HE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-0 through four games on their current six-game, seven-day homestand, sweeping the White Sox in three games over the weekend, followed by a win ove the Tigers last night...tonight, they will play the second of three against Detroit at Target Field...following tomorrow afternoon's series finale, Minnesota will travel to St. Petersburg to begin a seven-game roadtrip with three games against the Rays this weekend, followed by four games in Baltimore from April 2-5.
UMMM, WHAT?: The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 5-4 in wild walk-off fashion, their second straight walk-off victory (Buxton 10th inning home run on Sunday)...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing on run on five hits in a season-high 5.2 innings pitched with six strikeouts (also season-high)... the offense recorded just five hits, two apiece from Gio Urshela and Max Kepler....Kepler drove in three of the club's five runs, hitting his second home run and second double of the ninth left-handed starter Eduardo Rodriguez...the Twins scored two runs in the bottom of the nint
on a chaotic play which began with a Miguel Sano single, followed by a throwing error by Eric Haase that sailed into leftfield, following confusion by the Twins on the basepaths.
$\Phi$ The ninth-inning runs scored on the error marked the first time the Twins plated the tying and winning run on an error in walk-off fashion since September 3, 2003 vs. Anaheim when Shannon Stewart doubled off Troy Percival, then Dustan Mohr and Stewart both scored on a fielding error by catcher Bengie Molina.
TWINS-TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the second of 19 meetings in 2022...after this series, the Twins will host the Tigers for three games from May 23-25...the Twins' first trip to Comerica Park will come in five games from May 30-June 2 (doubleheader on May 31). $\Phi$ The Twins have won 18 of their last 27 over the Tigers and 23 of their last 35 .
क At Target Field, the Twins have gone 11-3 in their last 14 vs. Detroit, 16-4 in their last 20 and 22-7 in their last 29.
क Jorge Polanco is hitting . 303 (101-for-333) with 18 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs 54 RBI, 25 walks and an . 842 OPS in 86 career games against the Tigers.... he has reached base safely in 18 straight against Detroit
क Tonight's Tigers starter Michael Pineda pitched three seasons for Minnesota from 2019-21 going 22-13, 3.80 ERA (282.0 IP, 119 ER) with 56 walks, 253 strikeouts and 21 quality starts in 53 games ( 52 starts)...during his time in Minnesota, he ranked second in wins innings, strikeouts, starts and quality starts.
THE STREAK: The Twins have won five straight, matching their 2021 long (June 16-21)...their last six-game winning streak came July 31-August 5,2020 (also 6)...their last seven-game winning streak was from September 26, 2018-March 28, 2019...their last seven-game winning streak in a single season came June 11-21, 2011 (8 games).
क During their current streak, the Twins pitching staff has posted a 1.96 ERA (46.0 IP, 10 ER) with opponents hitting . 200 (33-for-165), 14 walks and 47 strikeouts.

STARTING LINE: Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 6-5, 2.60 ERA (79.2 IP, 23 ER) with 19 walks, 69 strikeouts, a 211 opponent batting average and a 1.02 WHIP this season.. AL starting staff rankings below:
