THE TWINS: The Twins finished their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4, going 2-2 at Fenway Park and 1-2 at Kauffman Stadium...tonight, the Twins will begin their second homestand of the season with the first of three against the White Sox...they will enjoy an off-day on Monday then host the Tigers for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.

RYAN EXPRESS RUNS THROUGH KC: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 1-0...their only run came on a Miguel Sanó sacrifice fly in the second inning...Joe Ryan (2-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, one walk and five strikeouts...Emilio Pagan earned his first save of the season with a scoreless ninth inning, his first save since August 23, 2020 for the Padres...Nick Gordon had two of the Twins eight hits and recorded an outfield assist, throwing out Andrew Benintendi at home plate in the fourth inning.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the first of 19 meetings this season...the Twins went 6-13 against the Sox in 2021, going 4-5 at Target Field and 2-8 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins have won three of their last four against the Sox.

- ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .458 (11-for-24) with one double, one triple, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.438 OPS in his last seven games against the White Sox.
- ☞ Byron Buxton has hit safely in seven straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 27, 2019...in that span, he is hitting .464 (13-for-28) with three doubles, four home runs, six RBI and a 1.464 OPS.
- ☞ Luis Arraez has hit safely in nine straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in that span, he is hitting .375 (12-for-32) with an .831 OPS.
- ☞ Miguel Sanó has hit 23 home runs in 78 career games against the White Sox, his most homers against any opponent.
- ☞ Max Kepler (15), former Twin Nelson Cruz (15) and Sanó (14) hold the top three spots in home runs against the White Sox since the start of 2019.
- ☞ The Twins have hit 83 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019, ahead of second place Cleveland's 61.

THE PLAYER HAS BEEN GIVEN A NAME: The player to be named later in the trade that brought the Twins Chris Paddack and Emilio Pagan from San Diego in exchange for Taylor Rogers, Brent Rooker and cash considerations is right-handed pitcher Braylan Medina...he was the top Venezuelan pitching prospect in the 2019-20 international class and signed with the Padres on July 2, 2019...after the pandemic cancelled the 2020 season, he spent some time in San Diego's fall instructional camp and then made his professional debut in 2021, throwing a combined 33.2 innings in the Dominican Summer League and Arizona Complex League...he is projected to pitch in the FCL this season.

ARRIGHT SIDE: Luis Arraez is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, four walks, a .433 on-base percentage and a .972 OPS against right-handed pitching this season...among all active players with a minimum of 600 at-bats, he leads baseball in batting average against right-handers at .331 (226-for-683), ahead of Robinson Canó (.313) and Michael Brantley (.311).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The Twins enter today tied for second in baseball with four first-inning home runs (with Toronto, behind Seattle - 5), tied for second with seven first-inning extra-base hits (with Oakland, Seattle, St. Louis and Toronto, behind Philadelphia - 8), tied for sixth in the majors with 10 first-inning runs and sixth with a .308 batting average in the first inning.

BEIN' GREEN: In recognition of the club's near-100 percent waste diversion rate last year, Major League Baseball yesterday announced that the Twins have won the 2021 Green Glove Award...the Green Glove Award is given to the MLB club with the highest diversion rate during the previous year; in 2021, the Twins saved nearly 99 percent of Target Field waste from landfills - a process driven by both the club's partners and the in-ballpark efforts of fans...additionally, rookie pitcher Joe Ryan has partnered with Players for the Planet this season to plant a tree for every strikeout he records; he has 16 in three starts so far this season. ☞ The Twins have an all-time record of 20-23 on Earth Day, which has been celebrated annually on April 22 since 1970.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1961, the Twins won their first game in Minnesota at Metropolitan Stadium after moving from Washington...the score was 5-4 over the Washington Senators in 10 innings...they won on a Zoilo Versalles sac fly, scoring Earl Battey in front of a crowd of 17,445...in 1985, the Twins recorded 16 hits in a 9-5 victory over Seattle...in the fourth inning, Kirby Puckett hit a three-run home run, his first homer in the majors, off Matt Young.

Sixth career start and appearance against Chicago-AL...has gone 1-1, 4.76 ERA (22.2 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 24 strikeouts in his five prior starts. Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his first loss of the season last Sunday, April 17 at Boston, as the Twins fell to the Red Sox, 8-1...allowed just four hits and two unearned runs in 6.0 innings, with one walk and three strikeouts...marked his third career quality start (also August 17, 2021 vs. Cleveland and August 30, 2021 at Detroit).

Has gone 2-1, 2.76 ERA (16.1 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and 13 strikeouts in his last three starts, dating back to September 24, 2021.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his season debut on April 10 vs. Seattle...earned the win after allowing four runs on four hits, with two walks in 5.0 innings pitched...allowed a home run to Mitch Haniger with two on and two out in the third inning...recorded four strikeouts in the start to reach 100 in his career...was supported with a career-high-tying eight runs of support, as the Twins' offense exploded for six home runs en route to a 10-4 win over the Mariners.

DEEP ARSENAL: Here's a look at Ober's pitch selection in his first two starts this season, per Baseball Savant...the rookie throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his 4-Seam Fastball and Slider.

A FAMILIAR FOE: Made his major league debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL and will be facing the White Sox for the sixth time in his career (all starts)...has gone 1-1, 4.76 ERA (22.2 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 24 strikeouts in his five prior starts...hasn't faced any other opponent more than twice.

Last start against the White Sox came on August 11, 2021 at Target Field (ND, 5.1 IP, 6 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K) in a 1-0 Twins victory...last win against Chicago-AL was an 8-5 victory at Target Field on July 5, 2021 (W, 5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 SO).

HOME SWEET HOME: Ober is 3-1, 4.42 ERA (53.0 IP, 26 ER) with 13 walks and 53 strikeouts in 11 career starts at Target Field, compared to 1-3, 3.75 ERA (50.1 IP, 21 ER) with nine walks and 50 strikeouts in 11 career starts on the road.

Has fared better at home against the White Sox...is 1-0, 2.51 ERA (14.1 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and 17 strikeouts when facing Chicago-AL at Target Field...numbers rise to 0-1, 8.64 ERA (8.1 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and seven strikeouts at Guaranteed Rate Field.

WINNING WAYS: The Twins are 13-9 in Ober's first 22 career starts, dating back to his debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...this includes 8-4 in his last 12 starts, since July 31, 2021 - Ober is 3-3, 3.30 ERA (60.0 IP, 22 ER) with nine walks and 58 strikeouts in that span.

A SUCCESSFUL SPRING: Went 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 2 ER), six walks and nine strikeouts in four spring training starts...tossed 2.0 scoreless innings to open the spring against Boston on March 19...recorded a spring training-high four strikeouts on March 24 against Tampa Bay...allowed his only two runs of the spring at Tampa Bay on March 29...earned the win in his final outing on April 4 against Boston, tossing 4.0 scoreless innings with three strikeouts.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Made his major league debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...earned first career win on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...first career quality start on August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/2 ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...fanned a career-high seven batters thrice - June 11 vs. Houston, July 5 vs. Chicago-AL and August 25 at Boston...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10-straight starts from July 20-September 12, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (50.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 50 strikeouts in that span.

Posted a 5.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the highest single-season mark by a Twins/Senators rookie pitcher (min. 70.0 IP), and tops among all major league rookies last season (also min. 70.0 IP)...named 2021 winner of Bill Boni Award for Twins minor league Player of the Year.

HEY, ROOKIE! YOU WERE GOOD: Ober's 20 starts in 2021 marked the most by a Twins rookie since Adalberto Mejia had 21 in 2017, while his 96 strikeouts were the most since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...96 strikeouts also matched Nick Blackburn (2008) and Gerry Arrigo (1964) for 10th most in a single season by a Minnesota rookie...ranked sixth among American League rookies in ERA (minimum 90.0 IP) and 12th in innings pitched (92.1).

AND ALL'S FAIR IN LOVE AND WAR: Posted a 1.1 WAR in 2021, per Baseball Reference...became the first Twins rookie pitcher to surpass 1.0 WAR in a single season since Tyler Duffy in 2015 (1.6 WAR).

CAREER NOTES

- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL. Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks, 117 strikeouts and a .252 opponent batting average in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota. In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season. Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020. Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola. Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961. Named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week for Fort Myers on April 14 and Southern League Pitcher of the Week for Pensacola on September 2. Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K). In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season. Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston for the 2017 season. Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John Surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY (2022 SEASON: 2-0, 0.87 ERA // CAREER: 48-57, 4.67 ERA)

Right-hander Dylan Bundy is due to start tomorrow afternoon against the Chicago White Sox at Target Field...earned the win in his last start on April 18 at Boston, tossing 5.1 innings (5 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 6 K) in an 8-3 Twins victory...his lone run allowed came on an RBI groundout by Christian Vásquez in the fifth inning...has allowed one earned run combined in his first two starts of the season...is making his seventh career appearance (sixth start) against the White Sox and is 4-0, 3.97 ERA (34.0 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks, 37 strikeouts and a .214 (27-for-126) opponent average.
