THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (2-2 at Fenway Park and 1-2 at Kauffman Stadium), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with consecutive wins over the White Sox the last two days...today, they will play the threegame series finale against Chicago...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow then host the Tigers for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.

BUNDY, BUCK....BATTLESTAR GALACTICA: The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday at Target Field by a score of 9-2, securing their first series win of the season (1-2-2)...Dylan Bundy (3) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...the offense set a season-high with 14 hits as both Byron Buxton and Luis Arraez (career-high) each recorded four...Buxton (4) and Ryan Jeffers (1) each homered.
क Dylan Bundy became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-or-fewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (Elias)....also became the third pitcher in Twins/ Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (Elias).

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the third of 19 meetings this season.. the Twins and Sox next series will take place from July 4-6 at Guaranteed Rate Field for three games...Twins have won five of their last six against the Sox.
$\Phi$ Jorge Polanco is hitting 375 (12-for-32) with one double, one triple, three home runs, क Byron Buxton has hit safely in eight straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 27, 2019...in that span, he is hitting . 531 (17-for-32) with four doubles, five home runs, eight RBI and a 1.670 OPS
क Luis Arraez has hit safely in 11 straight against the White Sox dating back to July 5 , 2021...in that span, he is hitting . 425 (17-for-40) with a . 927 OPS.

क Steer, 24, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting . 417 (10-for-24) with three doubles, six RBI, six walks, a .533 on-base percentage and a 1.075 OPS...the Long Beach, California native was drafted by the Twins in the third round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Oregon.
क Raya, 19, made one start for the Mighty Mussels on Tuesday at Dunedin and pitched 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and a career high 10 strikeouts...the Laredo, Texas native was drafted by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2020 First-Yea Player Draft out of United South High School.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, MORAN!: Triple-A St. Paul left-handed pitcher Jovani Moran is celebrating his 25th birthday today...Moran, who is on the club's 40-man roster, is 0-0, 5.40 ERA ( 5.0 IP , 3 ER) with five walks and nine strikeouts through four games with the Saints.

LAST TIME OUT: Archer started last Tuesday night's series opener in Kansas City, but did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on four hits in 4.1 innings ( $3 \mathrm{BB}, 5 \mathrm{~K}$ )...the Royals used a pair of solo home runs in the sixth inning off of Tyler Duffey to erase a 3-2 deficit and win, 4-3. \$ Opened his Twins career with 7.1 scoreless innings after blanking KC for the first 3.1 ' frames.
$\Phi$ Salvador Perez connected for a one-out, solo homer off him in the fourth, before Archer ran into trouble in the fifth...after retiring the leadoff batter, the next four Royals batters reached base (2 $1 \mathrm{~B}, 2 \mathrm{BB})$....was replaced by Joe Smith after issuing a bases-loaded walk to Ni
subsequently got Bobby Witt Jr. to bounce into an inning-ending double play.

TWO STARTS AGO: Archer made his season and Twins debut on April 12 in the opener of a two-game series against Los Angeles-NL at Target Field, tossing 4.0 innings of two-hit, shutout ball...did not walk a batter, while striking out three...locked horns with the Dodgers' Andrew Heaney, departing a scoreless contest after 63 pitches ( 39 for strikes)...game was tied 1-1 heading into the eighth, before LA erupted for six runs off the Twins' bullpen and, after a one-hour, 28 -minute rain delay, handed Minnesota a 7-2 loss.
$\Phi$ Retired his first 11 batters faced...pitched around a pair of doubles (by Gavin Lux with two outs in the third and by Freddie Freeman leading off the fourth) by holding the Dodgers hitless in four
at-bats with runners in scoring position (including a strikeout of Justin Turner to end his outing).
क Archer's 4.0 shutout innings marked his longest scoreless start since April 1, 2019 , when he blanked St. Louis over 5.0 frames ( $2 \mathrm{H}, 3 \mathrm{BB}, 8 \mathrm{~K}$ ) for Pittsburgh at PNC Park....Was his longest
scoreless outing without issuing a walk since he dominated Kansas City over 8.0 innings ( 5 H, 11 K) on May 10, 2017 at Tropicana Field (with Tampa Bay).

VS. THE WHITE SOX: Today marks Archer's 11th career appearance and 10th start vs. Chicago-AL...
is 4-2, 4.17 ERA (49.2 IP, 23 ER) lifetime against the White Sox; has posted a 3.59 ERA (47.2 IP, 19 $E R$ ) and all of his decisions across his nine starts.
$\Phi$ Was activated off the 60-day Injured List and made a start against the White Sox on August 22, 2021 for Tampa Bay at Tropicana Field...struck out four over 2.0 scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and one walk in helping the Rays to a 9-0 victory...marked his first appearance against Chicago since April 9, 2018.
ARCHER ON TARGET: In seven lifetime starts at Target Field, Archer is 4-0, 2.06 ERA ( 39.1 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 43 strikeouts - his lowest ERA at any ballpark in which he has made at least four starts...pitched here as a Twin for the first time on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL, tossing 4.0 scoreless innings ( $2 \mathrm{H}, 0 \mathrm{BB}, 3 \mathrm{~K}$ ).

क Has traditionally been a better pitcher in his home ballparks, where he has posted a 3.38 ERA (626.2 IP, 235 ER), 231 opponent batting avg. (543-for-2351) and . 658 opponent OPS in 107 starts and appearances...those numb
(608-for-2449) and .724 OPS on the road.

SUNSHINE DAY: Archer takes the ball this afternoon for his first day start of the 2022 season....has posted slightly better numbers in day games than at night throughout his career, with a 3.71 ERA posted slightly better numbers in day games than at night throughout his career, with a 3.51 ERA
( 487.0 IP ), 229 opponent batting average (424-for-1848) and a .670 opponent OPS in 85 games ( 83 starts)...has a 3.96 ERA ( 775.2 IP, 341 ER), 246 BAA (727-for-2952) and .705 OPS in 135 night contests (134 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Archer, who has featured either a three- or four-pitch mix throughout his career, has been mostly shown just two offerings over his first two Twins starts, per Baseball Savant: a slider and a fourseamer....he did throw five curveballs in his April 12 start...below is the website's tracking of his first two starts with Minnesota:

SOFT CONTACT: Average exit velocity off Archer in his first two starts has been just 87.7 mph (down from 92.1 mph in his 6 appearances in 2021), with a hard-hit percentage of 30.4 ( $50 \%$ in 2021).
$\Phi$ Has yielded just six hits in 31 at-bats overall (.194), while holding right-handed batters to a 158 mark (3-for-19)

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) signed a one-year contract with Minnesota on March 27...marks his fifth organization (Cleveland 2006-08, Chicago-NL, 2019-10, Tampa Bay 2011-18 and '21) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).
© In a recent Bally Sports North interview, Archer cited his relationship with Twins Manager Rocco Baldelli and Vice President, Baseball Operations Strategy \& Innovation Josh Kalk (both of whom were with Tampa Bay's front office and/or coaching staff from 2011-17), Minnesota's catching duo and up-the-middle defense, and positive reviews from one-time Rays teammate and former Twins starter Jake Odorizzi among his many reasons for coming to the Twin Cities.
MEANT TO BE: Upon signing with Minnesota, Archer took to his personal Instagram page to post a photo of himself from his Little League days wearing a Twins uniform...the young, then-outfielder was supporting a blue Twins top with the "M" hat...in his Bally Sports North interview, Archer mentioned later with Hunter, wis and Shannon Stewart). later with Hunter, Jones and Shannon Stewart).

- Twins are his fifth organization, following time with Cleveland (2006-08), Chicago-NL (2009-10), Tampa Bay (2011-18 and 2021) and Pittsburgh (2018-20)
- Has recorded double-digit strikeout totals 30 times in career...also boasts three seasons with at least 200.0 innings pitched and 200-plus strikeouts ( 212.0 IP and 252 K in $2015,201.1$ and 233 in 2016 , and 201.0 and 249 in 2017).
- Despite spending half of the 2018 season and all of the 2019 campaign in the National League, before missing 2020, he still ranks eighth in the American League with 1033 strikeouts since 2014...is fourth in the Junior Circuit over the same stretch by averaging 10.01 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched.
- Missed the 2020 season recovering from thoracic outlet surgery.... procedure was per
formed on June 2, 2020 by Dr. Robert Thompson at Washington University in St. Louis.
- Twice named to the American League All-Star Team (2015 and 2017).
- Pitched for Team USA in 2017 World Baseball Classic, starting and tossing 4.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts in an eventual 3-2,10-inning walk-off win over Columbia to open Pool Play.. Bam USA would go on win the 2017 WBC
- Led Major League Baseball and tied his own Tampa Bay record with 34 starts in 2017 - Posted a Rays-record 252 strikeouts in 2015 , second in the AL behind the White Sox Chris Sale (274) and fourth in the majors....finished the season 12-13, becoming the seventh pitcher in the modern era (since 1900) to record 250 strikeouts without posting Steve Carlton, Phil Niekro and Ed Walsh.
- Finished fifth in 2015 AL Cy Young Award voting after leading the big leagues and setting Tampa's club mark with 34 starts...also ranked sixth in the AL with a 3.23 ERA. - Finished third in 2013 AL Rookie of the Year balloting...named AL Pitcher of the Month and AL Rookie of the Month for July 2013.
