THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 5-0 through five games on their current six-game, seven-day homestand, sweeping the White Sox in three games over the weekend, followed by consecutive wins over the Tigers the last two nights...today, they will play the three-game series finale against Detroit at Target Field...following today's game, Minnesota will travel to St. Petersburg to begin a seven-game roadtrip with three games against the Rays this weekend, followed by four games in Baltimore from April 2-5.

TAKING A 'STAND: The Twins are looking to go a perfect 6-0 on their homestand today...the last time they had a 6-0 homestand was June 17-22, 2008, defeating Washington three times and Arizona three times.

TURTLENECKS SO SHARP, RON BURGUNDY'S JEALOUS: The Twins shut out the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 5-0, marking their third shutout of an opponent this season (also, 4-0 on April 11 vs. SEA and 1-0 on April 21 at KC)...Joe Ryan (3-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, one walk and a season-high nine strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, highlighted by Max Kepler, who went 2-for-3 with his 12th career multi-homer game - giving him three home runs in his last two games.

TWINS-TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the third of 19 meetings in 2022...after this series, the Twins will host the Tigers for three games from May 23-25...the Twins' first trip to Comerica Park will come in five games from May 30-June 2 (doubleheader on May 31).

- ☞ The Twins have won 19 of their last 28 over the Tigers and 24 of their last 36.
- ☞ At Target Field, the Twins have gone 12-3 in their last 15 vs. Detroit, 17-4 in their last 21 and 23-7 in their last 30.
- ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .301 (101-for-336) with 18 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 54 RBI, 26 walks and an .836 OPS in 87 career games against the Tigers...he has reached base safely in 19 straight against Detroit.

THE STREAK: The Twins have won six straight, their longest streak since July 31-August 5, 2020 (also 6)...their last seven-game winning streak was from September 26, 2018-March 28, 2019...their last seven-game winning streak in a *single season* came June 11-21, 2011 (8 games).

☞ During their current streak, the Twins pitching staff has posted a 1.64 ERA (55.0 IP, 10 ER) with opponents hitting .180 (35-for-194), 15 walks and 57 strikeouts.

STARTING LINE: Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 7-5, 2.39 ERA (86.2 IP, 23 ER) with 20 walks, 78 strikeouts, a .199 opponent batting average and a 0.96 WHIP this season...AL/MLB starting staff rankings below:

BUST OUT THE BROOMS: The Twins are seeking their second sweep of the season today...their other sweep was over the weekend, taking three against the White Sox...they swept an opponent four times last season: May 24-26 vs. Baltimore in three games, June 18-20 at Texas in three games, July 8-11 vs. Detroit in four games and September 21-22 at Chicago-NL in two games...the Twins' last sweep of the Tigers came in four games at Target Field from July 8-11, 2021.

SOUTHPAW STORIES: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter today for the eighth time (3-4) in 18 games...they faced Robbie Ray on April 8 vs. SEA (L), Marco Gonzales on April 10 vs. SEA (W), Andrew Heaney on April 12 vs. LAD (L), Clayton Kershaw on April 13 vs. LAD (L), Rich Hill on April 18 at Boston (W), Daniel Lynch on April 20 at KC (L) and Eduardo Rodriguez on April 26 vs. DET (W)...they are hitting .219 (47-for-215) with 24 walks, eight doubles and eight home runs against lefties this season...however, they are hitting .292 (14-for-48) with a .393 OBP in their last four vs. lefties.

☞ Eight of Kyle Garlick's nine career home runs have come against left-handed pitching...one this season off Rich Hill April 18 at Boston.

DIVISION SIGNS: The Twins are playing a divisional opponent for the ninth time today...they have gone 6-2 against the AL Central this season, going 1-2 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL and 2-0 against Detroit...since April 16, the other four teams in the division have combined to go 11-28 (Cleveland 3-8, Kansas City 4-5, Detroit 2-7, Chicago 2-8)...Twins are 7-4 in that span.

LUEY, PROFESSIONAL HITTER: Luis Arraez is hitting .365 (19-for-52), tied for fourth-highest average in the AL...his .441 on-base percentage ranks fifth...he has reached base safely in six straight games, hitting .450 (9-for-20) with three walks and a .522 on-base percentage in that span.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in the 2-1 Twins victory over Chicago-AL on April 22, allowing just one run on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...marked his eighth career start with no walks, first since September 24, 2021 vs. Toronto (5.1 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 6 K)...

- Has gone 2-1, 2.53 ERA (21.1 IP, 6 ER) with three walks and 19 strikeouts in his last four starts, dating back to September 24, 2021.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his first loss of the season on Sunday, April 17 at Boston, as the Twins fell to the Red Sox, 8-1...allowed just four hits and two unearned runs in 6.0 innings, with one walk and three strikeouts...marked his third career quality start (also August 17, 2021 vs. Cleveland and August 30, 2021 at Detroit).

DEEP ARSENAL: Here's a look at Ober's pitch selection in his first three starts this season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his 4-seam fastball and slider.

TIGERS, OH MY!: Will be facing the Tigers for the third time in his career (all starts)...has gone 1-0, 5.79 ERA (9.1 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts in his two prior starts...the Twins are 2-0 when he starts against Detroit.

- Last start and win against the Tigers came on August 30, 2021 at Comerica Park (W, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R/ER, 0 BB, 5 K), a 3-2 Twins victory...last start on Target Field came on July 10, 2021 (ND, 3.1 IP, 4 H, 4 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K), a 9-4 Twins victory.

IN THE SUNSHINE: Today marks Ober's third day start of the 2022 season...is 2-2, 4.53 ERA (47.2 IP, 24 ER) in 11 career starts in day games...compares to a 2-2 record, 3.56 ERA (60.2 IP, 24 ER) in 13 career starts in night games.

- Last start in a day game came on April 17, 2022 at Boston (L, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R/O ER, 1 BB, 3 K)...last day game win came on April 10, 2022 against Seattle (W, 5.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K).

A SUCCESSFUL SPRING: Went 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 2 ER), six walks and nine strikeouts in four spring training starts...tossed 2.0 scoreless innings to open the spring against Boston on March 19...recorded a spring training-high four strikeouts on March 24 against Tampa Bay...allowed his only two runs of the spring at Tampa Bay on March 29...earned the win in his final outing on April 4 against Boston, tossing 4.0 scoreless innings with three strikeouts.

WINNING WAYS: The Twins are 14-9 in Ober's first 23 career starts, dating back to his debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...this includes 9-4 in his last 13 starts, since July 31, 2021 - Ober is 3-3, 3.18 ERA (65.0 IP, 23 ER) with nine walks and 64 strikeouts in that span.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Made his major league debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...earned first career win on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...first career quality start on August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...fanned a career-high seven batters thrice - June 11 vs. Houston, July 5 vs. Chicago-AL and August 25 at Boston...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10 straight starts from July 20-September 12, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (50.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 50 strikeouts in that span.

- Posted a 5.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the highest single-season mark by a Twins/Senators rookie pitcher (min. 70.0 IP), and tops among all major league rookies last season (also min. 70.0 IP)...named 2021 winner of Bill Boni Award for Twins minor league Player of the Year.

HEY, ROOKIE! YOU WERE GOOD: Ober's 20 starts in 2021 marked the most by a Twins rookie since Adalberto Mejia had 21 in 2017, while his 96 strikeouts were the most since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...96 strikeouts also matched Nick Blackburn (2008) and Gerry Arrigo (1964) for 10th most in a single season by a Minnesota rookie...ranked sixth among American League rookies in ERA (minimum 90.0 IP) and 12th in innings pitched (92.1).

AND ALL'S FAIR IN LOVE AND WAR: Posted a 1.1 WAR in 2021, per Baseball Reference...became the first Twins rookie pitcher to surpass 1.0 WAR in a single season since Tyler Duffy in 2015 (1.6 WAR).

CAREER NOTES

- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks, 117 strikeouts and a .252 opponent batting average in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
Named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week for Fort Myers on April 14 and Southern League Pitcher of the Week for Pensacola on September 2.
Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston for the 2017 season.
Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John Surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
