JUST FEET AWAY ON OPENING DAY: The Twins lost their 2022 Opener by a score of 2-1 to the Mariners at Target Field yesterday...Joe Ryan ( $0-1$ ) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on two hits in 4.0 innings pitched, setting a career-high with four walks while throwing 70 pitches...Jhoan Duran made his major league debut with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief, striking out four of his nine batters faced...the offense recorded four hits with the only run Scored coming on a Gio Urshela fourth-inning solo shot off Robbie Ray...Gary Sánchez missed a walk-off two-run homer with a 361 -foot fly ball to leftfield to end the game...the attendance was 35,462.
THE DURANTULA: Jhoan Duran became the first Twins pitcher to throw at least 2.0 scoreless innings of relief and strikeout at least four batters in his debut since Mike Walters (4.2 IP/ 4 K ) on July 81983 vs. CLE...he threw three of the five highest velocity pitches yesterday: Duran 100.7, TB's Shane McClanahan 100.5, Duran 100.3, NYY's Aroldis Chapman 100.2, Duran 100.1.
ALWAYS SONNY: Sonny Gray was acquired via trade with Cincinnati on March 13 , along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Chase Petty...Gray, 32, started 26 games for the Reds last season, going 7-9, 4.19 ERA ( 135.1 IP, 63 ER) with 50 walks, 155 strikeouts a .225 ( 115 -for- 512 ) opponent batting average and a 1.22 WHIP...the two-time All-Star ( 2015,19 ) has appeared in 223 career major league games (214 starts) for the Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18) and Reds (2019-21), going 82-72, 3.61 ERA (1267.1 IP, 508 ER) with six complete games (including 4

SPRING CLEANING: The Twins finished their 32nd Spring Training in Fort Myers, FL on Tuesday with a record of 9-10...Byron Buxton led the club in hits (15), runs (8), doubles (5), home runs (5) and RB (13)...Bailey Ober led the club in innings pitched (12.0), while Dylan Bundy and Jhoan Duran tied for team-lead in strikeouts (10)...additionally, the Twins drew 45,055 over 19 openings for an average of ,006-per-game.

CAREER VS. SEATTLE: Has made 12 starts against the Mariners in his career going 5-3, 2.84 ERA (79.1 IP, 25 ER) with 24 walks, 78 strikeouts, and allowed a 215 opposing batting average...his 2.84 ERA marks his second lowest ERA against any team with more than 10 starts (lowest: 2.82 ERA vs. MIL).
© In his last six starts against Seattle, Gray owns a 3.24 ERA (41.2 IP, 15 ER) with 11 walks and 44 strikeouts...tossed at least 6.0 innings in each of those starts while striking out six-or-more batters in five of those six starts.

WELCOME TO THE TWIN CITIES: Is making his Twins debut today after being acquired from Cincinnati on March 13, in exchange for former Twins prospect Chase Petty....has made five total starts in his career at Target Field going 1-3, 3.91 ERA ( $25.1 \mathrm{IP}, 11 \mathrm{ER}$ )..is currently on a three game losing streak, however his last start resulted in a no decision after tossing 5.1 innings and allowed two earned runs with four strikeouts in a 5-3 victory.

BEST AGAINST THE WEST: Gray has started more games and pitched more innings against AL West opponents than any other division ( 335.0 IP, 54 app, 52 starts)...also $23-15$ with a 3.22 ERA ( 120 ER) which is his second-lowest earned run average against any division, first being the NL West (2.74 ERA, 69.0 IP, 21 ER).

MISSING BARRELS: According to Baseball Savant, Gray's hard hit percentage (balls hit with an exit velocity of 95 mph or less), was at $32.1 \%$, marking his lowest percentage in his career...he also missed barrels as much as he has missed bats with a S0/9 ratio of 10.3 last season...also has a S0/9 ratio of 10.0 or more in three consecutive seasons.

LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES: Last season, Gray allowed a . 239 batting average (66-for-276) with 22 walks and 75 strikeouts against right-handed hitters...allowed a 208 batting average (49-for-236) with 28 walks and 80 strikeouts to lefties
क In his career, Gray owns a 237 opposing batting average (566-for-2386) with 602 strikeouts against righties and owns a . 224 batting average (527-for-2354) with 619 strikeouts against left-handed hitters.
