**TWO STARTS AGO:** Paddack made his season and Twins debut on April 13 in the finale of a two-game series against Los Angeles-NL at Target Field...took the loss after allowing three runs on six hits, with three strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...marked his 13th career start with zero walks allowed as well as his second career Interleague start with no walks (September 5, 2021 vs. Houston)...the Twins were shut out, 7-0, and held to just one hit...Los Angeles-NL starting pitcher Clayton Kershaw tossed 7.0 perfect innings and struck out 13 batters.

MENACE OF THE NIGHT: Most of Paddack's career starts have come in night games...tonight will mark his second of the 2022 season... is 15-15, 4.36 ERA (231.1 IP, 112 ER) in 45 career starts at night... holds a 5-6 record, 3.89 ERA (85.2 IP, 37 ER) in 18 career appearances (17 starts) in day games.
 Tat at night came on April 20, 2022 at Kansas City, a 2-0 Twins loss (L, 5.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K).
 Last victory under the lights was on July 27, 2021 vs. Oakland, working 6.0 innings of three-run ball (9 H, 1 BB, 6 K)...San Diego won 7-4.
