THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (2-2 at Fenway Park and 1-2 at Kauffman Stadium), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a win over the White Sox last night...today, they will play the second of three against Chicago and wrap the series tomorrow afternoon...they will enjoy an off-day on Monday then host the Tigers for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.

TWINS STEAL ONE LATE FROM SOX: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 2-1, giving Minnesota its first win this season when trailing after seven innings (1-7)...the Twins scored two runs on one play that including throwing errors from Tim Anderson and José Abreu...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on five hits and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched...the bullpen of Griffin Jax, Tyler Duffey and Emilio Pagan combined for 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed and five strikeouts as Pagan earned his second save (2nd straight game)...the offense recorded five hits, including two from Trevor Larnach, who now has three hits in his last four at-bats.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have selected the contract of catcher José Godoy from Triple-A St. Paul...Godoy, who was originally claimed off waivers from the San Francisco Giants in spring training, played in four games for the Saints, going 2-for-15 with one double, one walk and three runs scored...the 27-year-old made his major league debut with the Seattle Mariners in 2021 and hit .162 (6-for-37) with one double, three RBI, three walks and two runs scored in 16 games...to make room on the 28-man roster, the Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Jhon Romero on the 10-day Injured List (retro April 20) with right biceps tendinitis...Romero, who was claimed off waivers from the Washington Nationals in spring training, appeared in four games for the Twins, allowing two runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcalá to the 60-day Injured List...Alcalá has missed the Twins' last 10 games with right elbow inflammation.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the second of 19 meetings this season...the Twins went 6-13 against the Sox in 2021, going 4-5 at Target Field and 2-8 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins have won four of their last five against the Sox.

- ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .407 (11-for-27) with one double, one triple, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.300 OPS in his last eight games against the White Sox.
- ☞ Byron Buxton has hit safely in seven straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 27, 2019...in that span, he is hitting .464 (13-for-28) with three doubles, four home runs, six RBI and a 1.464 OPS.
- ☞ Luis Arraez has hit safely in 10 straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in that span, he is hitting .371 (13-for-35) with an .834 OPS.
- ☞ Miguel Sanó has hit 23 home runs in 79 career games against the White Sox, his most homers against any opponent.
- ☞ Max Kepler (15), former Twin Nelson Cruz (15) and Sanó (14) hold the top three spots in home runs against the White Sox since the start of 2019.
- ☞ The Twins have hit 83 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019, ahead of second place Cleveland's 61.

STARTING LINE: Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 5-5, 2.73 ERA (66.0 IP, 20 ER) with 15 walks, 57 strikeouts, a .206 opponent batting average and a 0.98 WHIP this season...AL starting staff rankings below:

NOTE: Sonny Gray began the season as the club's number two starter but was placed on the 10-day Injured List on April 17 with a strained right hamstring, an injury he felt during his second start on April 16 at Boston.

POLISHING UP THE 'PEN: In the last three games, the Twins bullpen has thrown 10.0 scoreless innings with a .091 opponent batting average (3-for-33) with four walks and 12 strikeouts... additionally, in the last five games, relievers have combined to post a 2.08 ERA (17.1 IP, 4 ER) with a .219 opponent batting average (14-for-64) with six walks and 20 strikeouts.

- ☞ Joe Smith enters today's game with a 4.2-innings scoreless streak to start the season... in his last 30 games, dating back to July 26, 2021, he has gone 3-3, 1.57 ERA (23.0 IP, 4 ER) with opponents hitting .183.
- ☞ Jhoan Duran ranks tied for second in the AL in strikeouts among relievers with 13...his 16.71 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP ratio ranks fifth best.

ARRIGHT SIDE: Luis Arraez is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, five walks, a .441 on-base percentage and a .958 OPS against right-handed pitching this season...among all active players with a minimum of 600 at-bats, he leads baseball in batting average against right-handers at .331 (227-for-686), ahead of Robinson Canó (.313) and Mike Trout (.311).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1980, Angels pitcher Bruce Kison settled for a one-hitter when Minnesota's Ken Landreaux hit a ninth-inning double in a California 17-0 win...for Landreaux, the hit marked the beginning of a 31-game hitting streak, the longest in Twins history.

- Making his second start of the season and 135th of his career...163rd career appearance. Today marks Bundy's third start of the season and seventh career appearance (6th start) against the White Sox, going 4-0, 3.97 ERA (34.0 IP, 15 ER). Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Bundy made his first road start of the season and second start overall in the finale of a four-game series against the Red Sox last Monday, April 18...tossed 5.1 innings, and allowed one run on five hits, with no walks and six strikeouts in an 8-3 Twins victory...his lone run allowed came on a RBI groundout by Christian Vázquez in the 5th inning.

- Retired 13 of his first 14 batters faced...gave up two consecutive hits in the 5th inning, stranding one runner on base...also gave up consecutive hits in the sixth inning, then was replaced by Joe Smith, who ended up stranding the bases loaded. Bundy earned his second consecutive victory, marking his first time winning back-to-back starts since he won on August 6, 2020 at Seattle (w/ LAA) and August 11, 2020 vs. Oakland (w/LAA). Has thrown 5.0-or-more innings in consecutive games for first time since May 31-June 7, 2021 with the Angels, where he tossed consecutive 5.2-inning outings earning each a victory and a loss in that span. Bundy has allowed one earned run combined in his first two starts of the season...hasn't allowed one earned run or less combined in his first two starts of the season since March 29, 2018 vs. Minnesota (7.0 IP, 0 ER) and April 4, 2018 at Houston (6.0 IP, 1 ER).

TWO STARTS AGO: Bundy made his Twins debut on April 11 vs. Seattle, tossing 5.0 shutout innings and allowed just one hit, with one walk and two strikeouts...earned his first career win at Target Field in a 4-0 Twins victory...his start marked his first of at least 5.0 innings pitched with no runs allowed since August 5, 2021 at Texas...his start also marked his first of at least 5.0 innings with one hit allowed since August 29, 2017, where he threw a complete-game shutout (1 hit allowed) also against Seattle.

CAREER VS. CHICAGO-AL: Is making his seventh career appearance and sixth start against the White Sox this afternoon...career 4-0, 3.97 ERA (34.0 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks, 37 strikeouts and a .214 (27-for-126) opponent batting average.

- Is making his fourth career appearance and third start against the White Sox as the home pitcher...is 1-0, 3.86 ERA (14.0 IP, 6 ER), with two walks and 10 strikeouts in his career against Chicago-AL at home. Bundy's 3.97 career ERA against Chicago-AL marks his fifth lowest min. 10.0 IP against any opponent (2.44 ERA vs. Seattle, 2.82 ERA vs. Cleveland, 3.13 ERA vs. Texas, 3.27 ERA vs. Toronto)...his .214 opponent batting average is his third lowest among AL teams (.200 vs. Bal and .187 vs. Seattle).

SIZZLIN' START: Among all American League pitchers (min. 10.0 IP), Bundy ranks among the top in multiple categories in his first two starts...first in WHIP (0.68) fourth in ERA (0.87), fifth in BAA (.158), second in opponent OPS (.416), and eighth in pitching WAR (0.4).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: According to Baseball Savant, Bundy used a five-pitch mix in his first two starts of the season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his usages of each pitch, including right/left splits and opponent batting average.

Was the Angels Opening Day starter on April 1st vs. Chicago-AL tossing 6.0 innings while allowing three runs (all earned) with one walk and six strikeouts and taking a no decision...was his second career Opening Day start with his previous one being with Baltimore on March 29, 2018 vs. Minnesota resulting in a Baltimore 11-inning walk-off win. CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs. Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts. In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes. Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhardt Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season. Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City. Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th). Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta. Became 17th Orioles pitcher to record 10 wins in rookie season and first since Wei-Yin Chen (12 wins in 2012). Named Orioles top prospect according to Baseball America and Baseball Prospectus following the 2014 season. Underwent Tommy John surgery on right elbow June 27 2013, performed by Dr. James Andrews. Veteran right-hander Archer is scheduled to make his third start of the season in tomorrow's series finale against the White Sox...tossed 4.1 innings in his last start on April 19 at Kansas City, two runs on four hits, with five strikeouts as the Twins fell 4-3...will be making his 10th career start (11th appearance) against Chicago-AL...is 4-2, 4.17 ERA (49.2 IP, 23 ER) with 14 wals and 49 strikeouts, against the White Sox in his career...is 1-1, 2.01 ERA (22.1 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 23 strikeouts in four career starts when facing Chicago at home.
