THE TWINS: The Twins completed their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 6-0, sweeping the White Sox in three games last weekend, followed by a three-game sweep of the Tigers this week...tonight, the Twins will begin a seven-game roadtrip with the first of three against the Rays in St. Petersburg through the weekend...after this series, the Twins will travel to Baltimore to play four games against the Orioles from Monday-Thursday.

☞ The perfect 6-0 homestand marked the first for the Twins since June 17-22, 2008, when they beat Washington three times and Arizona three times at the Metrodome.

TV AND RADIO: Tonight's game can be seen on CW Twin Cities...additionally, the game will not be aired on WCCO radio but will be on TIBN, The Wolf and the main channel of the Audacy app.

TWINS STAY HOT, SWEEP TIGERS: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 7-1, completing the three-game sweep and recording their seventh consecutive victory...Bailey Ober was the starter and did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on six hits in 3.2 innings pitched, exiting early with right groin tightness...Griffin Jax earned his first career save, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings...the offense recorded 11 hits, three apiece from Gio Urshela and Carlos Correa...Correa drove in three runs, marking his first multi-RBI game as a Twin...Trevor Larnach and Gilberto Celestino each added two hits which marked the first time the Twins have had four-or-more hitters with multiple hits in consecutive games since June 20-22, 2021.

THE STREAK: The Twins have won seven straight, their longest streak since September 26, 2018-March 28, 2019...their last seven-game winning streak in a *single season* came June 11-21, 2011 (8 games)...below are their winning streaks of seven-plus dating back to 2010:

NOTE: Ryan's 1.17 ERA in April is the lowest mark by a rookie pitcher in March/April (min. 20.0 IP) in Twins/Senators history.

RAY MATTER: The Twins and Rays are playing the first of six games in 2022...they will host the Rays for three games from June 10-12...last season, they went 3-3 against Tampa, going 2-1 at Target Field from August 13-15 and 1-2 at Tropicana Field from September 3-5...the Twins are 11-6 in their last 17 against the Rays dating back to July of 2018.

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 8-5 against the Rays, going 4-3 at Tropicana Field and 4-2 at Target Field (since 2019).

☞ Last time the Twins visited the Trop, Baldelli left the team to attend the birth of his daughter in Minneapolis, as longtime Tampa Bay minor/major league coach/manager Bill Evers led the Twins to a victory in the three-game series finale, winning 6-5.

☞ Twins are 83-85 all-time against the Rays...they went 44-29 over Tampa Bay from 1998-2006 and have gone 39-56 since 2007.

☞ Notables at Tropicana Field: Jorge Polanco is hitting .362 (17-for-47) with six doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI in 12 career games at Tropicana Field...he has reached safely in all 12 games...Miguel Sanó is hitting .302 (16-for-53) with four doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, a .660 slugging percentage and a 1.005 OPS in 14 career games at Tropicana Field.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .324 (11-for-34) with one double, one home run, six RBI and four walks in seven career games against Tampa Bay.

THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ Miguel Sanó's next home run will tie him with Tom Brunansky (163) for 10th on the Twins all-time list.
- ☞ Twins outfielders have five assists this season, tied for second-most in the AL and tied for fourth-most in baseball.
- ☞ The Twins have had a average first pitch temperature of 53 degrees through their 19 games...just five games have been played above 57 degrees: 65 on April 15 at Boston, 71 on April 16 at Boston, 61 on April 20 at Kansas City, 72 on April 21 at Kansas City and 72 on April 23 vs. Chicago-AL.
- ☞ Twins special assistant Bob McClure is celebrating his 70th birthday today.

- Making his fourth start of the season and 137th of his career...165th career appearance. Today marks Bundy's 14th career start 15th career appearance against Tampa Bay going 5-6, 6.19 ERA (68.1 IP, 47 ER). Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his third start of the season and (2nd home start), to earn his third consecutive win in a 9-2 Twins victory last Saturday vs. Chicago-AL...tossed 5.0 shutout innings, allowing four hits, no walks and four strikeouts...marks the third time in his career he has won three consecutive starts (August 1-12, 2017 and August 2-12, 2016), and the first time in his career he has won in his first three starts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his first road start of the season and second start overall in the finale of a four-game series against the Red Sox on April 18...tossed 5.1 innings, and allowed one run on five hits, with no walks and six strikeouts in an 8-3 Twins victory...his lone run allowed came on an RBI groundout by Christian Vázquez in the 5th inning...retired 13 of his first 14 batters faced...gave up two consecutive hits in the 5th inning, stranding one runner on base...also gave up consecutive hits in the sixth inning, then was replaced by Joe Smith, who ended up stranding the bases loaded.

CAREER VS. TAMPA BAY: Has not fared well against Tampa Bay throughout his career, going 5-6, 6.19 ERA (68.1 IP, 47 ER, 26 BB, 66 K) in 14 career appearances (13 starts)...his last start against the Rays came on August 25, 2019, where he earned his latest win against Tampa after going 5.0 innings with three runs allowed (2 earned), two walks and two strikeouts (w/Baltimore)...his last win at Tropicana Field came on June 24, 2017, where he pitched 7.0 innings and allowed three runs, five hits, four walks with eight strikeouts in an 8-3 victory...has made five career starts at Tropicana Field, going 1-3, 8.22 ERA (23.0 IP, 21 ER) with 16 walks and 27 strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD: Bundy has been consistent with his numbers when he is on the road and at home throughout his career...owns a 4.60 ERA (436.1 IP, 223 ER) with 130 walks, 404 strikeouts and a .769 opponent OPS at home...compared to a 4.68 ERA (349.2 IP, 182 ER) with 128 walks, 366 strikeouts and a .765 opponent OPS on the road...will be making his second road start this season (other: 4/18 at Boston, W, 5.1 IP, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 6 K).

DYLAN IS DEALIN': Within his first three starts of the season, here are Bundy's ranks among all American League pitchers (min. 15.0 IP)...he ranks third in WHIP (0.72), third in wins (3), fourth in opponent OPS (.435), fourth in ERA (0.59), ninth in pitching WAR (0.6), and 10th in BAA (.175).

- Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-or-fewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (Elias). Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (Elias). Owns the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...is behind Fernando Romero (0.54 ERA, 5/2-5/13/18) and Ervin Santana (0.41 ERA, 4/3-4/14/17). Is tied for the fewest walks allowed (1 BB) in Minnesota Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season, (others: José Berríos and Chris Paddack).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy pitch usage has resulted in his highest groundball percentage in his career (46.7%)...according to Baseball Savant, Bundy used a five-pitch mix in his first two starts of the season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his usages of each pitch, including right/left splits and opponent batting average.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts. In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes. Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhardt Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season. Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City. Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th). Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta. Became 17th Orioles pitcher to record 10 wins in rookie season and first since Wei-Yin Chen (12 wins in 2012). Named Orioles top prospect according to Baseball America and Baseball Prospectus following the 2014 season. Underwent Tommy John surgery on right elbow June 27 2013, performed by Dr. James Andrews. Named Carolina League 2012 Midseason All-Star and Baseball America Minor League All-Star. Named Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month in April, 2012 (30 consecutive scoreless IP) and named Orioles top prospect by Baseball America following the season. Originally selected by Baltimore in the first round (4th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

AN A-BUNDY-ANCE OF VOTES: Placed ninth in AL Cy Young voting in 2020 going 6-3 with a 3.29 ERA (65.2 IP, 24 ER).

- Was tied for ninth-most strikeouts in the American League (72), and ranked sixth in opponent batting average. .208 (51-for-245), fifth in opponent OPS (.614), third in home runs allowed per nine innings (0.69) and tied for second in pitching WAR (2.2). Led the Angels pitching staff (min. 30.0 IP) in 2020 in wins (6), strikeouts (72), walks-per-9.0 (2.3) and quality starts (6)...was second in ERA (3.29), strikeouts-per-9.0 (9.8) and opponent OPS (.614).

Veteran right-hander Archer is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season in tomorrow's afternoon game against his former squad...did not factor into the decision after tossing 3.0 innings in his last start on April 24 vs. Chicago-AL, allowed two runs on three hits, with two strikeouts in a 6-4 Twins victory...will be making his first career appearance against Tampa Bay...is 34-43, 4.34 ERA (636.0 IP, 307 ER) with 225 walks and 675 strikeouts in 113 career road appearances (110 starts)...pitched seven seasons with the Rays from 2012-2018.
