**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 4-0 through four games on their current six-game, seven-day homestand, sweeping the White Sox in three games over the weekend, followed by a win over the Tigers last night...tonight, they will play the second of three against Detroit at Target Field...following tomorrow afternoon's series finale, Minnesota will travel to St. Petersburg to begin a seven-game roadtrip with three games against the Rays this weekend, followed by four games in Baltimore from April 2-5.

**UMMM, WHAT?:** The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 5-4 in wild walk-off fashion, their second straight walk-off victory (Buxton 10th inning home run on Sunday)...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on five hits in a season-high 5.2 innings pitched with six strikeouts (also season-high)...the offense recorded just five hits, two apiece from Gio Urshela and Max Kepler...Kepler drove in three of the club's five runs, hitting his second home run and second double - both off left-handed starter Eduardo Rodriguez...the Twins scored two runs in the bottom of the ninth on a chaotic play which began with a Miguel Sanó single, followed by a throwing error by Eric Haase that sailed into leftfield, following confusion by the Twins on the basepaths.

☞ The ninth-inning runs scored on the error marked the first time the Twins plated the tying and winning run on an error in walk-off fashion since September 3, 2003 vs. Anaheim, when Shannon Stewart doubled off Troy Percival, then Dustan Mohr and Stewart both scored on a fielding error by catcher Bengie Molina.

**TWINS-TIGERS:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the second of 19 meetings in 2022...after this series, the Twins will host the Tigers for three games from May 23-25...the Twins' first trip to Comerica Park will come in five games from May 30-June 2 (doubleheader on May 31).

☞ The Twins have won 18 of their last 27 over the Tigers and 23 of their last 35.

☞ At Target Field, the Twins have gone 11-3 in their last 14 vs. Detroit, 16-4 in their last 20 and 22-7 in their last 29.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .303 (101-for-333) with 18 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 54 RBI, 25 walks and an .842 OPS in 86 career games against the Tigers...he has reached base safely in 18 straight against Detroit.

☞ Tonight's Tigers starter Michael Pineda pitched three seasons for Minnesota from 2019-21, going 22-13, 3.80 ERA (282.0 IP, 119 ER) with 56 walks, 253 strikeouts and 21 quality starts in 53 games (52 starts)...during his time in Minnesota, he ranked second in wins, innings, strikeouts, starts and quality starts.

**THE STREAK:** The Twins have won five straight, matching their 2021 long (June 16-21)...their last six-game winning streak came July 31-August 5, 2020 (also 6)...their last seven-game winning streak was from September 26, 2018-March 28, 2019...their last seven-game winning streak in a *single season* came June 11-21, 2011 (8 games).

☞ During their current streak, the Twins pitching staff has posted a 1.96 ERA (46.0 IP, 10 ER) with opponents hitting .200 (33-for-165), 14 walks and 47 strikeouts.

**STARTING LINE:** Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 6-5, 2.60 ERA (79.2 IP, 23 ER) with 19 walks, 69 strikeouts, a .211 opponent batting average and a 1.02 WHIP this season...AL starting staff rankings below:

**DIVISION SIGNS:** The Twins are playing a divisional opponent for the eighth time tonight...they have gone 5-2 against the AL Central this season, going 1-2 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL and 1-0 against Detroit...since April 16, the other four teams in the division have combined to go 10-25 (Cleveland 3-7, Kansas City 4-4, Detroit 2-6, Chicago 1-8)...Twins are 6-4 in that span.

**LUEY, PROFESSIONAL HITTER:** Luis Arraez is hitting .354 (17-for-48), the seventh-highest average in the AL (minimum 50 plate appearances)...his .436 on-base percentage ranks sixth.

☞ Against right-handed pitching, he is hitting .412 (14-for-34) to rank second in the AL, trailing only Andrew Benintendi (.422), while his .512 on-base percentage ranks first.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1994, Scott Erickson pitched the third no-hitter in club history (5 total)...he faced 31 batters, walking four and hitting one as the Twins beat Milwaukee 6-0...the previous season, Erickson led all of baseball with 266 hits allowed.

- ☞ Facing Detroit for the second time in his career...last faced the Tigers on September 30, 2021 at Target Field, taking a no-decision in a 10-7 Twins loss (4.2 IP, 6 H, 6 R/ER, 2 HR, 2 BB, 5 K).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his second win of the season in his last start on April 21 at Kansas City, outdueling Zack Greinke...faced the Royals for the first time in his career and permitted just two hits and one walk, with five strikeouts in 6.0 shutout innings, tossing the first leg of a 1-0 victory...marked his second career start in which he allowed three-or-fewer base runners, alongside his outing on September 8, 2021 at Cleveland (W, 7.0 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 4 K).

- ☞ Paired with his start on April 15, recorded quality starts in back-to-back outings for the first time in his career.
- ☞ Ended the game with 46 career strikeouts, second most in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first eight career games, trailing only Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (48).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Earned his first win of the season on Friday, April 15 at Boston, as the Twins defeated the Red Sox 8-4...yielded one run on five hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts in 6.0 innings...lone run he allowed came on a solo homer by Alex Verdugo in the second inning...marked his second career quality start as well as his second career start with no walks allowed, previously achieving both feats on September 8, 2021 at Cleveland (W, 7.0 IP, 1 H, 4 K).

- ☞ His seven strikeouts marked his second most in a single start in his career, behind only his career-best 11 on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL.

**ZEROS FOR 10:** Enters his start tonight with a 10.0-inning scoreless streak, dating back to the third inning on April 15 at Boston...streak is the second longest of his career, after his 13.0-inning run from September 1-14, 2021, and the longest by a Twins pitcher this season.

**TIGER TAMER, HE IS NOT (YET):** Facing Detroit for the second time in his career, after taking the loss on September 30, 2021 at Target Field...allowed a career-high six runs on six hits (career high 2 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts in 4.2 innings...did not factor into the decision of a 10-7 Twins loss.

**DIVISIONAL DO'S AND DON'TS:** Ryan is making his fifth career start and appearance against the American League Central division...he's 2-0, 2.78 ERA (22.2 IP, 7 ER) with four walks, 19 strikeouts and a .154 (12-for-78) opponent batting average in his four prior starts...owns a 6.52 ERA (9.2 IP, 7 ER) in two divisional starts at Target Field – six of the seven runs allowed occurred in his September 30, 2021 outing against Detroit, and he allowed just one earned run in 5.0 innings in the other start, in the first game of the doubleheader on September 14, 2021 vs. Cleveland.

**DISCOMFORTS OF HOME:** Ryan has fared better on the road than at home so far in his career – is 0-2, 5.79 ERA (18.2 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 19 strikeouts in four career starts at Target Field, compared to 4-0, 1.13 ERA (24.0 IP, 3 ER) with two walks and 27 strikeouts in four career starts on the road.

**NIGHT MARES:** Ryan is making his first night start of the season tonight; all three of his starts to date have occurred during the day...has made four career starts in day games and four in night games, entering tonight – is 2-1, 1.71 ERA (21.0 IP, 4 ER) with six walks and 21 strikeouts in the daytime, compared to 2-1, 4.57 ERA (21.2 IP, 11 ER) with four walks and 25 strikeouts at night...his night numbers are skewed slightly by his outing on September 30, 2021 vs. Detroit, when he allowed six of his 11 career runs in night games...subtracting that start, he's 2-0, 2.65 ERA (17.0 IP, 5 ER) with two walks and 20 strikeouts at night.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and 51.5% of the time through his first three starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

**THE GOAL IS...TO THROW STRIKES:** Ryan posted a 73.2 strike percentage (80 pitches, 62 strikes) on April 15 in Boston, the fourth time in eight career starts he's thrown at least 70 percent of his pitches in the zone in a single outing (career best percentage is 74.6%, done in the first game of the doubleheader on September 14, 2021 vs. Cleveland)...owns a 69.2 career strike percentage, which ranks 11th in the majors since the start of 2021 (min. 40.0 IP).

**MASTER OF THE FIRST INNING:** Ryan has allowed just one hit in the first inning in his career – a Mitch Haniger two-run home run on Opening Day, April 8 vs. Seattle – and is holding hitters to a .040 (1-for-25) opponent batting average in the opening frame in his career...his .040 mark leads the majors since the start of 2021 (min. 20 opponent at-bats in the first).

**MAKING THE LORAX PROUD:** In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having a tree planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 16 batters so far, which will lead to 16 new trees planted.

**THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE:** Below are some facts and figures that summarize Ryan's major league career to date.

- ☞ Ryan has 46 career strikeouts, second most in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first eight career games, trailing only Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (48)...the record for most strikeouts through a pitcher's first nine career games is 50, also held by Blyleven.
- ☞ Owns a 4.60 strikeout-to-walk ratio through his first eight career outings, second best in Twins/Senators history (min. 4.00 IP) in a pitcher's first eight career games, behind Andrew Albers (5.25 – 21 K, 4 BB).
- ☞ Ryan worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four-or-fewer base runners in each of his first four career games (from September 1-22, 2021), the only pitcher in baseball history (1901-present) to do so.
- ☞ He became one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three-or-fewer hits in each of his first four career games (September 1-22, 2021), alongside San Francisco's Matt Cain, who did so in 2005.
- ☞ On September 8, 2021 at Cleveland, Ryan worked 7.0 shutout innings and allowed one base runner, a single...became the first pitcher in American League history to toss seven-or-more shutout innings and allow one-or-fewer base runners within his first two career starts (*Stats Perform*)...also retired the first 19 batters he faced, becoming the first Twins pitcher to do so since Francisco Liriano retired the first 19 Rangers on June 12, 2011 vs. Texas (*Elias Sports Bureau*).

TOMORROW'S STARTER – RHP BAILEY OBER (2022 SEASON: 1-1, 2.81 ERA // CAREER: 4-4, 3.99 ERA)

Right-hander Bailey Ober is due to start the Twins' series and homestand finale against the Detroit Tigers tomorrow afternoon...did not factor into the decision in his last start last Friday, April 22 vs. Chicago-AL...yielded one run on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings; departed with the Twins down, 1-0, and Minnesota scored two runs in the bottom of the eighth en route to a 2-1 win over the White Sox...is due to face the Tigers for the third time in his career and has gone 1-0, 5.79 ERA (9.1 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts in two starts...last faced Detroit on August 30, 2021 at Comerica Park, earning the win in a quality start (6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 5 K).

- 2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020.
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
