THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (2-2 at Fenway Park and 1-2 at Kauffman Stadium), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with consecutive wins over the White Sox the last two days...today, they will play the three-game series finale against Chicago...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow then host the Tigers for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.

BUNDY, BUCK...BATTLESTAR GALACTICA: The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday at Target Field by a score of 9-2, securing their first series win of the season (1-2-2)...Dylan Bundy (3-0) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...the offense set a season-high with 14 hits as both Byron Buxton and Luis Arraez (career-high) each recorded four...Buxton (4) and Ryan Jeffers (1) each homered.
 ☞ Dylan Bundy became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-or-fewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (Elias)...also became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (Elias).

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the third of 19 meetings this season...the Twins and Sox next series will take place from July 4-6 at Guaranteed Rate Field for three games...Twins have won five of their last six against the Sox.

- ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .375 (12-for-32) with one double, one triple, three home runs, eight RBI and a 1.162 OPS in his last nine games against the White Sox.
- ☞ Byron Buxton has hit safely in eight straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 27, 2019...in that span, he is hitting .531 (17-for-32) with four doubles, five home runs, eight RBI and a 1.670 OPS.
- ☞ Luis Arraez has hit safely in 11 straight against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in that span, he is hitting .425 (17-for-40) with a .927 OPS.
- ☞ Miguel Sanó has hit 23 home runs in 80 career games against the White Sox, his most homers against any opponent.
- ☞ Max Kepler (15), former Twin Nelson Cruz (15) and Sanó (14) hold the top three spots in home runs against the White Sox since the start of 2019...Kepler has three HR off Giolito (32 AB).
- ☞ The Twins have hit 85 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019, ahead of second place Cleveland's 61.
- ☞ The Twins have won four straight against the Sox, dating back to August 10, 2021, their longest streak over Chicago since winning five straight from August 27-September 17, 2019.

STARTING LINE: Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 6-5, 2.54 ERA (71.0 IP, 20 ER) with 15 walks, 61 strikeouts, a .206 opponent batting average and a 0.97 WHIP this season...AL starting staff rankings below:

NOTE: Sonny Gray began the season as the club's number two starter but was placed on the 10-day Injured List on April 17 with a strained right hamstring, an injury he felt during his second start on April 16 at Boston.

BUST OUT THE BROOMS: The Twins are seeking their first sweep of the season today...they swept an opponent four times last season: May 24-26 vs. Baltimore in three games, June 18-20 at Texas in three games, July 8-11 vs. Detroit in four games and September 21-22 at Chicago-NL in two games...the Twins' last sweep of the White Sox came in three games at Guaranteed Rate Field from August 27-29, 2019.

LUERY IS ARRIGT: Luis Arraez is hitting .406 (13-for-32) with two doubles, one home run, five RBI, five walks, a .486 on-base percentage and a 1.049 OPS against right-handed pitching this season...his batting average ranks third in the AL and seventh in baseball.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Double-A Wichita infielder Spencer Steer and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Marco Raya have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

- ☞ Steer, 24, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .417 (10-for-24) with three doubles, six RBI, six walks, a .533 on-base percentage and a 1.075 OPS...the Long Beach, California native was drafted by the Twins in the third round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Oregon.
- ☞ Raya, 19, made one start for the Mighty Mussels on Tuesday at Dunedin and pitched 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and a career high 10 strikeouts...the Laredo, Texas native was drafted by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of United South High School.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, MORAN!: Triple-A St. Paul left-handed pitcher Jovani Moran is celebrating his 25th birthday today...Moran, who is on the club's 40-man roster, is 0-0, 5.40 ERA (5.0 IP, 3 ER) with five walks and nine strikeouts through four games with the Saints.
