THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (2-2 at Fenway Park and 1-2 at Kauffman Stadium), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a win over the White Sox last night...today, they will play the second of three agains Chicago and wrap the series tomorrow afternoon...they will enjoy an off-day on Monday then host the Tigers for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.

TWINS STEAL ONE LATE FROM SOX: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 2-1, giving Minnesota its first win this season when trailing after seven inning (1-1)...the wins scored two runs on one play that including throwing errors from Iim Anderson ne jose Abreu....Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing Duffey and Emilio and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched...the bullpen of Griftin Jax, Tyler Dufriey and Emilio. Pagan combined for 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed and five hits, including two from Trevor Larnach, who now has three hits in his last four at-bats.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have selected the contract of catcher José Godoy from Triple-A St. Paul...Godoy, who was originally claimed off waivers from the San Francisco Giants in spring training, played in four games for the Saints, going 2-for-15 with one double, one walk and three runs scored...the 27-year-old made his major league debut with the Seattle Mariners in 2021 and hit . 162 ( 6 -for-37) with one double, three RBI, three walks and two runs scored in 16 games...to make room on the 28 -man roster, the Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Jhon Romero on the 10-day Injured List (retro April 20) with right biceps tendinitis...Romero, who was claimed off waivers from the Washington Nationals in spring training, appeared in four games for the Twins, allowing two runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala to the 60-day Injured List...Alcala has missed the Twins' last 10 games with right elbow inflammation.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the second of 19 meetings this season.. the Twins went 6-13 against the Sox in 2021, going 4-5 at Target Field and 2-8 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins have won four of their last five against the Sox.
$\Phi$ Jorge Polanco is hitting 407 (11-for-27) with one double, one triple, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.300 OPS in his last eight games against the White Sox.
$\mp$ Byron Buxton has hit safely in seven straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 27, 2019...in that span, he is hitting . 464 (13-for-28) with three doubles, four home runs, six RBI and a 1.464 OPS
$\Phi$ Luis Arraez has hit safely in 10 straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 5 , 2021 ..in that span, he is hitting .371 (13-for-35) with an .834 OPS
