# THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 6-0 (3-0 vs. Chicago-AL and 3-0 vs. Detroit), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a loss to the Rays last night...today, they will play the second of three at Tropicana Field over the weekend...following tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Baltimore to play four games against the Orioles from Monday-Thursday...the Twins are 8-4 at home and 3-5 on the road — their three road wins are April 15 and 18 at Boston and April 21 at Kansas City. **OLD FRIEND KLUBER GETS THE TWINS:** The Twins lost to the Rays last night at the Trop by a score of 6-1, snapping their seven-game winning streak and losing for the first time since April 20 at Kansas City...Dylan Bundy (3-1) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs on seven hits and two walks in 6.0 innings pitched, with a season-high seven strikeouts...Bundy entered the start having allowed just one run on 10 hits and one walk in 15.1 innings through three starts...the offense recorded just three hits, including two from Carlos Correa, who drove in the club's only run with a fourth-inning single...the Twins did not draw a walk for the first time this season and first time since August 19, 2021 at New York-AL. BRING MAY FLOWERS: With one game remaining the month, below is how the March/April hitting and pitching numbers compare since 2017...list excludes the 2020 pandemic season:

ENTER SAND-MAN: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober on the 10-day Injured List (retroactive to April 29) with a right groin strain...Ober departed Thursday's game vs. Detroit in the top of the fourth inning with the injury...he has made four starts for the Twins this season, going 1-1, 2.75 ERA (19.2 IP, 6 ER), five walks, 16 strikeouts, a .250 opponent batting average and a 1.22 WHIP...to replace Ober on the 28-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Cole Sands from Triple-A St. Paul...Sands has made four appearances (3 starts) for the Saints this season, going 0-3, 7.82 ERA (12.2 IP, 11 ER), four walks, 12 strikeouts, a .286 opponent batting average and a 1.42 WHIP...the 24-year-old was selected by Minnesota in the firth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Florida State University and is currently ranked as the 17th-best prospect in the organization, per MLB.com...Sands is looking to make his major league debut.

**ARCH-RIVAL**: Today's starter Chris Archer pitched for parts of eight seasons with Tampa Bay from 2012-18 and 2021...the two-time AL All-Star (2015 & '17) went 55-69, 3.71 ERA (1082.1 IP, 446 ER) with 355 walks, 1167 strikeouts and three complete game shutouts in 185 games (182 starts) for the Rays...he ranks second on the club's all-time list in strikeouts and starts, third in innings pitched and tied for third in wins...additionally, he was the Rays' Opening Day starter in four straight seasons from 2015-18.

RAY MATTER: The Twins and Rays are playing the second of six games in 2022...they will host the Rays for three games from June 10-12...

◆ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 8-6 against the Rays, going 4-4 at Tropicana Field and 4-2 at Target Field (since 2019).

◆ Twins are 83-86 all-time against the Rays...they went 44-29 over Tampa Bay from 1998-2006 and have gone 39-57 since 2007.

◆ Notables at Tropicana Field: Jorge Polanco is hitting .340 (17-for-50) with six doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI in 13 career games at Tropicana Field...he has reached safely in 12 of the 13 games...Miguel Sanó is hitting .302 (16-for-53) with four doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, a .660 slugging percentage and a 1.005 OPS in 14 career games at Tropicana Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Archer started last Sunday's 6-4, 10-inning win over the Chicago White Sox at Target Field, working the first 3.0 innings of a planned 60-pitch outing and piggyback scenario with long reliever Josh Winder...struggled with his command, throwing just 32 strikes among his 61 pitches, while allowing two runs on three hits, with three walks and two strikeouts...departed trailing 2-1 in a game the Twins rallied to win on Byron Buxton's three-run, walk-off home run in the bottom of the 10th inning (his second homer of the game, following a game-tying, two-run blast in the seventh).

Allowed his seventh career leadoff homer (third to the White Sox), as Tim Anderson took him deep on the first pitch of the game...was the first time he had surrendered a leadoff blast since August 3, 2018 (to St. Louis' Matt Carpenter at Pittsburgh's PNC Park), a span of 39 starts between.

Escaped further damage as the final out of his start was recorded when leftfielder Trevor Larnach threw out José Abreu trying to score a second run on a two-out, RBI-single by Andrew Vaughn.

TWO STARTS AGO: Archer took the ball April 19 at Kansas City and did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on four hits in 4.1 innings (3 BB, 5 K)...the Royals used a pair of solo home runs in the sixth inning off of Tyler Duffey to erase a 3-2 deficit and win, 4-3.

© Opened his Twins career with 7.1 scoreless innings after blanking KC for the first 3.1 frames... Salvador Perez connected for a one-out, solo homer off him in the fourth.

RAYS OF GLORY: Archer ranks second in Tampa Bay history in strikeouts (1167) and starts (182), third in innings pitched (1082.1) and tied for third in wins (55, with Scott Kazmir). Ditched for the Rays from his major league debut on June 20, 2012 through a 2018 trade deadline deal with Pittsburgh, and then again during the 2021 season...went 55-69, 3.71 ERA (1082.1 IP, 446 ER) with 355 walks and 1167 strikeouts in 185 games (182 starts) in a Tampa Bay uniform.

© Originally acquired by the Rays from Chicago-NL on January 8, 2011 as part of a seven-player deal in which the Cubs got Matt Garza...was dealt to Pittsburgh on July 31, 2018 as part of a four-player swap, before returning to Tampa as a free agent for the 2021 campaign.

© Finished third in American League Rookie of the Year voting in 2013, was fifth in AL Cy Young ballotting in 2015, and earned AL All-Star nods in 2015 and '17.

© Compiled three-straight seasons with at least 200.0 innings pitched and 200-plus strikeouts (212.0 IP and 252 K in 2015, 201.1 and 233 in 2016, and 201.0 and 249 in 2017)...252 strikeouts in 2015 are a single-season Rays franchise record, as are his 34 starts in 2015 and '17 (a mark shared with Scott Kazmir in 2007 and David Price in 2011).

© Made four consecutive Opening Day starts for Tampa Bay (2015-18), the first pitcher in Rays franchise history to do so...remains tied with James Shields (2018-10, 2012) for the most Opening Day starts in club history.

AT HOME AT THE TROP: Today marks Archer's 90th career start and appearance at Tropicana Field, where he is 23-32, 3.31 ERA (535.1 IP, 197 ER) with 165 walks, 609 strikeouts and a .228 opponent batting average (455-for-2000)...each of his previous 89 outings came with the Rays; today marks his first appearance in this ballpark as a visitor.

◆ Earned his first major league win in this ballpark, a 13-3 Tampa Bay victory over the Boston Red Sox on September 19, 2012 (5.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/ER, 4 BB, 6 K)...also captured his most recent big league triumph here at "The Trop" with an 11-4 Rays win over the Twins on September 4, 2021 (5.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R/ER, 4 BB, 3 K).

◆ Today is his 114th career appearance (111th start) on the road...is 34-43, 4.34 ERA (636.0 IP, 307 ER) lifetime as a visiting pitcher.

**DAYTIME INDOORS:** Archer takes the ball this afternoon for his second day start of the 2022 season... has posted slightly better numbers in day games than at night throughout his career, with a 3.73 ERA (490.0 IP, 203 ER), .230 opponent batting average (427-for-1860) and a .671 opponent OPS in 85 games (83 starts)...has a 3.96 ERA (775.2 IP, 341 ER), .246 BAA (727-for-2952) and .705 OPS in 135 night contests (134 starts).

SOFT CONTACT: Average exit velocity off Archer in his first two starts has been just 87.8 mph (down from 92.1 mph in his 6 appearances in 2021), with a hard-hit percentage of 36.4 (50% in 2021).

The Has yielded just nine hits in 43 at-bats overall (.209).

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Archer signed a one-year contract with Minnesota on March 27... marks his fifth organization (Cleveland 2006-08, Chicago-NL, 2019-10, Tampa Bay 2011-18 and '21) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

■ In a Bally Sports North interview, Archer cited his relationship with Twins Manager Rocco Baldelliand Vice President, Baseball Operations Strategy & Innovation Josh Kalk (both of whom were with Tampa Bay's front office and/or coaching staff from 2011-17), Minnesota's catching duo and up-the-middle defense, and positive reviews from one-time Rays teammate and former Twins starter Jake Odorizzi among his many reasons for coming to the Twin Cities.

**MEANT TO BE:** Upon signing with Minnesota, Archer took to his personal Instagram page to post a photo of himself from his Little League days wearing a Twins uniform...the young, then-outfielder was supporting a blue Twins top with the "M" hat...in his Bally Sports North interview, Archer mentioned being a fan of the Twins' "Soul Patrol" outfields of Torii Hunter, Jacque Jones and Matt Lawton (and later with Hunter, Jones and Shannon Stewart).
