percentage, which ranks ninth in the majors since the start of 2021 (min. 30.0 IP).

**GREEN THUMB:** In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having a tree planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 11 batters so far...additionally, tomorrow marks the 52nd Earth Day, which has been celebrated annually since 1970.

**SPRING RECAP:** Ryan made two Grapefruit League starts for the Twins this year, tossing 5.0 scoreless innings and permitting just three hits and one walk, with six strikeouts...faced Atlanta on March 22 (2.0 IP, 3 H, 0 BB, 1 K) and Boston on March 27 (3.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K), both at Hammond Stadium.

**THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE:** Below are some facts and figures that summarize Ryan's major league career to date.

- ☞ Ryan has 41 career strikeouts, second most in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first seven career games trailing only Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (43)...the record for most strikeouts through a pitcher's first eight career games is 48, also held by Blyleven.
- ☞ Owns a 4.56 strikeout-to-walk ratio through his first seven career outings, third best in Twins/Senators history (min. 30.0 IP) in a pitcher's first seven career games, behind Andrew Albers (6.67) and Doc Ayers (6.00).
- ☞ Ryan worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four-or-fewer base runners in each of his first four career games (from September 1-22, 2021), the only pitcher in baseball history (1901-present) to do so.
- ☞ He became one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three-or-fewer hits in each of his first four career games (September 1-22, 2021), alongside San Francisco's Matt Cain, who did so in 2005.
- ☞ On September 8, 2021 at Cleveland, Ryan worked 7.0 shutout innings and allowed one base runner, a single...became the first pitcher in American League history to toss seven-or-more shutout innings and allow one-or-fewer base runners within his first two career starts (*Stats Perform*)...also retired the first 19 batters he faced, becoming the first Twins pitcher to do so since Francisco Liriano retired the first 19 Rangers on June 12, 2011 vs. Texas (*Elias Sports Bureau*).

**TOMORROW'S STARTER – RHP BAILEY OBER [2022 SEASON: 1-1, 3.27 ERA // CAREER: 4-4, 4.09 ERA]**

Right-hander Bailey Ober is due to start the Twins' series opener tomorrow night against the Chicago White Sox at Target Field...took the loss in his last start on April 17 at Boston, despite allowing just four hits and two unearned runs in 6.0 innings, with one walk and three strikeouts as the Twins fell, 8-1...marked his third career quality start (also, August 17, 2021 vs. Cleveland and August 30, 2021 at Detroit)...made his major league debut in May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL and will be facing the White Sox for the sixth time in his career (all starts); has gone 1-1, 4.76 ERA (22.2 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 24 strikeouts in his five prior starts.

**CAREER NOTES**

- Currently ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the Twins organization, per MLB.com...2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020.
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Single-A Bowling Green (6 starts), Single-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, *Baseball America* High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
